**CLEMSON OVERVIEW**

- Clemson, which has a 20-4 home record, defeated Charlotte 8-5 on Tuesday.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.9 runs per game and hitting .284 with a .491 slugging percentage, .401 on-base percentage and 37 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 3.93 ERA, .228 opponents' batting average and 2.57 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .967.

**PITTSBURGH OVERVIEW**

- Pittsburgh, which has a 4-8 road record and is averaging 6.9 runs per game, is led by sixth-year Head Coach Mike Bell.
- The Panthers split two midweek games. They are hitting .287, have a 6.20 ERA and .967 fielding percentage.
- Josh Spiegel is hitting .333, Luke Cantwell is batting .330 with nine homers and 31 RBIs and Phil Fox has a team-high three saves.

**QUICK HITS**

- Clemson has a 30-2 record when scoring 3+ runs.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 19-3 record, 10 saves, a 4.21 ERA, .216 opponents' batting average and 159 strikeouts in 151.2 innings pitched.
- A total of 17 Tigers have started at least one game in the batting order.

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 4 in the nation by Baseball America this week, its 10th weekly ranking in a row in 2024.
- Clemson has been ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 10 weeks in 2024.
- Clemson has been ranked in the top five of at least one poll in each of the last five weeks.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks in 2023. It has a current streak of 18 weeks in a row.
- Clemson's No. 2 ranking earlier this season was its best since Collegiate Baseball ranked the Tigers No. 2 in the nation on May 28, 2018.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

## DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

## ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with an 11-4 league mark, ahead of second-place Florida State (10-5).
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in second place, behind first-place North Carolina (14-4).

## SERIES WIN STREAK

- Clemson won its first eight weekend series in 2024 and had a streak of 15 regular-season weekend series wins in a row dating to 2023.
- The streak ended when NC State won two of three games at Clemson from April 12-14.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 regular-season weekend series in a row from 2001 (5) to 2002 (10).
- Six of the 15 series wins were ACC road series.
- Eight of the 15 series wins were three-game sweeps, one was a two-game sweep of South Carolina (2024) and the other six were won 2-1.
- In the 14 three-game series, Clemson was 14-0 in series finales. Clemson has an active streak of 16 straight wins in weekend series finales.
- Clemson won its last seven ACC regular-season series in 2023 and won its first four in 2024. It had a streak of 11 ACC series wins in a row.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 ACC regular-season series in a row from 1993 (1) to 1994 (8) to 1995 (6).
- Six of the ACC regular-season series wins were three-game sweeps and the other five were won 2-1. Clemson is 29-7 in the last 12 ACC series.
- Clemson went 4-0 in the 2023 ACC Tourney. Therefore, Clemson is 33-6 in its last 39 games vs. ACC teams.
- Clemson began playing three-game ACC weekend series in 1990.

## COMEBACK TIGERS

- Clemson has 17 come-from-behind wins among its 30 overall victories in 2024.
- Clemson has scored first in only 18 of its 36 games and is 17-1 in those 18 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the fourth inning 11 times and is 8-3 in those 11 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the eighth inning seven times and is 3-4 in those seven games.
- Clemson is 25-1 when scoring six or more runs in 2024. Its lone loss that situation was an 11-8 setback against NC State on April 12.
- Clemson trailed Kennesaw State 6-5 at home in the eighth inning before rallying for an 8-6 win on Feb. 24.

- Clemson trailed Notre Dame 3-1 in the eighth inning on the road before rallying for a 7-3 win on April 5.

## GRAND MOMENTS

- Clemson has hit six grand slams in 2024 after hitting six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.
- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.
- Tristan Bissetta hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- Blake Wright hit grand slams in back-to-back wins over No. 7 Florida State at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on March 23,24.
- Wright's first grand slam tied the score in the ninth inning in Clemson's eight-run frame and 9-8 win.
- Wright's second grand slam in the seventh inning gave Clemson a 13-11 lead in its 14-12 win after the Tigers trailed 11-2 in the sixth.
- Clemson is 25-for-66 (.379) with six grand slams, three doubles and 78 RBIs with the bases loaded in 2024.

## CAPTAINS

- Billy Barlow, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Jacob Jarrell, Jimmy Obertop, Ty Olenchuk and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.
- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.
- Joe Allen, Nolan Nawrocki, Rocco Reid and Will Taylor were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titsworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

## BISSETTA BOLSTERING LINEUP

- Sophomore outfielder Tristan Bissetta received his chance to start in the lineup and has made the most of his opportunity.
- He is hitting .275 with three homers, a double, 12 RBIs, nine runs and a .393 on-base percentage in 21 games (13 starts).
- He did not start any of the first 12 games, but has started 13 of the last 24 games.
- He is hitting .368 with runners in scoring position.

# NOTES

- He hit his first two career homers in his first start of the season against UNC Greensboro on March 9.
- He hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- In his career, he is hitting .250 with two doubles, three homers, 13 RBIs, nine runs and a .360 on-base percentage in 33 games (16 starts).

## CANNARELLA CAN

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year.
- He is hitting .317 with 10 doubles, six homers, 33 RBIs, 32 runs and a .396 on-base percentage in 34 games.
- He has 14 multiple-hit games, including six three-hit games.
- He hit safely in each of his first eight games in 2024 and had a 17-game hitting streak dating to 2023.
- He had a 25-game on-base streak dating to 2023.
- In his career, he is hitting .362 with 26 doubles, three triples, 13 homers, 80 RBIs and 104 runs in 93 games.
- In his career, he has a .542 slugging percentage, .438 on-base percentage and 24 steals.

## CIUFO STEADY AT SHORTSTOP

- Junior Andrew Ciuffo was the starting shortstop in the first half of 2024 until he suffered a season-ending injury at Notre Dame on April 6.
- He hit .280 with two homers, a triple, two doubles, 16 RBIs, 19 runs, a .378 on-base percentage and five steals in 27 games in 2024.
- He had five sacrifice bunts.
- He had a .955 fielding percentage, committing only five errors in 110 chances.
- He committed five errors in the first six games, but did not commit an error in his last 21 games of the season.
- He did not commit an error in 47 chances in 11 ACC regular-season games.
- Clemson had a 24-3 record in his 27 starts.
- He was 4-for-6 with nine RBIs with the bases loaded.
- He hit a walkoff solo homer in the 12th inning in Clemson's 5-4 win over No. 12 South Carolina at Segra Park in Columbia, S.C. on March 2.
- He also made several highlight-reel plays on defense against the Gamecocks to save runs late in the game on March 2.
- He received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series against South Carolina, as he was 4-for-10 at the plate.

## DARDEN PITCHING EFFECTIVELY AGAIN

- Sophomore lefthander Ethan Darden emerged as a freshman in 2023 as a dependable weekend starter.
- He has picked up where he left off with consistent outings in 2024.
- He is 5-1 with a 3.19 ERA, .241 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts in 36.2 innings pitched over 11 appearances (four starts).
- He has allowed only seven walks and is holding opponents to .079 with two outs.
- He has 52 groundball outs vs. 24 eight flyball outs.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on Feb. 27.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing five hits, no earned runs and no walks with five strikeouts to earn the win at Notre Dame on April 6.
- He pitched a complete game against NC State on April 13, the first by a Tiger since 2021.
- In 9.0 innings pitched, he allowed just seven hits, one earned run and no walks with five strikeouts in throwing 105 pitches (80 strikes).

- In his career, he is 8-3 with a 4.60 ERA, .258 opponents' batting average and 73 strikeouts in 92.0 innings pitched over 30 appearances.

## HINDERLEIDER MAKING A MOVE

- Jacob Hinderleider transferred to Clemson for his final season in 2024 and has made a successful transition.
- Not only is he one of the team's top hitters, he was the primary starter at first base early in 2024 after never having played there before.
- He has also taken over starting duties at shortstop since early April.
- He is hitting .320 with seven homers, a triple, eight doubles, 34 RBIs, 22 runs, a .405 on-base percentage and eight steals in 35 games.
- He has made 34 starts, 21 at first base, nine at shortstop and four at third base.
- He is hitting .400 with two outs.
- He has 14 multiple-hit games and 12 multiple-RBI games.
- He is hitting .371 with four homers, five doubles, 17 RBIs and 12 runs in 15 ACC regular-season games.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April.

## HUGHES OFFERING RELIEF

- Sixth-year senior and graduate righthander Rob Hughes has had some impactful moments on the mound in 2024.
- He is 1-1 with three saves, a 7.15 ERA, .302 opponents' batting average and 12 strikeouts in 11.1 innings pitched over 11 appearances.
- He suffered an injury in 2022 that forced him to miss the entire season.
- In his three active seasons at Clemson, he is 2-2 with five saves, a 3.98 ERA and .233 opponents' batting average in 52.0 innings pitched.
- In his two seasons (2023,24) since returning from injury, he is 1-2 with five saves and a 3.77 ERA in 28.2 innings pitched over 23 outings.

## KNAAK OPENING THE DOOR

- Freshman righthander Aidan Knaak has stepped in to become one of the team's weekend starters.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.87 ERA, .201 opponents' batting average and 67 strikeouts against 15 walks in 53.1 innings pitched over nine starts.
- He leads the team in starts on the mound, innings pitched and strikeouts.
- Clemson has a 9-0 record in his nine starts.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.16 ERA, .179 opponents' batting average and 45 strikeouts against four walks in 33.1 innings pitched in five ACC starts.
- He has an 0.89 ERA, a .189 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts against one walk in 20.1 innings pitched over three road starts.

### MARCHAL RANKING AMONG BEST

- Senior righthander Matthew Marchal, a graduate transfer from Wofford, has been among the team's best and most consistent pitchers in 2024.
- With the midseason injury to Tristan Smith, he has made a start on the mound each of the last three weekends.
- He is 4-0 with a 4.44 ERA, .255 opponents' batting average and 24 strikeouts against 11 walks in 26.1 innings pitched over 11 appearances.
- He is holding opponents to .182 with two outs.

### MATHES PUTTING UP NUMBERS

- Senior outfielder Alden Mathes transferred in from Richmond and has made an immediate impact.
- He's hitting .317 with seven homers, a triple, four doubles, 22 RBIs, 38 runs, a .469 on-base percentage and three steals in 35 games in 2024.
- He has 29 walks and seven hit-by-pitches against only 26 strikeouts.
- He hit a grand slam in his first plate appearance as a Tiger against Xavier on Feb. 16.
- He has made several highlight-reel catches in the outfield, including one in each of Clemson's close wins at No. 3 Duke in March.

### NAWROCKI HITTING HARD

- Redshirt freshman infielder Nolan Nawrocki has patiently waited his turn to enter the lineup and has made the most of his opportunities.
- He has been a starter at third base, but has missed 13 games this season due in large part to medical reasons.
- He is hitting .269 with four homers, two doubles, 19 RBIs, 16 runs, a .348 on-base percentage and five steals in 23 games in 2024.
- He had at least one hit in each of his first 13 career games.
- He is hitting .370 with runners in scoring position.
- His solo homer in the sixth inning gave Clemson the lead for good in its 5-4 win over No. 12 South Carolina on March 3.

### OBERTOP PROVIDING LEADERSHIP

- Senior catcher and infielder Jimmy Obertop transferred to Clemson from Michigan and has become one of the team's best leaders.
- He is hitting .282 with nine homers, four doubles, 24 RBIs, 36 runs, 38 walks and a .465 on-base percentage in 34 games in 2024.
- He has made 25 starts at catcher, seven starts at first base and two starts as the designated hitter.
- He is hitting .339 with runners on base and .324 with runners in scoring position.
- He is riding a 24-game on-base streak.
- He has thrown out eight of 24 basestealers.

### SMITH ENTERS WEEKEND ROTATION

- Sophomore lefthander Tristan Smith was a reliever and spot starter as a freshman in 2023, but has emerged as a weekend starter in 2024.
- He has missed the last four weeks due to injury.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA, .179 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against 11 walks in 24.2 innings pitched over five starts.
- He allowed only three hits, one run and one walk with nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched against No. 12 South Carolina on March 2.

- He allowed just four hits, one earned run and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- In his career, he is 2-1 with a 3.67 ERA, .199 opponents' batting average and 79 strikeouts in 56.1 innings pitched over 29 appearances.

### WRIGHT ON TIME

- Senior infielder Blake Wright is having his best season as a Tiger.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- The co-captain has split time as the starter at third base (22 starts) and second base (14 starts) in 2024.
- He is hitting .320 with 14 homers, a triple, five doubles, 46 RBIs, 41 runs and a .641 slugging percentage in 36 games.
- He is hitting .389 with runners in scoring position and .345 with runners on base.
- He has 13 multiple-hit games, including six three-hit games and a four-hit game.
- He has 12 multiple-RBI games.
- He has a .954 fielding percentage, committing only five errors in 109 chances.
- He is the only Tiger to play all 36 games in 2024.
- He had a streak of at least one run, hit and RBI in 10 straight games in March.
- He went 4-for-4 with three RBIs and three runs against Winthrop on March 19.
- He hit a Clemson-record-tying three homers with six RBIs against Presbyterian at Greenville, S.C. on March 20.
- He became the 17th Tiger in history to hit three home runs in a game.
- He and Will Taylor, who hit three homers vs. USC Upstate on Feb. 27, became the first Tiger duo with three-homer games in a year since 1987.
- It was only the second time that feat was accomplished, as Steve Baucom and Chuck Baldwin did so in 1987.
- He hit a grand slam in the ninth inning to tie the score in the second game of a doubleheader against No. 7 Florida State on March 23.
- He hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning against No. 7 Florida State on March 24.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 25, as he was 13-for-22 (.591) with six homers, 21 RBIs, 10 runs and two walks in five games.
- He also earned national player-of-the-week honors by D1Baseball, NCBWA and Perfect Game.
