CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 7-3 road record, lost at No. 17 Georgia 4-3 in 15 innings on Tuesday night.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.7 runs per game and hitting .286 with a .496 slugging percentage, .397 on-base percentage and 40 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 3.83 ERA, .225 opponents' batting average and 2.54 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .968.

LOUISVILLE OVERVIEW

- Louisville, which has a 20-8 home record and is averaging 8.7 runs per game, is led by 18th-year Head Coach Dan McDonnell.
- The Cardinals defeated Western Kentucky 16-5 at home on Tuesday. They are hitting .325 and have a 6.16 ERA and .963 fielding percentage.
- Zion Rose is hitting .391, Gavin Kilen is batting .368, JT Benson has 25 steals and Tucker Biven has a team-high four saves.

QUICK HITS

- The home team has won each of the last nine regular-season games in the Clemson vs. Louisville series dating to 2021.
- Clemson is in the midst of a stretch of 12 games where nine of them are on the road.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 20-4 record, 11 saves, a 3.96 ERA, .205 opponents' batting average and 193 strikeouts in 179.2 innings pitched.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,846 fans per home date (25), the 14th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of April 24).
- Entering 2024, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance for 30 straight seasons.

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 4 in the nation this week, its 11th weekly ranking in a row in 2024.
- Clemson has been ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 11 weeks in 2024.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks in 2023. It has a current streak of 19 weeks in a row.
- Clemson's No. 2 ranking earlier this season was its best since Collegiate Baseball ranked the Tigers No. 2 in the nation on May 28, 2018.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 13-5 league mark, ahead of second-place Florida State (11-7).
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in first place, ahead of second-place North Carolina (15-6).

SERIES WIN STREAK

- Clemson won its first eight weekend series in 2024 and had a streak of 15 regular-season weekend series wins in a row dating to 2023.
- The streak ended when NC State won two of three games at Clemson from April 12-14.
- Clemson won its most-recent weekend series, therefore it has won 16 of its last 17 regular-season weekend series dating to 2023.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 regular-season weekend series in a row from 2001 (5) to 2002 (10).
- Six of the 15 series wins were ACC road series.
- Eight of the 15 series wins were three-game sweeps, one was a two-game sweep of South Carolina (2024) and the other six were won 2-1.
- In the 14 three-game series, Clemson was 14-0 in series finales. Clemson has an active streak of 17 straight wins in weekend series finales.
- Clemson won its last seven ACC regular-season series in 2023 and won its first four in 2024. It had a streak of 11 ACC series wins in a row.
- Clemson won its most-recent ACC series, therefore it has won 12 of its last 13 ACC regular-season weekend series dating to 2023.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 ACC regular-season series in a row from 1993 (1) to 1994 (8) to 1995 (6).
- Six of the ACC regular-season series wins were three-game sweeps and the other five were won 2-1. Clemson is 31-8 in the last 13 ACC series.
- Clemson went 4-0 in the 2023 ACC Tourney. Therefore, it is 35-7 in its last 42 games against ACC teams.

- Clemson has won its last seven ACC road series and is 17-3 in its last 20 ACC road games.
- Clemson began playing three-game ACC weekend series in 1990.

COMEBACK TIGERS

- Clemson has 18 come-from-behind wins among its 32 overall victories in 2024.
- Clemson has scored first in only 19 of its 40 games and is 18-1 in those 19 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the fourth inning 13 times and is 9-4 in those 13 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the eighth inning eight times and has won three of those eight games.
- Clemson is 27-1 when scoring six or more runs in 2024. Its lone loss in that situation was an 11-8 setback against NC State on April 12.
- Clemson trailed Kennesaw State 6-5 at home in the eighth inning before rallying for an 8-6 victory on Feb. 24.
- Clemson trailed Notre Dame 3-1 in the eighth inning on the road before rallying for a 7-3 win on April 5.

COMEBACK WINS AGAINST SEMINOLES

- Tiger fans experienced one of the most memorable series in program history when Clemson swept No. 7 Florida State at home on March 23,24.
- Clemson rallied from deficits of four runs (1st inning), seven runs (9th inning) and nine runs (6th inning) in the games, respectively.
- The Tigers ended the games on runs of 15-1, 8-0 and 12-1, respectively, against Florida State, who entered the series with a 19-0 record.
- Therefore in those three games, Florida State combined for leads of 23-3, but Clemson finished the games on a combined run of 35-2.
- In the first game, Florida State scored four runs in the first inning, but the Tigers scored in five of the seven innings to win 15-5.
- In the second game, Florida State led 8-1 entering the ninth inning, but 11 of the 12 Tigers reached base and Clemson won 9-8.
- Jacob Hinderleider, who hit a three-run homer earlier in the ninth, hit a walkoff single after Blake Wright hit a game-tying grand slam.
- In the third game, Florida State led 11-2 until the Tigers scored five runs in the sixth and six runs in the seventh to take the lead.
- Wright hit another grand slam in the seventh inning to give Clemson the lead for good.

NOTES

- Clemson hit .346 with 38 runs, four doubles, seven homers, 23 walks, five hit-by-pitches and a .485 on-base percentage in the series.
- Wright totaled three homers and 12 RBIs in the series.
- It marked Clemson's first series sweep of the Seminoles since 2015 and its first home sweep of the Seminoles since 2010.

GRAND MOMENTS

- Clemson has hit six grand slams in 2024 after hitting six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.
- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.
- Tristan Bissetta hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- Blake Wright hit grand slams in back-to-back wins over No. 7 Florida State at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on March 23,24.
- Wright's first grand slam tied the score in the ninth inning in Clemson's eight-run frame and 9-8 win.
- Wright's second grand slam in the seventh inning gave Clemson a 13-11 lead in its 14-12 win after the Tigers trailed 11-2 in the sixth.
- Clemson is 25-for-71 (.352) with six grand slams, three doubles and 78 RBIs with the bases loaded in 2024.

CAPTAINS

- Billy Barlow, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Jacob Jarrell, Jimmy Obertop, Ty Olenchuk and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.
- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.
- Joe Allen, Nolan Nawrocki, Rocco Reid and Will Taylor were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

CANNARELLA CAN

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year.
- He is hitting .309 with 11 doubles, seven homers, 36 RBIs, 35 runs and a .384 on-base percentage in 38 games.
- He has 16 multiple-hit games, including six three-hit games.
- He hit safely in each of his first eight games in 2024 and had a 17-game hitting streak dating to 2023.
- He had a 25-game on-base streak dating to 2023.
- In his career, he is hitting .357 with 27 doubles, three triples, 14 homers, 83 RBIs and 107 runs in 97 games.
- In his career, he has a .537 slugging percentage, .432 on-base percentage and 24 steals.

DARDEN PITCHING EFFECTIVELY AGAIN

- Sophomore lefthander Ethan Darden emerged as a freshman in 2023 as a dependable weekend starter.
- He has picked up where he left off with consistent outings in 2024.
- He is 5-2 with a 4.19 ERA, .272 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts in 38.2 innings pitched over 12 appearances (five starts).
- He has allowed only eight walks and is holding opponents to .163 with two outs.

- He has 53 groundball outs compared to 26 eight flyball outs.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on Feb. 27.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing five hits, no earned runs and no walks with five strikeouts to earn the win at Notre Dame on April 6.
- He pitched a complete game against NC State on April 13, the first by a Tiger since 2021.
- In 9.0 innings pitched, he allowed just seven hits, one earned run and no walks with five strikeouts in throwing 105 pitches (80 strikes).
- In his career, he is 8-4 with a 4.98 ERA, .270 opponents' batting average and 74 strikeouts in 94.0 innings pitched over 31 appearances.

HINDERLEIDER MAKING A MOVE

- Jacob Hinderleider transferred to Clemson for his final season in 2024 and has made a successful transition.
- Not only is he one of the team's top hitters, he was the primary starter at first base early in 2024 after never having played there before.
- He has since taken over starting duties at shortstop since early April with the season-ending injury to Andrew Ciufu.
- He is hitting .322 with eight homers, a triple, 11 doubles, 36 RBIs, 24 runs, a .408 on-base percentage and eight steals in 39 games.
- He has made 38 starts, 21 at first base, 13 at shortstop and four at third base.
- He is hitting .413 with two outs.
- He has 16 multiple-hit games and 13 multiple-RBI games.
- He is hitting .365 with five homers, six doubles, 19 RBIs, 13 runs and a .434 on-base percentage in 18 ACC regular-season games.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April.

KNAAK OPENING THE DOOR

- Freshman righthander Aidan Knaak has stepped in to become one of the team's weekend starters.
- He is 4-0 with a 2.59 ERA, .200 opponents' batting average and 75 strikeouts against 17 walks in 59.0 innings pitched over 10 starts.
- He leads the team in starts on the mound, innings pitched and strikeouts.
- He has totaled at least five strikeouts in each of his 10 starts and has pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his last nine starts.
- Clemson has a 10-0 record in his 10 starts.
- He has only allowed seven extra-base hits.
- The Tiger freshman record for strikeouts in a season is 99, shared by Rusty Gerhardt (1969) and Ryan Mottl (1997).
- He is 3-0 with a 1.85 ERA, .181 opponents' batting average and 53 strikeouts against six walks in 39.0 innings pitched over six ACC starts.
- He has an 0.89 ERA, a .189 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts against one walk in 20.1 innings pitched over three road starts.
