## NEED TO KNOW

 Head coach Marissa Young is in her seventh season at the helm of the program and holds a 247-101 (.710) overall ledger.Duke is one of five Division I teams that ranks in the top-15 nationally in both batting average and ERA ... No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 2 Texas, Boston U. and Southeastern Louisiana are the other two programs. As a team, Duke ranks in the top-15 of six national categories: first in ERA (1.25), tied for third in shutouts (16), eighth in scoring (7.08) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.91), 12th in batting average (0.339) and 13th in slugging percentage (0.544).
The Blue Devils had their nine-game winning streak halted on Wednesday with their close 3-2 loss to Campbell .. Duke had outscored its opponents 173-77 during that stretch.
Following back-to-back ACC series sweeps, Duke softball earned the program's first No. 1 ranking on Monday when SoftballAmerica unveiled its Top 25 poll for week nine.
Left-handed pitcher Cassidy Curd was named the ACC Pitcher of the Week after tossing a five-inning shutout to help guide Duke past North Carolina, 8-0, and clinch the series win last Saturday ... the sophomore fanned a career-high 12 batters during the contest and allowed just three Tar Heels to reach base on a walk, single and double.
Curd ranks second nationally in strikeout per seven innings (11.2), seventh in hits allowed per seven innings (3.72), and 22 nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.14).
The 8-0 five-inning win against North Carolina marked Duke's 16th shutout on the year, which ranks tied for third nationally with Stanford ... the pair trail No. 10 Florida (18) and No. 1 Oklahoma (17).
Five different Blue Devils have combined to register six grand slams on the year ... two of the six came from junior Ana Gold during Duke's 18-0 win over North Dakota State on Feb. 14 ... she became the first Blue Devil to blast two grand slams in a single game.

The Blue Devils hold an all-time road ledger of 70-41 (.627) and have outscored their opponents, $185-71$, during that stretch ... in Duke's true road tests this season, it is $8-2$, including ranked wins over No. 16 Florida State.

## HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

Overall, Duke is 128-37 (.780) when playing at Duke Softball Stadium, including a 20-1 record this season ... Wednesday's 3 -2 loss to Campbell halted a 20-game winning streak at home .... the Blue Devils had outscored their opponents 169-29 during that stretch.

## DUKE IN THE RANKINGS

Following back-to-back ACC series sweeps, Duke softball earned the program's first No. 1 ranking on Monday when SoftballAmerica unveiled its Top 25 poll for week nine.

The Blue Devils broke into the top-5 in all four major polls last week after a three-game sweep over then-No. 15 Virginia Tech.

## BAKER AND TAPIA NAMED 2024 CAPTAINS

Redshirt-sophomore Jada Baker and graduate student Gisele Tapia were selected as team captains for the 2024 campaign, following a program vote.

The duo previously served together as representatives on the team's leadership council during the 2023 season, which was created in an effort to develop leadership across every class.

## DUKE'S GRAND OPENING

Three grand slams highlighted Duke's 18-0 win over North Dakota State in its home opener on Feb. 14.

Junior Ana Gold became the first Blue Devil to record two grand slams in a single game, while senior Kelly Torres tallied the first bases-clearing blast of her career ... Gold's eight RBI in the contest set a single-game program record and gave the Ballston Spa., N.Y., native four career multi-home run games.

Five different Blue Devils have combined to register six grand slams on the year.

## STOUT DEFENSE AND SHUTOUTS

The Blue Devil defense has been stout this season, holding opponents scoreless in 16-of-38 games ... the 16 shutouts rank tied for third nationally with Stanford ... the pair train only Florida (18) and Oklahoma (17).

## TEAM SEVEN

In just seven years, Duke has quickly made its mark on the softball world, accumulating 247 wins and finishing above .500 in five of its last six seasons.

The Blue Devils have already recorded an ACC Championship (2021) and made three consecutive NCAA Regional appearances, including hosting rights in 2022 and 2023.

Last season, the Blue Devils reached the NCAA Super Regionals for the second consecutive year and earned hosting duties for the first time in program history after receiving the No. 8 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

## DANGEROUS DUO

Senior Claire Davidson and sophomore Aminah Vega have proved to be a dangerous duo batting at the top of Duke's lineup ... the pair rank first and second on the team in batting average, doubles, home runs and RBI.

Davidson and Vega have also recorded back-to-back home runs in three games this season against Villanova, No. 15 Virginia Tech and North Carolina.

## THE WRIGHT WAY

Senior Jala Wright continues to lead Duke's pitching staff with 85.2 innings on the year ... she has collected 101 strikeouts while allowing just 13 earned runs ... the Charlotte, N.C., native has been named ACC Pitcher of the Week on two occasions this season.

She earned her first nod after a dominate opening weekend in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico, posting a 0.66 ERA, after three appearances while fanning 13 in her 10.2 innings of work ... Wright earned the win against No. 18 Nebraska after tossing all seven innings and sitting down 21-of-22 batters faced ... she collected eight strikeouts during the contest and surrendered just one hit, a solo home run in the bottom of the seventh.

Wright picked up her second weekly conference honor after tossing 10.0 scoreless innings and collecting 10 strikeouts during Duke's three-game series sweep of Syracuse ... she surpassed 300 career strikeouts during the weekend as well.

She holds an impressive 1.06 ERA, which ranks 11th in the nation and third in the ACC ... in 19 appearances, Wright is 12-1 in the circle.

## THE GOLD STANDARD

In just three years in Durham, junior Ana Gold has proven to be a powerhouse at the plate for the Blue Devils ... the starting third baseman broke Duke's all-time home run record on Tuesday, after blasting a three-run shot over the left field fence against East Carolina ... she passed Kristina Foreman's career mark and now owns 36 career long balls, including seven this season.

At the start of the year, Gold was recognized as one of the top-50 best players in the country by D1Softball and SoftballAmerica ... she sits at No. 46 in D1Softball's top-100 player rankings and No. 37 by SoftballAmerica.

Last season, the Ballston Spa, N.Y., native led the team in home runs (19), RBI (56), and runs scored (53) ... Gold's 19 home runs ranked seventh nationally and second in the ACC.

## DAVIDSON IS DYNAMITE

Senior Claire Davidson has been explosive at the plate for the Blue Devils this season ... she leads the team in batting average (.451), runs (44), home runs (13) and RBI (46) ... she also sits second in doubles (12) ... her . 451 batting average ranks 18th nationally and second in the ACC.

Davidson was named ACC Player of the Week after leading the Blue Devils to the program's first series victory over Florida State ... she finished the week batting 5 -for-13 with a triple, seven RBI and scored four of Duke's 25 runs .. the senior homered in two of three games on the weekend, after recording two-run blasts on Friday and Sunday.

During Duke's opening weekend in Mexico, Davidson was the engine behind the offense, batting 5 -for-12 with two doubles, a grand slam and seven RBI ... she joined classmate Jala Wright as the two lone Blue Devils to earn all-tournament honors at the Puerto Vallarta College Challenge.

## HISTORY OF NO-HITTERS

The Blue Devils have recorded six overall no-hitters in school lore, including three last season.

Last season sophomore Cassidy Curd recorded the first solo seven-inning no-hitter in program history in the Blue Devils' $2-0$ win over No. 9 Clemson in the ACC semifinals ... the lefty became the first rookie to throw a no-no at the ACC tournament and recorded the sixth overall at the postseason event.

Duke's first no-hitter of 2023 was a combined effort from seniors Jala Wright and Lillie Walker in game two of a doubleheader with Charleston Southern on Feb. 22.

Senior Claire Davidson and sophomore Sophie Garner-MacKinnon recorded the second combined no-hitter last season after the Blue Devils defeated Elon, 4-0, at Duke Softball Stadium on April 10 ... Davidson's performance in the circle marked her second combined no-no as she was also part of the program's first joint no-hitter in an effort with Shelby Waters against NC State in 2021.

Wright and Walters each tossed solo five-inning no-nos after shutting out Army West Point in 2022 and NC Central in 2021, respectively.

## CURD CAUSING CHAOS

In just two seasons, sophomore Cassidy Curd has already made her mark on the program ... she was named ACC Pitcher of the Week for the second time this season after two strong performances in the circle last week ... tossing 9.1 scoreless innings and collecting 19 strikeouts.

She earned the start in Duke's midweek contest against Charlotte and worked 4.1 innings, while punching out seven to push her past the 250 -career strikeout milestone ... she then tossed a five-inning shutout to guide Duke past North Carolina, 8-0 ... the Port St. Lucie, Fla., native fanned a career-high 12 batters and allowed just three baserunners to reach on a single, double and walk during that outing.

This season, Curd holds a 1.34 ERA after 18 appearances in the circle ... she also has 267 strikeouts to her name in 195.0 career innings of work.

## BRINGING HER ‘A' GAME

Sophomore Aminah Vega was a consistent part of the Blue Devils' offense during her first season in Durham and for those efforts she was one of the 34 student-athletes named to the 2024 Softball America Preseason All-America team ... the DeBary, Fla., native is also listed in the top-100 player rankings nationally by Softball America and DISoftball, checking in at No. 79 and 95 , respectively.

Last season, Vega batted .371 with 19 multi-hit games and led the team in triples (3) and total bases (119) ... additionally, she finished second behind Ana Gold in home runs (12) and RBI (50) ... she set the freshman single-season home run record after tallying 12 on the year, including a two-run blast to lift the Blue Devils over No. 6 Florida State, 2-1, on March 25.

Vega has continued that trend in 2024, leading the team in doubles (13) and ranks second in home runs (9), RBI (39), total bases (87) and batting average (.402).

## JETTIN' JENNINGS

A 2023 NFCA All-America selection, sophomore D'Auna Jennings finished her first year at Duke in strong fashion, setting program single-season records in batting average (.462) and hits (80) to rank sixth nationally in both categories.

She placed second all-time in stolen bases with 21 on the year, which ranked second behind Deja Davis' mark of 24 in 2019 ... the Houston, Texas, native proved her power on offense and earned a spot in the starting lineup in 58-of-60 games last year.

Heading into this season, Jennings was named to DISoftball's Preseason All-America team, USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List and tabbed a top-100 player by D1Softball and Softball America at No. 51 and No. 33, respectively.

Jennings leads the team in stolen bases with 10 on the year and sits tied for third in batting average with .388 .

## DUKE'S DOMINANCE IN THE ACC

The Blue Devils have won nine straight conference series' and have swept three of their opening five ACC series this season ... Duke has outscored its opponents 173-77 during that stretch.

Duke ranks first in the ACC standings with a 13-2 record heading into the final two weeks of the regular season.

## SPARKING THE OFFENSE EARLY

The Blue Devils' offense has been hot from the start ... Duke has recorded 199 of its 269 runs this season in the first four innings ... the number accounts for 73.9 percent of the Blue Devils' run production this season.

The Blue Devils are averaging 7.08 runs per game, which ranks eighth nationally.

Since then, Young continues to remain passionate about racial justice and equality for all ... Young is one of the key contributors in the promotion of the MLK Partnership Day at Duke and the first person to bring the anti-racism program "Real Talk" to campus ... many other teams and programs then learned about "Real Talk" and incorporated this training into their programs.

A current member of ACC CORE (Champions of Racial Equity), Young seeks to be an example for young minority women and open the door to the world of college athletics.

## MEET THE COACHES

## Marissa Young - Head Coach

## Seventh Season

## Michigan, 2003

In her seventh year at the helm of the Duke softball program, Marissa Young holds a 247-101 (.708) career record.
Young guided the program to a record-setting 2023 campaign, compiling a program-best 48 wins, earning the Blue Devils the No. 8 national seed in their third NCAA appearance and the right to host the NCAA Super Regional for the first time. Young's coaching and leadership allowed the program to reach new heights and led to the development of freshman All-American D'Auna Jennings. Jennings became the fourth NFCA All-American in the program's six-year history after earning second team honors.

Under her leadership, the Blue Devils became ACC Champions for the first time and reached the NCAA Regionals, as part of a 44-12 campaign in 2021. Before the 2020 season was shortened by COVID-19, Young's squad saw its best start in program history with a $23-4$ record. The Blue Devils ended their season at No. 25 in the final ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, marking the first time Duke has cracked into the national polls. Young put together a challenging schedule in 2019, playing 11 teams who went on to play in the NCAA Tournament, and finished Duke's second season at 25-31. In the program's inaugural season, Young led the Blue Devils to a 29-27 record, including a $13-11$ finish in ACC action to earn the No. 7 seed in the 2018 ACC Tournament. The Blue Devils' 29 wins were the fifth most by an ACC program in its first season while becoming the second school in league history to finish its inaugural campaign with a winning record.

Prior to being tabbed to build the Duke softball program, Young spent the prior two seasons across town at North Carolina, with her primary responsibilities included coaching the pitchers and catchers. In the spring of 2015, Young helped the Tar Heels to a 37-16 overall record and a berth in the NCAA Tournament after the squad won 24 contests the prior season. Young's pitchers posted a 3.30 earned run average with 234 strikeouts in 335.1 innings pitched.

Young spent the 2012 and 2013 seasons as an assistant coach at Eastern Michigan, where she served as the compliance liaison, recruiting coordinator and managed team travel and the operational budget, among other duties. She helped coach five Academic All-America picks and five player of the week selections during her tenure at Eastern Michigan. Prior to her stint at EMU, Young was the head coach at Concordia University (NAIA) in Ann Arbor, Mich., from 2008-11. In less than three years, she turned the $2-20$ program to a $23-23$ record, the second-most wins in a single season since an appearance in the 2002 NAIA National Tournament.

As a player, Young was a three-time All-America selection as a pitcher at the University of Michigan and was named the 2002 Big Ten Pitcher of the Year and 2003 Big Ten Player of the Year. Young graduated from Michigan in 2003 as the all-time strikeout leader ( 927 ) and her 88 career wins became the second highest in program history. She also matched the then-program single-season home run record with 13 in 2003 . Young played two years of professional softball, one overseas in Italy and the second year with the Texas Thunder of the National Pro Fastpitch.

Olivia Watkins was named an assistant coach on July 5, 2022 and enters her second season at Duke. Watkins coaches the defense and slappers, while overseeing baserunning and the short game. Watkins came to Durham after a three-year stint as an assistant coach at Boston College, where she worked on the defense, baserunning and slap-hitting. Under Watkins' guidance, the Eagles saw improvement during each of her three seasons in Chestnut Hill. Prior to her time at Boston College, Watkins spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Dartmouth College, where she coached hitting, baserunning and infield defense. During her time with the Big Green, Dartmouth took home a share of the Ivy League title in 2018. Watkins began her coaching career as a volunteer assistant coach at the University of Illinois for two seasons (2016-17). Watkins has been active in promoting diversity initiatives, serving as a member of the Boston College Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee. For her efforts, Watkins was awarded the 2021 NFCA Natasha Watley Scholarship for Social Change, which is awarded to a Black coach who has created educational or athletic opportunities for their community, has removed and overcome obstacles through social change, or has opened doors for growing the game of fastpitch for Black girls or women. A 2015 graduate of Western Kentucky University with a degree in interdisciplinary studies and a concentration in science, Watkins had a standout softball career as a Hilltopper. A two-time NFCA All-Region and All-Sun Belt first team honoree, Watkins graduated as the program's all-time leader in batting average (.380) and stolen bases (117). Watkins also spent time in professional softball, as the first Western Kentucky alumni to sign with National Pro Fastpitch (NPF). Watkins played for the Akron Racers, Pennsylvania Rebellion and Houston Scrap Yard Dawgs.

Taylor Wike was named an assistant coach on July 1,2023 and enters her first season at Duke. Wike serves as the team's hitting and infield coach. Wike joins the program after a four-year stint at Charlotte as an assistant coach before being promoted to associate head coach in 2022. During her time with the 49ers, Wike played an important role in leading the program to its first ever Conference USA East Division title in 2021 and first appearance in the national polls in 2022. Wike's coaching and leadership led to the development of many Charlotte student-athletes, including twotime Conference USA Player of the Year Bailey Vannoy. The fifth-year catcher also became the program's first NFCA All-American, after garnering second team honors in 2022. Prior to her time at Charlotte, Wike spent one season as a volunteer assistant coach at South Carolina. During her time with the Gamecocks, Wike helped guide them to a 38-19 overall record and reach the NCAA Regional finals for the fourth-straight season.
A 2018 graduate of North Carolina with a degree in Exercise and Sport Science, Wike had a standout softball career as a Tar Heel. The Hiddenite, N.C., native led the Tar Heels to three consecutive NCAA Tournaments from 2015 to 2017. She earned All-ACC honors in each of her four seasons, while starting a staggering 225 games. Wike was named the 2018 ACC Defensive Player of the Year. She was also a finalist for NFCA Freshman of the Year in 2015 and earned All-Southeast Region honors as a junior and a senior.

Bryan Jones was named an assistant coach on September 7, 2023 and enters his first season at Duke. Jones will work primarily with the team's catchers and infield. Jones joins the program after a three-year stint as the head coach of Barons Christian Baseball, a Christian-based homeschool high school team in Duluth, Ga. A native of Plantation, Fla., Jones has also spent time as the hitting and infield coach for the Brookhaven Bucks, Prince Avenue Christian School and Florida Pokers Baseball. Aside from coaching, Jones played professional baseball for eight years after being drafted by the Detroit Tigers organization in 1994. During those eight years, he spent time with the Nashua Pride (2001-03), Amarillo Dillas (1999), Nicaragua Matagalpa (1997-99), Thunder Bay Whiskey Jacks (1997) and Lakeland Flying Tigers (1994-96). He was also a fundamental part of two MiLB championship teams in 1995 and 1999 . Jones retired from playing in 2006 and opened Evolution Baseball and Softball Academy in Lawrenceville, Ga., a 53,000 square-foot training facility designed to train athletes that hope to play at the collegiate and professional level. He served in various roles at the facility, including Director of Baseball and Softball Operations, Director of Community Outreach and Mentor Programs and a hitting and defense coach.
