CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 10-4 road record, rallied to defeat Charlotte 14-12 at Truist Field on Tuesday night.

- The Tigers are averaging 8.3 runs per game and hitting .298 with a .518 slugging percentage, .402 on-base percentage and 51 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.24 ERA, .236 opponents' batting average and 2.3 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .967.

WAKE FOREST OVERVIEW

- Wake Forest, which has a 22-7 home record and is averaging 8.6 runs per game, is led by 15th-year Head Coach Tom Walter.
- The Demon Deacons defeated North Carolina A&T 24-7 on Tuesday. They are hitting .286 and have a 5.16 ERA and .974 fielding percentage.
- Seaver King is hitting .329 with 14 homers, Nick Kurtz has a team-high 19 homers and Cole Roland and David Falco both have four saves.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson has scored 63 runs in the fourth inning, its highest-scoring inning.
- Clemson is hitting .330 with runners in scoring position.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 25-6 record, 13 saves, a 4.65 ERA, .221 opponents' batting average and 224 strikeouts in 213.0 innings pitched.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,899 fans per home date (27), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of May 8).
- Entering 2024, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance in each of the last 30 seasons (1994-23).

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 2 in the nation by D1Baseball this week, its 13th weekly ranking in a row in 2024.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Clemson has also been ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 13 weeks in 2024.
- Clemson has been ranked in the top five of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks in 2023. It has a current streak of 21 weeks in a row.
- Clemson's No. 2 ranking earlier this season was its best since Collegiate Baseball ranked the Tigers No. 2 in the nation on May 28, 2018.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 17-7 league mark, ahead of second-place Florida State (14-9).
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for first place with North Carolina.

SERIES WIN STREAK

- Clemson won its first eight weekend series in 2024 and had a streak of 15 regular-season weekend series wins in a row dating to 2023.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 regular-season weekend series in a row from 2001 (5) to 2002 (10).
- Six of the 15 series wins were ACC road series.
- Eight of the 15 series wins were three-game sweeps, one was a two-game sweep of South Carolina (2024) and the other six were won 2-1.
- In the 14 three-game series, Clemson was 14-0 in series finales. Clemson has an active streak of 19 straight wins in weekend series finales.
- The streak ended when NC State won two of three games at Clemson on April 12-14.
- Clemson has won its three most-recent weekend series, therefore it has won 18 of its last 19 regular-season weekend series dating to 2023.
- Clemson won its last seven ACC regular-season series in 2023 and won its first four in 2024. It had a streak of 11 ACC series wins in a row.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 ACC regular-season series in a row from 1993 (1) to 1994 (8) to 1995 (6).
- Six of the ACC regular-season series wins were three-game sweeps and seven were won 2-1.

- Clemson has won its three most-recent ACC series, therefore it has won 14 of its last 15 ACC regular-season weekend series dating to 2023.
- Clemson is 35-10 in the last 15 ACC series.
- Clemson went 4-0 in the 2023 ACC Tournament. Therefore, Clemson is 39-9 in its last 48 games against ACC teams.
- Clemson has won its last eight ACC road series dating to 2023 and is 19-4 in its last 23 ACC road games.
- Clemson began playing three-game ACC weekend series in 1990.

COMEBACK TIGERS

- Clemson has 21 come-from-behind wins among its 37 overall victories in 2024.
- Clemson has scored first in only 24 of its 47 games and is 21-3 in those 24 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the fourth inning 14 times and is 10-4 in those 14 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the eighth inning 10 times and has won five of those 10 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the ninth inning 10 times and has won three of those 10 games.
- Clemson is 30-2 when scoring seven or more runs in 2024.
- Clemson trailed Kennesaw State 6-5 at home in the eighth inning before rallying for an 8-6 victory on Feb. 24.
- Clemson trailed Notre Dame 3-1 in the eighth inning on the road before rallying for a 7-3 win on April 5.
- Clemson trailed Louisville 11-4 in the fifth inning and 11-8 in the ninth inning on the road before rallying for a 12-11 win on April 26.
- It marked the first time in Tiger history that an opponent scored 10 runs in an inning (4th) and Clemson still won the game.
- Clemson trailed Charlotte 12-10 on the road entering the ninth inning and 12-11 with two outs in the ninth inning before winning 14-12.

COMEBACK WINS AGAINST SEMINOLES

- Tiger fans experienced one of the most memorable series in program history when Clemson swept No. 7 Florida State at home on March 23,24.
- Clemson rallied from deficits of four runs (1st inning), seven runs (9th inning) and nine runs (6th inning) in the games, respectively.

NOTES

- The Tigers ended the games on runs of 15-1, 8-0 and 12-1, respectively, against Florida State, who entered the series with a 19-0 record.
- Therefore in those three games, Florida State combined for leads of 23-3, but Clemson finished the games on a combined run of 35-2.
- In the first game, Florida State scored four runs in the first inning, but the Tigers scored in five of the seven innings to win 15-5.
- In the second game, Florida State led 8-1 entering the ninth inning, but 11 of the 12 Tigers reached base and Clemson won 9-8.
- Jacob Hinderleider, who hit a three-run homer earlier in the ninth, hit a walkoff single after Blake Wright hit a game-tying grand slam.
- In the third game, Florida State led 11-2 until the Tigers scored five runs in the sixth and six runs in the seventh to take the lead.
- Wright hit another grand slam in the seventh inning to give Clemson the lead for good.
- Clemson hit .346 with 38 runs, four doubles, seven homers, 23 walks, five hit-by-pitches and a .485 on-base percentage in the series.
- Wright totaled three homers and 12 RBIs in the series.
- It marked Clemson's first series sweep of the Seminoles since 2015 and its first home sweep of the Seminoles since 2010.

LONG BALL TIGERS

- Clemson has hit 88 home runs and has a .518 slugging percentage, its highest figure since 2002 (.533).
- The Tigers are averaging 1.9 homers per game, the second-highest mark in school history (1962, 2.0).
- Clemson has totaled 100+ homers in a season three times, 1991 (111), 2002 (112) and 2022 (100).
- Clemson has hit a home run in 37 of the 47 games.
- The Tigers have hit multiple homers in 28 (24-4 record) of the 47 games.
- The long balls are a big reason Clemson is averaging 8.3 runs per game, its highest figure since 2010 (8.6).
- Clemson hit a season-high six home runs in its 11-1 win over Presbyterian at Greenville, S.C. on March 20.
- Blake Wright leads the team with 19 homers, while Jimmy Obertop is second with 16 homers.

GRAND MOMENTS

- Clemson has hit six grand slams in 2024 after hitting six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.
- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.
- Tristan Bissetta hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- Blake Wright hit grand slams in back-to-back wins over No. 7 Florida State at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on March 23,24.
- Wright's first grand slam tied the score in the ninth inning in Clemson's eight-run frame and 9-8 win.
- Wright's second grand slam in the seventh inning gave Clemson a 13-11 lead in its 14-12 win after the Tigers trailed 11-2 in the sixth.
- Clemson is 30-for-80 (.375) with six grand slams, four doubles and 89 RBIs with the bases loaded in 2024.

CAPTAINS

- Billy Barlow, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Jacob Jarrell, Jimmy Obertop, Ty Olenchuk and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.
- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.
- Joe Allen, Nolan Nawrocki, Rocco Reid and Will Taylor were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titsworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

GRADUATES

- Five Tiger players received their diplomas during commencement ceremonies in Littlejohn Coliseum on May 9.
- B.J. Bailey, Tristan Bissetta, Ty Olenchuk, Will Taylor and Blake Wright earned their bachelor's degrees.
- Bissetta and Taylor earned their degrees in only three years.
- Andrew Ciufio, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Alden Mathes and Jimmy Obertop earned their certificates.

BISSETTA BOLSTERING LINEUP

- Sophomore outfielder Tristan Bissetta received his chance to start in the lineup and has made the most of his opportunity.
- He is hitting .299 with four homers, three doubles, 21 RBIs, 18 runs, a .419 on-base percentage and two steals in 31 games (23 starts).
- He did not start any of the first 12 games, but has started 23 of the last 35 games.
- He is hitting .357 with runners on base and .440 with runners in scoring position.
- He hit his first two career homers in his first start of the season against UNC Greensboro on March 9.
- He hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- In his career, he is hitting .280 with four doubles, four homers, 22 RBIs, 18 runs and a .397 on-base percentage in 43 games (26 starts).

CANNARELLA CAN

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year.
- He is hitting .328 with 15 doubles, two triples, eight homers, 46 RBIs, 43 runs and a .402 on-base percentage in 45 games.
- He has 22 multiple-hit games, including seven three-hit games, and 12 multiple-RBI games.
- He hit safely in each of his first eight games in 2024 and had a 17-game hitting streak dating to 2023.
- He had a 25-game on-base streak dating to 2023.

- Freshman righthander Aidan Knaak has stepped in to become one of the team's weekend starters.
- He is 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA, .196 opponents' batting average and 82 strikeouts against 20 walks in 63.0 innings pitched over 11 starts.
- He leads the team in starts on the mound, innings pitched and strikeouts.
