CLEMSON OVERVIEW

 Clemson, which has a 10-4 road record, rallied to defeat Charlotte 14-12 at Truist Field on Tuesday night.

- The Tigers are averaging 8.3 runs per game and hitting .298 with a .518 slugging percentage, .402 on-base percentage and 51 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.24 ERA, .236 opponents' batting average and 2.3 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .967.

WAKE FOREST OVERVIEW

- Wake Forest, which has a 22-7 home record and is averaging 8.6 runs per game, is led by 15th-year Head Coach Tom Walter.
- The Demon Deacons defeated North Carolina A&T 24-7 on Tuesday. They are hitting .286 and have a 5.16 ERA and .974 fielding percentage.
- Seaver King is hitting .329 with 14 homers, Nick Kurtz has a team-high 19 homers and Cole Roland and David Falco both have four saves.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson has scored 63 runs in the fourth inning, its highest-scoring inning.
- Clemson is hitting .330 with runners in scoring position.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 25-6 record, 13 saves, a 4.65 ERA, .221 opponents' batting average and 224 strikeouts in 213.0 innings pitched.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,899 fans per home date (27), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of May 8).
- Entering 2024, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance in each of the last 30 seasons (1994-23).

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Clemson has also been ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 13 weeks in 2024.
- Clemson has been ranked in the top five of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks in 2023. It has a current streak of 21 weeks in a row.
- Clemson's No. 2 ranking earlier this season was its best since Collegiate Baseball ranked the Tigers No. 2 in the nation on May 28, 2018.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 17-7 league mark, ahead of secondplace Florida State (14-9).
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for first place with North Carolina.

SERIES WIN STREAK

- Clemson won its first eight weekend series in 2024 and had a streak of 15 regular-season weekend series wins in a row dating to 2023.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 regular-season weekend series in a row from 2001 (5) to 2002 (10).
- Six of the 15 series wins were ACC road series.
- Eight of the 15 series wins were three-game sweeps, one was a two-game sweep of South Carolina (2024) and the other six were won 2-1.
- In the 14 three-game series, Clemson was 14-0 in series finales. Clemson has an active streak of 19 straight wins in weekend series finales.
- The streak ended when NC State won two of three games at Clemson from April 12-14.
- Clemson has won its three most-recent weekend series, therefore it has won 18 of its last 19 regular-season weekend series dating to 2023.
- Clemson won its last seven ACC regular-season series in 2023 and won its first four in 2024. It had a streak of 11 ACC series wins in a row
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 ACC regular-season series in a row from 1993 (1) to 1994 (8) to 1995 (6).
- Six of the ACC regular-season series wins were threegame sweeps and seven were won 2-1.

- Clemson has won its three most-recent ACC series, therefore it has won 14 of its last 15 ACC regular-season weekend series dating to 2023.
- · Clemson is 35-10 in the last 15 ACC series.
- Clemson went 4-0 in the 2023 ACC Tournament.
 Therefore, Clemson is 39-9 in its last 48 games against ACC teams.
- Clemson has won its last eight ACC road series dating to 2023 and is 19-4 in its last 23 ACC road games.
- Clemson began playing three-game ACC weekend series in 1990.

COMEBACK TIGERS

- Clemson has 21 come-from-behind wins among its 37 overall victories in 2024.
- Clemson has scored first in only 24 of its 47 games and is 21-3 in those 24 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the fourth inning 14 times and is 10-4 in those 14 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the eighth inning 10 times and has won five of those 10 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the ninth inning 10 times and has won three of those 10 games.
- Clemson is 30-2 when scoring seven or more runs in
- Clemson trailed Kennesaw State 6-5 at home in the eighth inning before rallying for an 8-6 victory on Feb.
- Clemson trailed Notre Dame 3-1 in the eighth inning on the road before rallying for a 7-3 win on April 5.
- Clemson trailed Louisville 11-4 in the fifth inning and 11-8 in the ninth inning on the road before rallying for a 12-11 win on April 26.
- It marked the first time in Tiger history that an opponent scored 10 runs in an inning (4th) and Clemson still won the game.
- Clemson trailed Charlotte 12-10 on the road entering the ninth inning and 12-11 with two outs in the ninth inning before winning 14-12.

COMEBACK WINS AGAINST SEMINOLES

- Tiger fans experienced one of the most memorable series in program history when Clemson swept No. 7 Florida State at home on March 23,24.
- Clemson rallied from deficits of four runs (1st inning), seven runs (9th inning) and nine runs (6th inning) in the games, respectively.

- The Tigers ended the games on runs of 15-1, 8-0 and 12-1, respectively, against Florida State, who entered the series with a 19-0 record.
- Therefore in those three games, Florida State combined for leads of 23-3, but Clemson finished the games on a combined run of 35-2.
- In the first game, Florida State scored four runs in the first inning, but the Tigers scored in five of the seven innings to win 15-5.
- In the second game, Florida State led 8-1 entering the ninth inning, but 11 of the 12 Tigers reached base and Clemson won 9-8
- Jacob Hinderleider, who hit a three-run homer earlier in the ninth, hit a walkoff single after Blake Wright hit a game-tying grand slam.
- In the third game, Florida State led 11-2 until the Tigers scored five runs in the sixth and six runs in the seventh to take the lead.
- Wright hit another grand slam in the seventh inning to give Clemson the lead for good.
- Clemson hit .346 with 38 runs, four doubles, seven homers, 23 walks, five hit-by-pitches and a .485 onbase percentage in the series.
- Wright totaled three homers and 12 RBIs in the series.
- It marked Clemson's first series sweep of the Seminoles since 2015 and its first home sweep of the Seminoles since 2010

LONG BALL TIGERS

- Clemson has hit 88 home runs and has a .518 slugging percentage, its highest figure since 2002 (.533).
- The Tigers are averaging 1.9 homers per game, the second-highest mark in school history (1962, 2.0).
- Clemson has totaled 100+ homers in a season three times, 1991 (111), 2002 (112) and 2022 (100).
- Clemson has hit a home run in 37 of the 47 games.
- The Tigers have hit multiple homers in 28 (24-4 record) of the 47 games.
- The long balls are a big reason Clemson is averaging 8.3 runs per game, its highest figure since 2010 (8.6).
- Clemson hit a season-high six home runs in its 11-1 win over Presbyterian at Greenville, S.C. on March 20.
- Blake Wright leads the team with 19 homers, while Jimmy Obertop is second with 16 homers.

GRAND MOMENTS

- Clemson has hit six grand slams in 2024 after hitting six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.
- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.
- Tristan Bissetta hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- Blake Wright hit grand slams in back-to-back wins over No. 7 Florida State at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on March 23.24.
- Wright's first grand slam tied the score in the ninth inning in Clemson's eight-run frame and 9-8 win.
- Wright's second grand slam in the seventh inning gave Clemson a 13-11 lead in its 14-12 win after the Tigers trailed 11-2 in the sixth.
- Clemson is 30-for-80 (.375) with six grand slams, four doubles and 89 RBIs with the bases loaded in 2024.

- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.

- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titsworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

BISSETTA BOLSTERING LINEUP

- Sophomore outfielder Tristan Bissetta received his chance to start in the lineup and has made the most of his opportunity.
- He is hitting .299 with four homers, three doubles, 21 RBIs, 18 runs, a .419 on-base percentage and two steals in 31 games (23 starts).
- He did not start any of the first 12 games, but has started 23 of the last 35 games.
- He is hitting .357 with runners on base and .440 with runners in scoring position.
- He hit his first two career homers in his first start of the season against UNC Greensboro on March 9.
- He hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16
- In his career, he is hitting .280 with four doubles, four homers, 22 RBIs, 18 runs and a .397 on-base percentage in 43 games (26 starts).

CANNARELLA CAN

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year.

- He did not commit an error in 47 chances in 11 ACC regular-season games.
- Clemson had a 24-3 record in his 27 starts.
- He was 4-for-6 with nine RBIs with the bases loaded.
- He hit a walkoff solo homer in the 12th inning in Clemson's 5-4 win over No. 12 South Carolina at Segra Park in Columbia, S.C. on March 2.
- He also made several highlight-reel plays on defense against the Gamecocks to save runs late in the game on March 2.
- He received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series against South Carolina, as he was 4-for-10 at the plate.

DARDEN PITCHING EFFECTIVELY AGAIN

- Sophomore lefthander Ethan Darden emerged as a freshman in 2023 as a dependable weekend starter.
- He has picked up where he left off with consistent outings in 2024.
- He is 5-2 with a 4.11 ERA, .277 opponents' batting average and 31 strikeouts in 50.1 innings pitched over 14 appearances (seven starts).
- He has allowed only nine walks and is holding opponents to .217 with two outs.
- He has 75 groundball outs compared to 37 flyball outs.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on Feb. 27.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing five hits, no earned runs and no walks with five strikeouts to earn the win at Notre Dame on April 6.
- He pitched a complete game against NC State on April 13, the first by a Tiger since 2021.
- In 9.0 innings pitched, he allowed just seven hits, one earned run and no walks with five strikeouts in throwing 105 pitches (80 strikes).

GORDON CLOSING

- Junior righthander Austin Gordon started the season as a weekend starter, but has since become the predominant closer in 2024.
- He is 0-2 with eight saves, a 5.28 ERA, .270 opponents' batting average and 38 strikeouts in 29.0 innings pitched over 16 appearances.
- In his 11 relief outings, he has a 2.51 ERA, .176 opponents' batting average and 20 strikeouts against six walks in 14.1 innings pitched.

- Jacob Hinderleider transferred to Clemson for his final season in 2024 and has made a successful transition.
- Not only is he one of the team's top hitters, he was the primary starter at first base early in 2024 after never having played there before.
- He has since taken over starting duties at shortstop since early April with the season-ending injury to Andrew Ciufo.
- He is hitting .330 with 11 homers, a triple, 14 doubles, 52 RBIs, 32 runs, a .410 on-base percentage and nine steals in 46 games.
- He has made 45 starts, 21 at first base, 20 at shortstop and four at third base.
- He is hitting .429 with two outs.

- He has 19 multiple-hit games and 17 multiple-RBI games.
- He is hitting .373 with seven homers, nine doubles, 32 RBIs, 20 runs and a .439 on-base percentage in 24 ACC regular-season games.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April.
- He is riding a 13-game hitting streak that started in April.
- He had 10 assists as the shortstop without committing an error at Louisville on April 27. It was the most assists by a Tiger since 2007.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, double and six RBIs in Clemson's 17-7 win at Louisville in seven innings on April 28.

HUGHES OFFERING RELIEF

- Sixth-year senior and graduate righthander Rob Hughes has had some impactful moments on the mound in 2024.
- He is 1-1 with three saves, an 8.74 ERA, a .302 opponents' batting average and 12 strikeouts in 11.1 innings pitched over 12 appearances.
- He suffered an injury in 2022 that forced him to miss the entire season.
- In his three active seasons at Clemson, he is 2-2 with five saves, a 4.33 ERA and .233 opponents' batting average in 52.0 innings pitched.
- In his two seasons (2023,24) since returning from injury, he is 1-2 with five saves and a 4.40 ERA in 28.2 innings pitched over 24 outings.

KNAAK OPENING THE DOOR

- Freshman righthander Aidan Knaak has stepped in to become one of the team's weekend starters.
- He is 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA, .196 opponents' batting average and 82 strikeouts against 20 walks in 63.0 innings pitched over 11 starts.
- He leads the team in starts on the mound, innings pitched and strikeouts.
- He has at least five strikeouts in each of his 11 starts and has at least seven strikeouts in each of his seven ACC regular-season starts
- Clemson has an 11-0 record in his 11 starts.
- He has only allowed eight extra-base hits.
- The Tiger freshman record for strikeouts in a season is 99, shared by Rusty Gerhardt (1969) and Ryan Mottl (1997).
- He is 3-0 with a 1.88 ERA, .178 opponents' batting average and 60 strikeouts against nine walks in 43.0 innings pitched (seven ACC starts).
- He has an 0.89 ERA, a .189 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts against one walk in 20.1 innings pitched over three road starts.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing two hits, no runs and one walk with 10 strikeouts to earn the win at Miami (Fla.) on March 30.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing three hits, one earned run and no walks with nine strikeouts at Notre Dame on April 7.
- He did not allow a hit until the seventh inning and earned ACC Co-Pitcher-of-the-Week honors for his efforts at Notre Dame.
- He became the first Tiger freshman to earn ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors since 2016 and the first Tiger first-year freshman since 2013.
- He pitched 8.0 innings, allowing two hits, no runs and one walk with 10 strikeouts to earn the win over NC State on April 14.
- He retired the first 14 Wolfpack batters of the game, faced only two batters over the minimum and only allowed two infield singles.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors, the second week in a row he earned conference accolades.

- He became the first Tiger pitcher to earn ACC weekly honors twice in one year since 2016 and the first in back-to-back weeks since 2005.
- He pitched 5.2 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with eight strikeouts against Pittsburgh in the second game of a doubleheader on April 20.
- He did not allow a Panther baserunner to advance past second base.

MAHLSTEDT EFFECTIVE FROM THE SIDE

- Junior righty Lucas Mahlstedt transferred to Clemson from Wofford and has been one of the team's top relievers with his sidearm delivery.
