SAINT FRANCIS TIDBITS IN A FLASH

- · Friday's meeting between Saint Francis and Clemson marks the first Facility meeting between the two teams in program history.
- The Tigers become the 13th team in the Atlantic Coast Conference that the Red Flash will play out of the 20 teams that have ever been associated with the conference. Saint Francis holds an 80-70 win against Pittsburgh to open up the 2020-21 season for its only win against the conference.
- Saint Francis is 1-19 all-time against teams in the ACC and 1-17 on the road. The only ACC team to come to Loretto was Wake Forest in 1961-62 and 1975-76. Pittsburgh (five times) has also visited Loretto, but was associated with the Big East then. Pittsburgh is 77 miles away from Loretto, the second closest Power 5 team (Penn State is 63 miles away).
- Head coach Rob Krimmel is 1-10 against the ACC, with the win against the Panthers on his resume. Krimmel's Flash will be playing the conference for the ninth time in the last eight years. Saint Francis has played an ACC team every year since 2016-17 before not scheduling the league for the first time last season in that stretch.
- Along with its win against Pittsburgh, Saint Francis has played Notre Dame and Virginia Tech twice and faced Duke, Florida State, Louisville, Miami, North Carolina, and Virginia once on the road in the Krimmel era.
- The last time the Frankies played an ACC team was December 17, 2022 at Miami. In that game against the No. 25 ranked team in the country and NCAA Final Four participant, Saint Francis had a 37-35 lead with the ball, trying to close out the half before a Miami steal and basket to end the half to send the teams into the locker room tied at 37. Miami would go on to win the game, 91-76.
- It will be the 26th time Krimmel has faced a Power 5 opponent, with wins against Pittsburgh and Rutgers on his resume. This season, the Red Flash will also travel to Penn State (November 13), Georgetown (November 23) and Maryland (December 17).
- It is the first time the Red Flash has played four Power 5 teams in the same season. In 2022-23 (Butler, No. 25 Ohio State, No. 25 Miami) and in 2018-19 (No. 20 UCLA, No. 7 North Carolina, No. 13 Virginia Tech) the Frankies played three Power 5 squads. The 2022-23 games were over a month, while the gauntlet of games in 2018-19 was in nine days.

- Freshman **Jeremy Clayville** posted 14 points with 12 of his 14 points coming in the first half. The freshman posted nine points to help the Red Flash cut the margin to 23-20 in the final nine minutes of the first half.
- Sophomore Bobby Rosenberger III posted 10 points and seven rebounds.

about the tigers... Clemson, who is receiving votes in the national polls, comes into the contest 1-0 after defeating Charleston Southern 91-64 on Monday.

- Myles Foster and Chase Hunter both paced the Tigers with 17 points. Viktor Lakhin also found double figures with 12 points in the game.
- Hunter ranked third last season with 12.9 points per game for Clemson, while lan Schiefflin was fourth with 10.1 points per
- · Foster is in his first campaign with the Tigers after registering 12.4 points and 8.1 rebounds per game at Illinois State last season. He played three seasons at Monmouth.
- Lakhin played at Cincinnati in 2023-24 and averaged 9.2 points and 6.0 rebounds per game in his third season with the Bearcats.
- Clemson finished 24-12 last season and lost to Alabama in the Elite Eight in the NCAA Tournament.
- Saint Francis will be the second team from the Northeast Conference the Tigers will face. Clemson is 2-0 against Wagner, winning in 1983-84 and 1988-89.

top performances against power five... Seven players have registered at least 20 points in head coach Rob Krimmel's 13 seasons as head coach against Power 5 teams.

- Josh Cohen had the most points for Krimmel against a Power 5 opponent with his 30 points against Miami on December 17, 2022.
- In that game, Landon Moore recorded 25 points, which is the most a freshman has scored against a Power 5 conference team under Krimmel and the only time under the head coach that two players posted 20 points in the same game against the big dogs.
- Keith Braxton (25 points, Louisville, November 24, 2017), Myles Thompson (23 points, Florida State, November 23, 2019), Earl Brown (23 points, Rutgers, 12-20-14), Ramiir Dixon-Conover (21 points, Pittsburgh, November 25, 2020) and Jamal King (North Carolina, November 19, 2018) are the other players that reached 20 points in a game.
- Sophomore Bobby Rosenberger III had the most points against a Power 5 conference team returning in 2023-24 with his then career-high 19 points against Penn State on November 14, 2023, the second most as a freshman and the eighth-most overall under
- Two players have registered a double-double against a Power 5 team under Krimmel. Cohen tallied 18 points and 10 rebounds against Ohio State on December 3, 2022. Ronnie Drinnon was the first player to turn the trick with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Maryland on December 4, 2015.

against the palmetto state... Saint Francis is 1-1 against the state of South Carolina.

- The Red Flash defeated South Carolina State 78-74 in 1979-80 and lost to South Carolina 85-75 four years later in 1983-84. Both of those games were in South Carolina.
- Saint Francis has played North Carolina more times, holding a 9-18 record against the Tarheel state, and will be heading to the state next with a return game against Campbell slated for Sunday.
- The Frankies are 2-14 in North Carolina and 3-15 all-time in the two
- The win at South Carolina State in 1979-80 is the last time the Flash won in the Carolinas, with wins against Davidson (1958-59) and East Carolina (1970-71), the other two victories in North Carolina.

on the road... Saint Francis has lost its last 11 games on the road since last season. Thehe Red Flash lost its first four on the road in 2023-24 and then won back-to-back road games at Lehigh (November 29, 2023) and American (December 2, 2023) before its current streak.

 The five-game road trip ties the program record for most games away from Loretto to start the season with the 1964-65 team. The Frankies opened last season with four games on the road.

trending up... Freshman Jeremy Clayville posted 14 points in his collegiate debut against Dayton on Monday. He made his first two baskets from downtown and three of his four and finished the first half with 12 points. Clayville's 14 points are tied for the second most for a freshman in a collegiate debut under head coach **Rob Krimmel.** Myles Thompson scored 16 points in his collegiate debut against Buffalo on November 6, 2018, and Landon Moore scored 14 points against St. Bonaventure on November 7, 2022.

 Sophomore Bobby Rosenberger III has posted double figures in points in seven of his last nine games dating back to last sea-

- The sophomore is averaging 11.8 points and 7.0 rebounds per game in that stretch, with four games with at least 15 points and seven games with at least six rebounds. He registered a career-high 22 points at home against Stonehill on February 10, 2024, and hauled in his first career 10+ rebound game at Stonehill 14 days later.
- · Freshman Juan Cranford, Jr. registered nine points in his collegiate debut while playing in his hometown and an arena where he had great success in high school.
- Junior Chris Moncrief added eight points off the bench on 4-for-5 shooting from the floor. It was the fourth time in a Saint Francis uniform and the fifth time in his career the junior had finished the game within two points of his first double-digit game.

debut in red... Freshman Jeremy Clayville had the most impressive debut among the seven players who debuted for Saint Francis against Dayton. The freshman posted 14 points in his collegiate

 Fellow freshmen Juan Cranford, Jr. (nine points) and Victor Payne (four points), and walk-on Zachary Jones (zero points) also made their collegiate debut against the Flyers.

 Junior transfers Riley Parker (Cochise College - JUCO) and Valentino Pinedo (East Carolina) and sophomore transfer Daemar Kelly (Quinnipiac) each made their Red Flash debut in the starting lineup. It was Kelly's first collegiate start and Parker's first NCAA start.

 Parker stuffed the stat sheet with four points, six rebounds, and five assists, while Kelly and Pinedo each had two points.

Sophomore walk-on **Trey Wieand** will be on the Carolina road trip

looking to make his collegiate debut.

preseason poll... According to the Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll, Saint Francis was picked to finish eighth.

- CCSU, the defending NEC regular-season champion, and Wagner, the NEC Tournament champion, head into the season as co-favorites. The Blue Devils earned five first-place votes, and the Seahawks garnered the other four. FDU, Le Moyne, LIU, Chicago State, Mercyhurst, Saint Francis, and Stonehill round out the nineteam poll. The Red Flash and Skyhawks finished in a tie for eighth
- Twice under head coach Rob Krimmel, the Red Flash has been picked in the bottom half of the poll and finished at least two spots better than the poll. In 2015-16, the Frankies were picked eighth and placed sixth, while the 2016-17 was picked ninth and finished fourth. The Red Flash advanced to its first of three NEC Championship games that season. In addition, FDU was picked seventh in 2022-23 and earned the second-ever No. 16 upset over a No. 1 win against Purdue in the NCAA Tournament. After being selected fifth in the poll, Wagner won the NEC Tournament last season.

in the nec... Sophomore Bobby Rosenberger III is one of four returning players in the Northeast Conference that ranked in the top 30 in scoring last season. He ranked 29th in the NEC with 9.0 points per game and is the third-highest scorer returning to the league in 2024-25.

 Rosenberger also ranked eighth in offensive rebounds (1.93 rpg.), 16th in rebounding (4.8 rpg.), and 29th in minutes played (26.23).

- Sophomore Ace Talbert also returns after ranking fifth in the NEC in 3-point field goal percentage (.394), 13th in assists (2.21 apg.), and 22nd in minutes played (28.17).
- Sophomore Aidan Harris was 11th in offensive rebounds per game (1.63 rpg.).

aye, aye, captain... Sophomores Bobby Rosenberger III, Ace Talbert, and junior Riley Parker have been named team captains for the 2024-25 season.

- The duo are the top two returning scorers from last season. Rosenberger averaged 9.0 points and 4.8 rebounds and started all but four games last season.
- Talbert averaged 8.3 points per game and started 21 of the 29 games he played.
- Parker joined the team in 2024-25 as a junior college transfer from Cochise College in Arizona. He registered 608 points, 186 rebounds, 268 assists, and 95 steals at the NJCAA Division I school.

20-point club... Saint Francis returns two players with 20-point performances on their resumes with sophomores **Bobby Rosenberger III** and **Ace Talbert**.

- Rosenberger leads the team with two 20+ games after posting 21 points against LIU on January 19, 2024, and a career-best 22 points against Stonehill on February 10, 2024.
- Talbert also had his 20-point game against Stonehill with 21 points.
 All three took place at DeGol Arena, so the Red Flash will be looking
- for its first player on this year's roster to hit that mark on the road.

 The most points a player registered last year was 25 points.
- Saint Francis was 3-5 last season when a player reached 20 points in a game but was 2-0 when Rosenberger turned the trick.
- The Red Flash also had a player who narrowly missed 20 points and finished with 19 points seven times. Rosenberger, Talbert, and **Miles Webb** (vs. Sacred Heart, January 25, 2024) had a 19-point game last season.

double figures in points... Sophomores **Bobby Rosenberger III** and **Ace Talbert** are the only players who have reached double figures at least 10 times in their careers.

- Rosenberger leads the team with 14 double-figure games, and Talbert is right behind him with 12. Rosenberger posted his first 10+ point game of the season with 10 points at Dayton on November 4.
- Junior **Gestin Liberis** has six 10+ games, while fellow junior **Miles Webb** has five 10+ point games.
- Junior **Wisler Sanon II** is the only player to have a 10+ point game on the roster before 2023-24 and has posted one double-figure game in each of his first two campaigns.
- Sophomore Aidan Harris has two 10+ point games in his career.
 Freshman Jeremy Clayville became the first freshman this season to reach double figures and record 14 points against Dayton.

boards up... Junior **Gestin Liberis** and sophomore Aidan Harris lead the team with two 10+ rebound games.

- Harris also has recorded the most rebounds in a single game on the roster coming into the 2024-25 season. The sophomore hauled in 15 rebounds against Lehigh on November 29, 2023.
- Sophomore Bobby Rosenberger III is the only other player to register double figures in rebounds on the roster.
- The Red Flash had four players reach double digits in rebounds in a game last season and 15 times in 2024-25.

double vision... Junior **Gestin Liberis** is the only player on the roster that has recorded a double-double and leads the team with two.

- Sophomore Bobby Rosenberger III narrowly missed a double-double four times last season, finishing one rebound shy three times and three points shy, the only time he hit double figures in rebounds.
- Sophomore Ace Talbert also narrowly missed a double-double in his freshman campaign, registering 12 points and nine rebounds against Campbell on December 30, 2023.
- The Frankies had two players accomplish double-doubles last season for a total of 10 double-doubles.

krimmel, the dean of coaching... Head coach **Rob Krimmel** is in his 13th season as a head coach and is the longest-tenured head coach in the Northeast Conference.

- Gary Manchel has been the head coach at Mercyhurst for 22 years,
 Head to be the head coach at Mercyhurst for 22 years,
- but the Lakers are in their first season in the NEC.
 CCSU's Patrick Sellars is second in coaching games in the NEC with his fourth season.
- Last season was full of milestones for Krimmel after he won his 150th career game (at Lehigh, November 29, 2023), his 100th NEC win (vs. Stonehill, February 10, 2023), coached in his 350th game as a head coach (at Wagner, January 6, 2024) and his 200th NEC game (at Le Moyne, January 21, 2024)
- Krimmel is the 12th head coach to win 100 NEC games.
- Krimmel is in his 29th season with the Red Flash as a player and assistant coach. He is the only head coach connected to his alma mater for the last 29 years and has the fifth-longest connection in NCAA Division I among all the head coaches. (See chart on page 31).

welcome to the 'lo... Juniors Riley Parker and Valentino Pinedo, sophomores Daemar Kelly and Trey Weiand, and freshmen Jeremy Clayville, Juan Cranford, Jr., Zachary Jones, Victor Payne, and Carson Rhodes joined the team in 2024-25.

 Parker comes to Saint Francis after two years at NJCAA Division I Cochise College, and Pinedo played two seasons at East Carolina. Kelly played one year at Quinnipiac. Weiand was a member of the Red Flash football team last season before joining the basketball team.

international flare... Juniors Riley Parker (Australia) and Valentino Pinedo (Spain) become the seventh and eighth players who hail from outside the United States to play for Krimmel in his 13 seasons.

The duo joins Ben Millaud-Meunier (Montreal, Quebec, 2012-16), Georgios Angelou (Halkida, Greece, 2013-17), Ifeanyi Umezurike (Uturu, Abia State, Nigeria, 2015-17), Deivydas Kuzavas (Kretinga, Lithuania, 2016-20), Luidgy Laporal (Petit-Boutg, France, 2017-18), Chukwu Ikediashi (Nigeria, 2018-22) to suit up for the Red Flash and to originate from outside of the United States.

 It will be the first season since Ikediashi's senior year in 2021-22 that the team will have an international player on the roster.

nec championship pedigree... Freshmen **Jeremy Clayville** and **Victor Payne** are the sons of former NEC champion basketball players.

- Clayville's mother, Sue Steele, played four seasons for FDU and was a member of their only two NEC Tournament titles in 1990 and 1992.
- Payne's father, Victor, was a four-year letterwinner at CCSU and helped the Blue Devils to their first NEC Tournament title in 2000.
 The elder Payne had 12 points in the championship game against Robert Morris. NOTE: Payne does not have a suffix in his name since he does not share the same middle name as his father.
- Clayville and Payne are two players known in NCAA Division I to be playing for a rival conference opponent from their parents. Both of Delaware's Houston (junior) and Macon (freshman) Emory's parents played at William & Mary. Father Andrew was with the Tribe men's basketball team from 1987-91 and their mother, Rebecca Dayvault, played on the W&M women's basketball team from 1989-93.
- UConn freshman Isaiah Abraham, Faisal, was a four-year letterwinner at Marquette (1993-97). The legacy dates back to Abraham's grandfather, Ralph, who played at St. John's from 1967-70.

familiar faces... Sophomore Ryen Gresko is the third Gresko to wear the black and red uniform in his family. His brother, Aric, appeared in 16 games, with one start from 2012-15 on the hardwood for the Red Flash. He registered a career-high three points and two rebounds against Keystone in his senior year. In addition, his sister, Katee, was a four-year letterwinner on the cross country and track and field team from 2012-15.

Two player's parents also have to head coach Rob Krimmel.
 Freshman Zachary Jones' father, Barrett, went to high school in State College with Krimmel, while fellow freshman Victor Payne's father, Victor, played against Krimmel at CCSU.

cambria county family connection... Sophomore Aidan Harris' father, Quinn, is in the Pitt Johnstown Hall of Fame for men's basketball.

- Quinn Harris (1988-93) left the Mountain Cats as the program's alltime leading scorer with 1,490 points, a record that stood until 2000.
 He currently ranks fifth in scoring and 10th in rebounding and was inducted into the Pitt Johnstown Hall of Fame in 2012.
- Pitt Johnstown is an NCAA Division II program located in the same county as Saint Francis, separated by just 25.5 miles.

new look to the staff... Head coach **Rob Krimmel's** staff looks different in 2024-25.

- Luke McConnell and Oliver Allen are the only returners from last season, but each took new roles. In his 12th season with the program, McConnell was elevated to Associate Head Coach. McConnell, a 2012 Saint Francis graduate, played on the Red Flash football team as a student-athlete. McConnell is the son of former Saint Francis men's basketball head coach Tom McConnell (1992-99), while his cousin T.J. McConnell is in his 10th season in the NBA.
- Allen, a graduate assistant for the last two years, was moved to assistant coach.
- Devin Sweetney, a 2010 graduate of Saint Francis, joined the staff in 2023-24 as an assistant coach. Sweetney posted 1,529 points and 754 rebounds in a Red Flash uniform and enjoyed 12 professional basketball seasons in 17 countries before ending his playing career. John McKeown also joins the staff as a graduate assistant. McKeown was a student manager at Rhode Island for the last four years. FUN FACT: There was a John (Jay) McKeown, who played seven games, eight minutes and made one basket for the 1992-93 Red Flash. The two are not related.

nba connections... Associate head coach **Luke McConnell** is the cousin to T.J. McConnell, who is in his 10th season in the NBA.

• The Red Flash NBA connection grew in the offseason when the Washington Wizards drafted Kyshawn George with pick number 24 in the 2024 NBA Draft. George's father, Deon, was a four-year letterwinner on the Red Flash men's basketball team and helped Saint Francis to its only Northeast Conference Tournament title and NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992.

NOTABLE MBB ALUMNI

Maurice Stokes (1951-55) - Stokes led the Frankies to the 1955 National Invitation Tournament and was named Most Valuable Player although his team finished fourth in the tournament. In his first college season, Stokes averaged 23.1 points and 26.5 rebounds per game. In the following season, he averaged 271 points and 26.2 rebounds per game. Stokes remains Saint Francis' all-time leading rebounder with 1,819 and is second in scoring with 2,282 points. The Red Flash were 79-30 during Stokes' ing with 2,282 points. The Red Flash were 79-30 during Stokes' four seasons. During his three seasons in the NBA (1955-58), he grabbed more rebounds than any other player with 3,492 (Bob Pettit was second with 3,417) and also amassed 1,062 assists, which was second in the NBA only to Boston Celtics' point guard Bob Cousy (1,583). Stokes was named an All-Star and All-NBA Second Team for all three seasons of his career. He was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in September 2004. On March 12, 1958, in the last game of the 1957-58 NBA regular season. Stokes was knocked unconthe 1957-58 NBA regular season, Stokes was knocked unconscious after he drove to the basket, drew contact, and struck his head as he fell to the court. He was revived with smelling salts and returned to the game. Three days later, after recording 12 points and 15 rebounds in an opening-round playoff game against the Detroit Pistons, he became ill on the team's flight back to Cincinnati. Stokes later suffered a seizure and was left permanently paralyzed. He was diagnosed with post-traumatic encephalopathy, a brain injury that damaged his motor-control center. On June 9, 2013, the NBA announced that both Stokes and Jack Twyman would be honored with an annual award in their names, the Twyman-Stokes Teammate of the Year Award, which recognizes the player that embodies the league's ideal teammate that season.

Calvin Fowler (1959-62) - Fowler was the captain of the United States gold medal basketball team at the 1967 Pan American Games. He also was co-captain of the U.S. gold medal team at the 1968 Summer Olympics.

Mike luzzolino (1989-91) - luzzolino was selected by the Dallas Mavericks in the second round (35th pick overall) of the 1991 NBA draft. luzzolino, a 5-foot 10 inch point guard, played two years in the National Basketball Association (NBA), both with the Mavericks. He averaged 9.0 points per game in his career. In 1993, he signed as a free agent with the Orlando Magic, but was waived. After his NBA career, luzzolino played professionally in Italy and Spain. luzzolino was featured in the 1993 arcade edition of the popular video game NBA Jam. He is currently an assistant coach with Robert Morris.

Dave Magarity (1968-72) - Magarity was the Saint Francis men's basketball head coach from 1978-83 and was also the head coach at Marist College from 1986-2004. He guided the Red Foxes to the 1987 NCAA Tournament with future NBA player Rik Smits. He would also serve as the women's basketball coach at Army from 2006-21. He holds a career record of 313-335 as a men's coach and a 266-183 mark as a women's coach.

Jack Phelan (1973-77) - Phelan still holds the DeGol Arena record with 42 points against Duquesne on January 14, 1977. was drafted by the San Francisco Warriors in the 1977 NBA Draft. To speak to his athleticism, he was signed as a free agent by the Pittsburgh Steelers in the NFL after his senior year. He served as the Hartford men's basketball coach for 11 seasons and is one of four coaches in men's basketball team history to amass 100 career wins. Phelan was the head coach at Hartford during its transition from NCAA Division II to I in 1984-85. After he left Hartford, he served as the athletics director at Farmington High School and passed away in June 2020.

Kevin Porter (1968-72) - Over an 11-year NBA career, Porter averaged 11.6 ppg, 8.1 apg, while winning four assist titles. Basketball historian Bijan Bayne said, "What always stood out about Kevin Porter is that he was pass-first, in an era of Pistol, Clyde, Pearl, Tiny, Westphal and Jo Jo. That watered down his star quality. Porter himself added, "That's what I did. I got the ball to scorers. That's what kept me in the league that long."

Norm Van Lier (1966-69) - The Chicago Bulls selected Van Lier in the third round of the 1969 NBA draft, but immediately traded him to the Cincinnati Royals, with whom he led the NBA in assists in 1971. On January 5 of that year, Van Lier became the first player in NBA history to have a scoreless double-double with zero points, 13 assists and 11 rebounds in a victory against the Los Angeles Lakers. During his ten-year career, Van Lier was named to three NBA All-Defense First Teams and five NBA All-Defense Second Teams. He has the most selections along-side Michael Cooper to not be inducted into the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame. He was named to the All-NBA Second Team in 1974. Van Lier retired in 1979 with career totals of 8,770 points and 5,217 assists.

NON-BASKETBALL NOTABLE ALUMNI

Paul Boyton - Boyton, known as the Fearless Frogman, was a showman and adventurer some credit as having spurred worldwide interest in water sports as a hobby, particularly open-water swimming. Boyton is best known for his water stunts that captivated the world, including crossing the English Channel in a novel rubber suit that functioned similarly to a kayak. As the founder of Sea Lion Park in 1895, Boyton is also known as the originator of the first modern amusement park with a fenced-in enclosure and admission charged at the gate.

Scott Layden (1978-81) - Layden graduated from Saint Francis with a degree in Business and Sports Marketing. He worked as an assistant coach for the Utah Jazz with his father, Frank, where he is generally considered for the selection of John Stockton with the 16th pick in the 1984 NBA Draft and Karl Malone the following year with the 13th pick. He also served as the general manager of the New York Knicks and the Minnesota Timberwolves.

Bob Moore (1965-69) - Moore served as the Director of Public Relations with the Kansas City Chiefs for 21 years starting in 1989. He then served as the team's historian for eight years and is now a historian emeritus. Moore got his start in professional sports with the Philadelphia/Baltimore Stars for three years and also started as a sports information director at Saint Francis and Drexel. Moore was inducted into the Saint Francis Athletics Hall of Fame over the summer for his contributions to the Golden Era wing of the Saint Francis Hall of Fame.

John Naioti (1938-42) - Naioti played in the National Football League for the Pittsburgh Steelers in 1942. He then went into the Army Air Corp during World War II. He was a first lieutenant navigator and a member of the 603rd Squadron. On August 16, 1944, he flew on a mission from Nuthampstead, England to Delitzsch, Germany.[3] He completed his 32 combat missions on August 26, 1944, after a flight over Gelsenkirchen, Germany. After completion of his military service, he returned to the Pittsburgh Steelers and played in 1945. In 1945 he also kicked four point after touchdowns

Charles M. Schwab (1874-77) - Schwab was an American steel magnate. Under his leadership, Bethlehem Steel became the second-largest steel maker in the United States, and one of the most important heavy manufacturers in the world. Schwab also owned a 44-room summer estate on 1,000 acres (4 km2) in Loretto, Pennsylvania, called "Immergrün", German for "evergreen". The house featured opulent gardens and a nine-hole golf course. Schwab's estate sold Immergrün after his death, and it is now Mount Assisi Friary owned by the Franciscan friars (Third Order Regular) who administer the adjacent Saint Francis University.


Brian Sell (1997-2001) - Sell represented SFU at the 2000 NCAA Division I XC Championships, where he ran the 10K in 31:171 and was an All-American. Sell placed third overall in the 2008 USA Olympic Team Trials Marathon in Central Park, New York City on November 3, 2007, with a time of 2:11:40, earning him a spot, along with Ryan Hall and Dathan Ritzenhein, on the U.S. men's marathon team at the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing, where he finished the Olympic Marathon in 22nd place with a time of 2:16:7.

Thomas Joseph Tobin (1966-69) - Tobin is an American prelate of the Roman Catholic Church. He was bishop of the Diocese of Providence in Rhode Island from 2005 to 2023.







Head coach **Rob Krimmel** has been associated with Saint Francis basketball since he stepped on the Loretto campus as freshman in the fall of 1996 and has never left.

Krimmel is the second winningest coach in program history with 155 wins, trailing Saint Francis Hall of Famer Skip Hughes (293-206-1, 1945-66).

Under Krimmel's tutelage, the Red Flash has posted two wins against Power 6 Conference opponents after defeating Rutgers 73-68 on December 20, 2014 and Pittsburgh 80-70 on November 20, 2020.

The Red Flash has advanced to the NEC Championship Game three times in the last seven years and the NEC Semifinals six times in his first 12 seasons at the helm.

Krimmel's teams have done just as much good on the court as it has off it as he was named the recipient of the 2019 NABC Guardians of the Game Award for Service for his dedication to the sport. In addition, the Red Flash has won the NEC Sportsmanship Award eight times in the 16-year history of the award.

Since Krimmel took over as head coach, 14 players have gone on to sign professional contracts: Earl Brown, Greg Brown, Ben Millaud-Meunier, Ronnie Drinnon, Georgios Angelou, Pat Wrencher, Deon Baker, Jamaal King, Andre Wolford, Isaiah Blackmon, Keith Braxton, Ramiir Dixon-Conove, Tyler Stewart and Marlon Hargis.

The 2024-25 season features 40 head coaches that are coaching at their alma mater. There are over 90 games on the schedule when two coaches will be coaching against each other on oposing sidelines.
