CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 7-6 road record, won one of three games at No. 5 Florida State last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.1 runs per game and hitting .272 with a .444 slugging percentage, .409 on-base percentage and 58 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.97 ERA, .246 opponents' batting average and 2.55 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .975.

COASTAL CAROLINA OVERVIEW

- Coastal Carolina, which has a 20-3 home record and is averaging 7.4 runs per game, is led by first-year Head Coach Kevin Schnall.
- The Chanticleers swept App State in three home games last weekend. They are hitting .281 and have a 3.47 ERA and .976 fielding percentage.
- Caden Bodine is hitting .324, Sebastian Alexander has eight homers and 20 steals and Dominick Carbone has a team-high four saves.

QUICK HITS

- Coastal Carolina defeated the Tigers 8-2 at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on March 25, 2025.
- Tuesday's game at Coastal Carolina marks Clemson's 11th consecutive game against a top-25 team.
- Clemson's highest-scoring inning is the first inning, when it has scored 64 runs, 24 more than any other inning.

- Clemson has a current 39-week streak of being ranked in the top 25 of at least poll dating to the 2023 season.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,951 fans per home date (30), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of May 4).
- In a 5-3 win over South Carolina on Feb. 28, Clemson set a school record with 6,891 fans in attendance at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- Entering 2025, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 31 straight seasons.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is tied for sixth place in the ACC standings with a 14-10 league mark.
- Clemson has won six of its eight ACC series, including series wins over No. 11 Wake Forest, No. 19 Georgia Tech and No. 17 Louisville.

SHRINERS SHOWDOWN RECAP

- Clemson was one of four teams in the six-team Shriners Children's College Showdown with a 2-1 record to tie for the best record.
- The showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas from Feb. 14-16 marked Clemson's first three games in an MLB stadium and a dome.
- It marked Clemson's first regular-season game outside the Eastern time zone since 2005.
- Clemson defeated No. 13 Oklahoma State 6-5 in the first game, then beat No. 12 Arizona 16-5 in its second game before falling to Ole Miss.
- Oklahoma State and Arizona were the top-two teams, respectively, in the Big 12 Conference coaches pre-season poll.
- The Tigers hit .324 with 10 doubles, 27 runs, a .418 on-base percentage, two steals and a .990 fielding percentage in the showdown.
- Dominic Listi was 5-for-9 (.556) with seven RBIs, four runs, two walks, two hit-by-pitches and a .643 on-base percentage in three games.

TIGERS SWEEP RIVAL GAMECOCKS

- Clemson swept South Carolina in three games at three different sites by a combined score of 18-6 from Feb. 28 to March 2.
- The Tigers won 5-3 at Clemson, 5-1 at Fluor Field in Greenville, S.C. and 8-2 at South Carolina.
- Clemson never trailed in the series.
- Clemson had a 1.69 ERA, .160 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against nine walks in 27.0 innings pitched in the series.
- A Doug Kingsmore Stadium record crowd of 6,891 saw the Tigers outlast the Gamecocks by a score of 5-3 on Feb. 28.

- Ethan Darden received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series.
- Darden pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win on March 1.
- Jarren Purify was 4-for-8 with a homer, double, three RBIs, a .636 on-base percentage and two steals in three games.
- It marked the third time in four years the Tigers swept South Carolina, as they won all three games in 2022 and both games in 2024.
- It upped Clemson's winning streak in the series to five, while the Tigers have won 10 of the last 12 meetings.
- Clemson has won eight of the last 11 series.

17-GAME WINNING STREAK

- Clemson had a 17-game winning streak that started with a 6-2 win over VCU on Feb. 21 and ended with a 7-3 loss to Notre Dame on March 16.
- The 17-game winning streak was Clemson's longest since it won 17 games in a row during the 2023 season.
- The 17-game winning streak tied for the fourth longest in school history.
- Seven of the 17 wins during the winning streak were comeback victories.
- Clemson hit .290 with a .480 slugging percentage, .439 on-base percentage and 8.3 runs per game during the winning streak.
- Clemson had a 2.84 ERA, .186 opponents' batting average and 184 strikeouts against 57 walks in 149.0 innings pitched in the winning streak.
- Clemson held opponents to .145 with runners in scoring position during the winning streak.

SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an official RPI of No. 7 (through games of May 4).
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-10 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 17 in the nation.
- Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 90 in the nation, and the Tigers are 23-2 in regular-season non-conference games.

TAKING ONE FOR THE TEAM

- Clemson batters have been hit by a pitch 87 times in 49 games (1.8 per game) in 2025.
- Clemson has set the Tiger record for hit-by-pitches in a season, breaking the 2021 team's mark of 80.
- The 87 hit-by-pitches along with its 296 walks (6.0 per game) are a big reason Clemson has a .409 on-base percentage.
- Dominic Listi leads the team in hit-by-pitches with a school-record 22.

BULLPEN SUCCESS

- Clemson's bullpen has been a big reason the Tigers have won the vast majority of their close games in 2025.
- The bullpen has a 26-2 record, 20 saves, a 4.51 ERA, .247 opponents' batting average and 267 strikeouts in 237.1 innings pitched.
- Tiger relievers have allowed 99 walks and have a 2.70 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- Lucas Mahlstedt leads the bullpen with a 2-0 record, a Tiger-record-tying 15 saves and 1.95 ERA in 20 relief appearances
- Reed Garris is 3-0 with three saves, an 0.69 ERA and a .153 opponents' batting average in 16 relief outings.
- Joe Allen has only allowed two of 17 inherited baserunners to score in his 15 relief appearances.

CAPTAINS

- Andrew Ciuffo, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2024.
- Seven Tigers were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Those seven Tigers are Joe Allen, Tristan Bissetta, Cam Cannarella, Dominic Listi, Lucas Mahlstedt, Tryston McCladdie and Josh Paino.

BAILEY BACK

- Senior lefty B.J. Bailey missed all of 2024 due to injury after pitching 15.2 innings in 2023, but has become one of Clemson's top pitchers.
- He is 2-3 with a 3.98 ERA, .240 opponents' batting average and 46 strikeouts against 19 walks in 52.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- He has made 11 relief appearances and four starts, as he joined the weekend rotation for the first time at Georgia Tech in late March.
- He leads the team in pickoffs (2).
- He allowed one run with eight strikeouts in 6.2 innings pitched in the second game of a doubleheader at No. 19 Georgia Tech on March 29.
- It was his first start as a Tiger, as he allowed just four hits against a team that entered the game averaging 9.9 runs per game.
- The only run he allowed came on a two-out balk, as he struck out the next batter.
- In two active years as a Tiger, he is 4-5 with a 3.99 ERA and .251 opponents' batting average in 67.2 innings pitched over 32 appearances.
- He has 66 strikeouts against 25 walks in his two active years as a Tiger.

CANNARELLA RACKING UP HITS

- Junior outfielder Cam Cannarella continues to accumulate hits in his third season as a Tiger.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He's hitting .301 with two homers, two triples, 15 doubles, 33 RBIs, 46 runs, a .448 on-base percentage and four steals in 47 games in 2025.
- He has more walks (42) than strikeouts (35).
- He is riding a 30-game on-base streak.
- He went 5-for-5 with an RBI and two runs in Clemson's 6-4 win over The Citadel on March 18.
- He hit a two-run triple and scored the go-ahead run on the play in the eighth inning in Clemson's victory over No. 5 Florida State on May 3.
- In his career, he is hitting .347 with 232 hits, 47 doubles, eight triples, 20 homers, 140 RBIs, 176 runs and 28 steals in 164 games.

- In his career, he has a .531 slugging percentage and .442 on-base percentage.

DARDEN HAVING HIS MOMENTS

- Junior lefthander Ethan Darden has had some big moments in his junior season in 2025.
- A majority of his appearances in each of his three seasons as a Tiger have been in a starting role.
- He has not pitched since April 12 due to injury.
- He is 4-2 with a 6.07 ERA, .277 opponents' batting average and 34 strikeouts against 16 walks in 40.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- Clemson has a 7-2 record in his nine starts.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 5-1 win over South Carolina on March 1.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors and received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series against South Carolina.
- In his career, he is 12-9 with a 5.50 ERA, .281 opponents' batting average and 121 strikeouts in 162.0 innings pitched over 47 appearances.
- He has made 32 starts in his career.

GAFFNEY AT HOME

- Sophomore infielder and catcher Luke Gaffney has found a home at Clemson after transferring from Purdue following a standout 2024 season.
- He is hitting .276 with five homers, six doubles, 33 RBIs, 24 runs, a .367 on-base percentage and steal in 47 games (45 starts) in 2025.

GARRIS PROVIDING RELIEF

- Senior righthander Reed Garris has been a steadying influence on the bullpen for three years.
- He is 3-0 with three saves, an 0.69 ERA, .153 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts versus six walks in 26.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- He is 2-0 with two saves, an 0.63 ERA and 17 strikeouts against four walks in 14.1 innings pitched (10 outings) in ACC regular-season games.
- In his career, he is 9-1 with three saves, a 2.70 ERA, .186 opponents' batting average and 93 strikeouts in 80.0 innings pitched.
- He has only allowed 25 walks and hit three batters in his career.
- He has a 3.72 strikeout-to-walk ratio in his career.
- He has not thrown a wild pitch in his career.
- He has made 63 relief appearances in three seasons as a pitcher after playing his first season (2022) at Clemson as a catcher.

JARRELL POSTING POWER NUMBERS

- Junior catcher Jacob Jarrell has been one of the team's top power hitters in 2025.
- He was named to the Buster Posey Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He leads the team in homers with 11, including nine in the last 21 games.
- He is hitting .255 with 11 homers, four doubles, 30 RBIs, 35 runs and a .388 on-base percentage in 46 games (44 starts) in 2025.
- He is hitting .278 with seven homers, four doubles, 17 RBIs, 19 runs and a .556 slugging percentage in 24 ACC regular-season games.
- He has two two-homer games in 2025, at Georgia Tech on March 28 and against Gardner-Webb on April 9.

- Sophomore righty Aidan Knaak is continuing where he left off in 2024 by piling up strikeouts in 2025.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is 6-1 with a 4.66 ERA, .224 opponents' batting average and 80 strikeouts against 20 walks in 65.2 innings pitched over 12 starts.
- He has a 10.96 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in 2025.
- Clemson has a 10-2 record in his 12 starts in 2025.
- In eight ACC regular-season starts, he is 4-1 with a 4.40 ERA, .225 opponents' batting average and 48 strikeouts in 47.0 innings pitched.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with 12 strikeouts against one walk to earn the win against Notre Dame on March 14.
- He allowed two hits, one run and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win against No. 11 Wake Forest on March 21.
- He was named Perfect Game National Pitcher-of-the-Week and NCBWA National Co-Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts.
- He was named ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts, as it was the third time in his career he earned that accolade.

- Senior and transfer outfielder Dominic Listi has become the starter in left field and leadoff batter while bringing energy to the team.
- He is hitting .298 with three homers, a triple, 12 doubles, 38 RBIs, 48 runs, 50 walks and a .515 on-base percentage in 49 games.
- The last Tiger with a .500 on-base percentage in a season was Seth Beer in 2016, when he had a .535 on-base percentage.

MAHLSTEDT SOLID ON & OFF THE FIELD

- Senior and sidearm righthander Lucas Mahlstedt has been one of the team's best relievers since transferring to Clemson for the 2024 season.
- He was named to the National Pitcher-of-the-Year Watch List in April.
- He was named to the NCBWA Stopper-of-the-Year Watch List in April.
- He is 2-0 with 15 saves, a 1.95 ERA, .223 opponents' batting average and 51 strikeouts against five walks in 37.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- He leads the nation in saves (through games of May 4).

- His 15 saves are tied for the Tiger single-season record, shared with Nick Glaser in 2000.
- He has only allowed eight extra-base hits, including only two homers.
- He pitched 3.0 innings, allowing no hits, no runs and no walks with four strikeouts to record the save against South Carolina on Feb. 28.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn the win against No. 11 Wake Forest on March 23.
- He pitched 3.0 innings, allowing no runs and no walks with five strikeouts to record the save against Stanford on April 12.

- He is hitting .268 with nine homers, a triple, eight doubles, 44 RBIs, 35 runs and six steals in 49 games (48 starts).
- He is hitting .348 with runners in scoring position.

PRIEST SLUGGING

- Sophomore infielder Collin Priest has put up solid power numbers in his first season as a Tiger in 2025 after transferring from Michigan.
- He is hitting .262 with 10 homers, 11 doubles, 41 RBIs, 31 runs and 36 walks in 45 games (43 starts) in 2025.
- He also has a .545 slugging percentage and .432 on-base percentage.
- He had a 12-game hitting streak from April to May.
- He is hitting .289 with eight homers, five doubles, 26 RBIs, 15 runs and 20 walks in 23 ACC regular-season games.
- He has a .671 slugging percentage and .456 on-base percentage in ACC regular-season games.

- Sophomore Jarren Purify has always been solid on defense and one of the team's best leaders and energetic teammates.
- In 2025, he has become one of the team's top offensive threats.
- He is hitting .311 with four homers, three triples, nine doubles, 28 RBIs and 44 runs in 44 games in 2025.
- He also has a .444 on-base percentage and team-high 22 steals.
- He had a 21-game on-base streak from February to March.
- He had a 13-game hitting streak from February to March, as he was 22-for-41 (.537) with three homers, 14 RBIs and a .632 on-base percentage.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 10, as he was 12-for-20 with two homers, two triples, a double and nine RBIs in five games.

- He has 39 strikeouts and has only allowed 11 walks, good for a 3.55 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He pitched 4.1 perfect innings in relief with seven strikeouts to earn the win against Gardner-Webb on April 9.
- He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in his first career start to earn the win against No. 17 Louisville on April 18.
- He did not allow a baserunner past second base and faced three batters over the minimum, earning ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors.
- In his career, he is 8-1 with a 3.49 ERA, .210 opponents' batting average and 65 strikeouts in 56.2 innings pitched over 35 appearances.
- He also has two saves in his career.

FIVE TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2025

- Five former Tigers, Carson Spiers, Spencer Strider, Eli White, Weston Wilson and Justin Wroblewski, have played in an MLB game in 2025.
- Spiers, who had a 2.47 ERA at Clemson from 2017-20, made his MLB debut as a starter with the Cincinnati Reds on Sept. 3, 2023.
- Strider, who had a 5-2 record in his two active seasons (2018,20) at Clemson, was a 2023 MLB All-Star Game selection.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Wilson, who hit .260 with 94 RBIs at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Philadelphia Phillies on Aug. 9, 2023.
- Wroblewski, who played one season (2019) at Clemson before transferring, made his MLB debut with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 7, 2024.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2021 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
- Clemson has had at least one former Tiger play in an MLB game each of the last 70 years (streak started in 1956).
- Clemson has had multiple former Tigers play in an MLB game each of the last 52 years (streak started in 1974).
- Clemson set a school record with 12 former Tigers in the majors in 2021, breaking the previous record of eight.
