Clemson seeks bounceback year

- After a College Cup appearance in 2023, the 2024 Clemson Tigers established a promising 4-1 record before injuries to key players triggered two different winless streaks—a six-match midseason skid and a four-match slide to end the season. Among those returning from injury, Nona Reason, Dani Davis and Renee Lyles are back for the 2025 campaign, aiming to help Clemson recapture its 2023 success.

Who are the returning starters?

- The Tigers have eight returning players who started at least 10 games last year. This list includes forward Maria Manousos (16 games), midfielder Kendall Bodak (15 games), defender Mackenzie Duff (14 games), midfielder Emily Brough (14 games), midfielder Anna Castenfelt (13 games), midfielder Christian Brathwaite (12 games), Nona Reason (11 games) and Dani Davis (10 games).

New Recruits

- Clemson finished the 2024-25 recruiting cycle with 11 signees who collectively made up the No. 2 ranked recruiting class according to TopDrawerSoccer. Incoming freshman with their prospect rankings include Carla Small (No. 8), Juju Harris (No. 9), Reese Klein (No. 11), Neely Kerr (No. 23), Jolie Jenkins (No. 26), Maddie Costello (No. 50), Elle Bissinger (No. 97), Alessandra Washington (No. 140), Madeline Parrott (No. 168), Natalie Brooks and Taylor Leib. The Tigers also gain Gr. Baleigh Bruster, a Duke transfer.

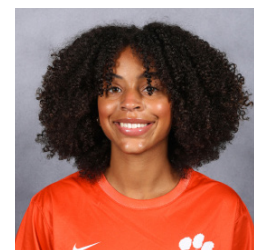

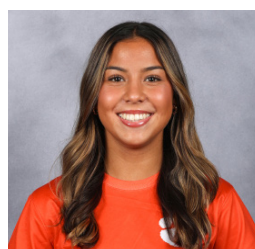

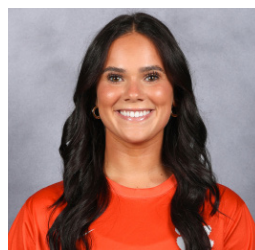
