Quick Kicks

Last Time Out

- Clemson defeated Boston College 1-0 last Friday, Oct. 24 in Chestnut Hill.
- Juju Harris scored her fifth game-winning goal of the season, seventh overall goal.
- The win extended the Tigers' win streak to four with the other victories coming against Syracuse, SMU and (then) No. 17 Wake Forest.

Tigers Rumble with Rankings

- Of the Tigers 16 matches played, eight have been against ranked opponents with the lowest being No. 18 Ohio State (8/14).
- Clemson has faced No. 1 (Virginia, 9/25), No. 2 (Notre Dame, 9/28) and No. 3 (Stanford, 9/11) teams this season.
- The Tigers are 1-3-4 against ranked teams this season.
- The other three ranked opponents were Virginia Tech (No. 15), South Carolina (No. 12) and Georgia (No. 15).
- No. 10 Duke gives the Tigers more ranked than unranked opponents this year.

New Recruits Showing Out

- Clemson finished the 2024-25 recruiting cycle with the No. 2 ranked recruiting class (TopDrawerSoccer).
- Juju Harris leads the pack with seven goals and six assists, starting in all but one match.
- Eight other freshman have made an impact including Neely Kerr (16 GS, 3 A), Reese Klein (16 GP-15 GS), Taylor Leib (13 GP, 2 G), Bissinger (12 GP-3 GS, 2 G, 2 A), Natalie Brooks (16 GP-8 GS, 2 A), Jolie Jenkins (16 GP-14 GS, 2 A) and Carla Small (16 GP-4 GS, 1 A) to name them.

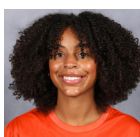
