# **NEED TO KNOW**

#### **RANSFORD (THE MAN) GYAN**

- •Sophomore midfielder Ransford Gyan has netted eight goals so far this season. His eight goals are tied for eight in the nation and second in the ACC.
- •He is also 10th in the nation and second in the ACC averaging 0.80 goals per game.

#### THE NOONAN EFFECT

- •Under Head Coach Mike Noonan the Tigers have earned two national championships (2021, 2023) to bring the program's total to four which are represented in the Men's Soccer crest. The four national championships are the most of any program on Clemson's campus, which has eight toal.
- Clemson has made postseason four of the last five seasons which is more than any other ACC school.
   HISTORIC RECORD AT HISTORIC RIGGS
- Since Mike Noonan arrived at Clemson in 2010, the Tigers are 127-39-17 at Historic Riggs Field.
- Last season, the Tigers were 9-1 at home, including going 4-1-1 in postseason play (ACC Tournament/ NCAA Tournament)

#### **OFFENSIVE POWER**

- During the Mike Noonan era, Clemson is 160-14-16 when the Tigers score first.
- Clemson is 115-6-8 under Noonan when leading at the half and 149-10-10 when the Tigers score
  at least twice.
- The Tigers are third in the ACC averaging 7.30 points per game.

#### **RETURNERS AND NEWBIES**

- Clemson returns ACC Freshman of the Year, TopDrawerSoccer Freshman Postseason 100-No.1 and TopDrawerSoccer Freshman of the Year, Ransford Gyan as well as 14 other returners.
- The Tigers added Gatorade National Player of the Year Xander Sevian to the 2025 roster, along with 10 other freshmen.

#### INTERNATIONAL BRAND

 The 2025 Clemson roster features 16 international players, including five from Ghana and two from Iceland.
