ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- In the last outing, KJ Lewis led a trio in double figures to lead Georgetown past the visiting Binghamton Bearcats on Wednesday evening. Vince Iwuchukwu came off the bench to tally an efficient 17 points on 5-for-9 shooting and a 7-for-9 performance from the charity stripe and Malik Mack scored 13 points, all in the second half, on 5-for-11 shooting and a perfect 2-for-2 effort from the charity stripe.
- Lewis was named to the first BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll of the 2025-26 season following a 2-0 week for the Hoyas. Lewis led the squad tallying 15.0 ppg on 47.4% (9-19) shooting from the floor. He grabbed a squad-best 7.0 rpg while he dished out 2.0 apg and managed 2.0 spg.
- A trio of Hoyas are scoring in double figures led by Lewis who is tallying 16.7 ppg, while Mack averages 14.3 ppg and Iwuchukwu manages 11.0 ppg. Lewis leads the Hoyas on the glass with 24 rebounds on the season, followed by Mack and Caleb Williams who have each collected 13 on the season. Jeremiah Williams paces the offense with 10 total assists, followed closely by Mack with seven and Lewis with five
- In its last outing, Clemson rolled past Morehead State 83–51 on Tuesday night in Littlejohn Coliseum. Jake Wahlin paced the Tigers with a season-high 14 points, while RJ Godfrey posted his first double-double of the year with 13 points and 11 rebounds.

RETURN OF THE MACK

- MALIK MACK WAS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST THIRD TEAM AND IS ONE OF A TRIO OF HOYAS AVERAGING DOUBLE FIGURES.
- THE OXON HILL NATIVE IS COMING OFF A SOPHOMORE SEASON WHERE HE PLAYED IN AND STARTED 32 GAMES. AVERAGING 34.8 MINUTES. 12.9 POINTS. 4.3 ASSISTS AND 3.6 REBOUNDS PER GAME WHILE SHOOTING 35.5% FROM BEHIND THE ARC.
- MACK TALLIED DOUBLE DIGITS 21 TIMES IN 32 GAMES SCORING A CAREER-BEST 37 AGAINST WASHINGTON STATE IN THE FIRST ROUND OF THE COLLEGE BASKETBALL CROWN.



K.I LEWIS

- KJ LEWIS WAS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST SECOND TEAM AND IS ONE OF A TRIO OF HOYAS AVERAGING DOUBLE FIGURES.
- THE EL PASO NATIVE IS COMING OFF A SOPHOMORE SEASON AT ARIZONA WHERE HE APPEARED IN ALL 37 GAMES. MAKING SIX STARTS AND AVERAGING 10.8 POINTS PER GAME AND 4.6 REBOUNDS PER GAME IN HIS SECOND SEASON WITH THE WILDCATS.
- LEWIS REGISTERED CAREER HIGHS IN ASSISTS (106), BLOCKS (31) AND STEALS (49) WHILE ALSO SCORING IN DOUBLE FIGURES 22 TIMES.



HOYAS SELECTED SIXTH IN THE BIG EAST

- GEORGETOWN WAS SELECTED SIXTH IN THE PRESEASON COACHES' POLL IN HEAD COACH ED COOLEY'S THIRD SEASON AS THE LEADER OF THE PROGRAM.
- WITH A 16-PERSON ROSTER, THE HOYAS WELCOME SIX NEWCOMERS TO THE HILLTOP TO GO ALONG WITH RETURNERS SEAL DIOUF, JAYDEN FORT, JULIUS HALAIFONUA, MALIK MACK, KAYVAUN MULREADY, CALEB WILLIAMS, HASHEM ASADALLAH, AUSTIN MONTGOMERY, MASON MOSES AND MICHAEL VAN RAAPHORST.
- SEVEN OUT OF THE 10 RETURNERS, EXCLUDING DIOUF, FORT AND MOSES, ALL SAW PLAYING TIME A SEASON AGO.



KEY RETURNERS

- MACK LEADS THE RETURNERS WITH 12.9 POINTS PER GAME DURING HIS SOPHOMORE SEASON AND A SOUAD-BEST 4.3 ASSISTS PER GAME. CALEB WILLIAMS APPEARED IN 29 GAMES FOR THE HOYAS, STARTING 14 AND AVERAGING 4.3 POINTS AND 3.8 REBOUNDS A GAME, MULREADY APPEARED IN 22 GAMES, AVERAGING 7.8 MINUTES PER GAME.
- THE HOYAS WILL LOOK TO JULIUS HALAIFONUA TO MAKE AN IMPACT AFTER A SHORTENED FRESHMAN CAMPAIGN AFTER AN INJURY SIX GAMES INTO THE SEASON. THE HOYAS WILL ALSO LOOK TO SEAL DIOUF AND JAYDEN FORT, A PAIR WHO REDSHIRTED THEIR FRESHMAN SEASONS.

OVERVIEW

- Georgetown and Clemson will meet for the second time in program history with the Hoyas holding the 1-0 edge in the series.
- The lone meeting between the two teams was December 23, 2004 with the Blue & Gray taking the 75-60 win at the Rainbow Classic in Hawaii. Brandon Bowman led a quartet of Hoyas in double figures with 22 points on 8-for-13 shooting, followed by Jeff Green (15), Jonathan Wallace (13) and Ashanti Cook (12). Green is still playing in the NBA, currently with the Houston Rockets.
- This will be Cooley's first career matchup against Clemson.
- The Hoyas hold a 174-153 record against the ACC while Cooley is 11-20 against the conference.

ABOUT THE TIGERS

- Clemson enters the matchup with a 3-0 start to the 2025-26 season.
- The Tigers closed the 2024-25 season with a 27-7 record and a 18-2 mark in ACC action. Clemson wrapped up the season with a first-round loss to 12th-seeded McNeese, 69-67, in the NCAA Tournament.

BIG EAST AWARDS

- Georgetown University men's basketball junior KJ Lewis was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll, as announced by the league office in New York on Monday.
- The award comes after a 2-0 week for Georgetown that saw the Hoyas defeat Morgan State 87-70 in the season opener at Capital One Arena on Monday before making the short trip to College Park on Friday to defeat the University of Maryland 70-60 at XFINITY Center.
- In a 2-0 week for the Hoyas, KJ Lewis led the squad tallying 15.0 ppg on 47.4% (9-19) shooting from the floor. He grabbed a squad-best 7.0 rpg while he dished out 2.0 apg and managed 2.0 spg.
- In the home opener against the Bears, Lewis tallied 14 points on 4-for-7 shooting (57.1%) to go along with a 6-for-6 performance from the free throw line, while pulling down five rebounds to go along with three steals.
- At Maryland, Lewis nearly had a double-double with 16 points and nine rebounds. He dished out a trio of assists and managed one steal.
- This is Lewis' first nod to the honor roll and the first for the Hovas this season.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST

- Georgetown University's KJ Lewis was named to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Second Team and Malik Mack was named to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Third Team.
- KJ Lewis is coming off a sophomore season at Arizona where he appeared in all 37 games, making six starts.
- The El Paso, Texas native averaged 10.8 points per game and 4.6 rebounds per game in his second season with the Wildcats.
- Lewis registered career highs in assists (106), blocks (31) and steals (49) while also scoring in double figures 22 times.
- In the preseason exhibition against George Washington on October 18, Lewis led GU with a contest-best six steals while also chipping in six points, a block and four rebounds.
- Malik Mack is coming off a sophomore season where he played in and started 32 games.
- The Oxon Hill, Maryland native averaged 34.8 minutes, 12.9 points, 4.3 assists and 3.6 rebounds per game while shooting 35.5% from behind the arc.
- Mack tallied double digits 21 times in 32 games scoring a career-best 37 against Washington State in the first round of the College Basketball Crown. The sophomore dished out five or more assists 12 times and had 14 games where he drained two or more triples.
- Mack received BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll honors once last season.
- In the preseason exhibition against George Washington, Mack totaled 16 points on 5-for-8 (62.5%) shooting from the floor and 5-for-7 (71.4%) from the free throw line. The junior also pulled down four rebounds, dished out four assists and recorded two steals.
- The Hoyas were selected sixth in the Preseason Coaches' Poll, as announced by the BIG EAST Conference ahead of BIG EAST Men's and Women's Basketball Media Day at Madison Square Garden.

GEORGETOWN MOURNS THE PASSING OF PAUL TAGLIABUE (C'62)

- The Georgetown community mourns the loss of Paul Tagliabue (C'62), who passed away on Nov. 9, 2025, at the age of 84. Tagliabue served as the chair of Georgetown's board of directors from 2009 to 2015 after serving as the commissioner of the National Football League for 17 years. He is survived by his wife Chandler, his daughter Emily, his son Drew and his husband Mark Jones, and three grandchildren.
- Tagliabue was a member of the Georgetown community for over 60 years. A captain of the men's basketball team, class president and Rhodes Scholarship finalist, Tagliabue graduated with honors from Georgetown in 1962 before pursuing a career in law that led him to the NFL commissioner's office.
- In 2006, Tagliabue began his service on Georgetown's board of directors. He was elected chair in 2009, stepping down in 2015 while continuing his service as a vice chair until 2018. In his role, Tagliabue was a trusted advisor to university leadership, especially on athletics issues. He played a pivotal role in the construction of the John R. Thompson Jr. Intercollegiate Athletic Center, which opened in 2016.

PRESEASON EXHIBITION: HOYAS WIN AT RUPP

- Malik Mack led a trio of Hoyas in double figures as Georgetown University's men's basketball team defeated the University of Kentucky Wildcats, 84-70, at Rupp Arena on Thursday evening in Lexington, Kentucky.
- Mack led a trio of Hoyas in double figures with a game-best 22 points on 56.3% shooting (9-16) from the floor. He knocked down a pair from beyond the arc. The junior tied a squad-best five rebounds with Vince Iwuchukwu and a team-best three assists with Julius Halaifonua.
- KJ Lewis tallied 19 points on 8-for-13 (61.5%) shooting from the floor while also adding a rebound, block, steal and an assist.
- Iwuchukwu managed 14 points on three made buckets and an 8-for-9 performance from the charity stripe. Iwuchukwu's pair of blocks led the way as the Hoyas tallied six with a quartet of Hoyas managing one apiece. To complete his stat line, the senior managed a game-best three steals.

- Cooley was one of four current coaches to speak on the panel moderated by ESPN's lay Bilas. He was joined on stage by University of Maryland Women's Basketball Head Coach Brenda Frese, LSU Women's Basketball Head Coach Kim Mulkey and University of Virginia Men's Basketball Head Coach Ryan Odom.
- Also in attendance was Cal Ripken Jr., baseball's Iron Man, who holds the Major League Baseball (MLB) record for consecutive games played with 2,632, starting on May 30, 1982 through September 19, 1998.

HOYAS X DC SPORTS HALL OF FAME

- The 2025 DC Sports Hall of Fame class features seven individuals and one legendary team that have left a lasting impact on the local and national sports landscape. Among the honorees are former Washington Mystics guard and four-time WNBA All-Star Alana Beard, Georgetown basketball standout turned professional star Alonzo Mourning, Rich Chvotkin, the long-time radio voice of Georgetown University men's basketball, and Johnny Dawkins, a standout from Mackin Catholic High School who went on to a successful college and professional basketball career. Soccer great and Lake Braddock Secondary School graduate Mia Hamm was recognized for her global impact on the sport, while former George Mason University men's basketball head coach Jim Larrañaga and Washington Capitals television analyst Craig Laughlin were also among the 2025 inductees. The Team of Distinction honor was awarded to Washington's Super Bowl XXVI Champions, a group still celebrated for its dominant performance in the 1991 NFL season.
- Now in its 45th year, the DC Sports Hall of Fame was established in 1980 to recognize men and women who have elevated the Washington, D.C., sports community through their excellence. The names of all inductees are displayed at Nationals Park on a large banner over the left field plaza and inside the main concourse behind home plate.

HOYAS X 2025 NBA DRAFT

- Following the season, Thomas Sorber and Micah Peavy were both selected in the 2025 NBA Draft.
- · Sorber, a unanimous selection to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team and tabbed All-BIG EAST Third Team, was drafted in the first round, 15th overall, to the reigning NBA Champions Oklahoma City Thunder.
- Peavy, an All-BIG EAST First Team selection, was selected by the Washington Wizards before the hometown team traded the draft rights of Peavy to the New Orleans Pelicans
- It marked the first time a Hoya duo has been drafted since 2008.

HOYA KEY RETURNERS MALIK MACK

2024-25

- Played in and started 32 games; missing a pair due to injury. Averaged 34.8 minutes, 12.9 points, 4.3 assists and 3.6 rebounds per game while shooting 35.5% from behind the arc.
- Named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll on January 6 after GU posted a 2-0 week with wins over Coppin State (83-53) and Xavier (69-63). Mack averaged 20.5 ppg on 48.1% shooting, including 42.9% from beyond the arc. Over the twogame stretch, the sophomore chipped in 7.0 apg and 2.5 rpg.

ED COOLEY

HEAD COACH | THIRD SEASON AT GU | 20TH SEASON OVERALL STONEHILL '94

> Ed Cooley opens the 2025-26 season in his third season as the head coach of the Georgetown University men's basketball program.

Following his second year on the HIlltop, Cooley owns a 361-261 record over 19 seasons. His second season on the sidelines (2024-25) for Georgetown saw the Hoyas double their wins from the year before with an overall record of 18-16 and a postseason appearance in the inaugural College Basketball Crown held in Las Vegas. Following the year, the duo of Thomas Sorber and Micah Peavy were both selected in the 2025 NBA Draft with Sorber going in the first round with the 15th pick to the reigning NBA Champions Oklahoma City Thunder. Peavy was selected in the second round, 40th overall, by the Washington Wizards before his rights were traded to the New Orleans Pelicans. It was the first time since 2008 the Hoyas had a pair of draft picks and the two draft picks marked the first two NBA Draft selections of Cooley's tenure on the HIlltop.

> In two seasons, Cooley has coached a pair of athletes who went on to earn All-BIG EAST honors with Peavy earning a nod to the first team (2025) and Sorber earning a spot on the third team (2025). Sorber was also a unanimous selection to the All-Freshman Team.

> Cooley arrived on the Hilltop ahead of the 2023-24 season after spending the previous 12 seasons at Providence College. At PC, Cooley posted a 242-153 record, which included seven trips to the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Sweet 16 in 2022, a BIG EAST regular season title (2022) and a BIG EAST Tournament title (2014). In 2022, Cooley was the recipient of the Naismith Coach of the Year Award, named the Sporting News Coach of the Year, the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, the NABC District 5 Coach of the Year and the USBWA District 1 Coach of the Year.

Cooley was responsible for turning around the Friar program. Prior to his arrival in 2011, Providence had finished under .500 in six of the 10 previous seasons and made just one trip to the NCAA Tournament (2004) in that 10-year span. Following Cooley's arrival, he led the Friars to nine postseason tournament berths, including seven straight from 2013-19. In 2022, he guided the team to the NCAA Sweet 16 and the program's first BIG EAST regular season title. In 2014, he led the team to the BIG EAST Tournament title.

During his time at Providence, Cooley has coached five All-Americans. He also has had players earn two BIG EAST Player of Year honors, two BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year accolades, three BIG EAST Most Improved Player awards, one BIG EAST Tournament MVP, five BIG EAST All-Tournament Team accolades, two BIG EAST All-Rookie Team awards, one BIG EAST Sportsmanship honor and 12 All-BIG EAST honors.

Prior to his time at Providence, Cooley guided Fairfield University to a school-record 25 wins and a Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference regular season title in 2010-11. He was named the 2011 MAAC Coach of the Year and the 2011 United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) District I Coach of the Year honors as his squad advanced to the second round of the

In five seasons at Fairfield, Cooley's teams posted a 92-69 mark, including a 58-32 record in MAAC action. In 2010 Cooley was the first recipient of the Ben Jobe Award, presented annually to the top minority men's basketball coach in the nation.

Prior to taking the Fairfield position, Cooley spent 10 seasons as an assistant coach for Al Skinner (Rhode Island - 1996-97; Boston College - 1997-2006). During his time with BC, the Eagles advanced to five NCAA Tournaments and one NIT, secured the 2001 BIG EAST Tournament title and three BIG EAST regular season titles (2001, 2003 and 2005).

A 1994 graduate of Stonehill College, he was a three-time captain for the basketball team and was inducted into its Athletics Hall of Fame in 2019. Cooley began his coaching career at UMass-Dartmouth. He helped lead UMass-Dartmouth to a 25-4 mark and a No. 3 national ranking (1994-95). He returned to his alma mater to serve as an assistant coach for one season (1995-96).

Cooley is a native of Providence, Rhode Island and attended Central High School, earning two Rhode Island High School Player of the Year honors. He did a postgraduate year at New Hampton Prep before attending Stonehill. He and his wife Nurys have a daughter Olivia, who attends Georgetown University, and a son Isaiah.






