IT'S PALADINS

We're the "Pala-dins", NOT "Pah-ladins", "Pah-ladians", or "Purple" Paladins, just as South Carolina isn't called the "Garnet" Gamecocks or Clemson the "Orange" Tigers.

WHAT'S A PALADIN?

A "Paladin" is a knight on a horse, a paragon of chivalry; a heroic champion; a strong supporter or defender of a cause; and any of the 12 peers of French emperor Charlemagne's court. While history reveals knights were not always mounted men-at-arms, the modern image of a knight, mounted and in full armor, has undoubtedly influenced the concept of Furman's mascot.

WE'VE BEEN PLAYING THIS SPORT A LONG TIME

The 2025 campaign marks the 120th season of football at Furman, which has played 1,204 games (654-512-38) in its history (began in 1889). Furman's 654 victories are tops among all current Southern Conference schools.

SETTING THE SCENE

Furman's football team wraps up its 2025 season this Saturday when it takes on Clemson in a 4:30 p.m. contest at Memorial Stadium.



SERIES NOTES, ETC.

Furman provided the opposition for Clemson in the Tigers' first football game, played in Greenville on Oct. 31, 1896 (14-6 Clemson win). Clemson owns a 32-game winning streak in the series, its run having started in 1938 and most recently extended in 2022 with a 35-12, triumph. Furman's last win in the series, a 12-0 verdict, came in 1936 in Clemson. The last time Furman defeated an ACC foe was 1999, when the Paladins downed North Carolina, 28-3. From 1983-86 Furman went 3-0-1 against ACC foes, beating Georgia Tech in 1983 (17-14), N.C.State in both 1984 (34-30) and 1985 (42-20), and tying Georgia Tech in 1986 (17-17). Head coach Clay Hendrix was part of the three wins, which the Paladins registered with Hendrix as a starting offensive guard.

LAST TIME OUT

GREENVILLE, S.C. (Nov. 15, 2025) — Sophomore **Trey Hedden** threw for 275 yards and connected with freshman **Evans James** on a pair of touchdown tosses to power Furman to a 32-14 victory over VMI on Senior Day at Paladin Stadium.

The victory improved to the Paladins to 6-5 overall and 4-4 in the Southern Conference. VMI fell to 1-10 overall and 0-7 in league play.

After a scoreless first quarter, Hedden and James connected on an eight-yard touchdown to cap an eight-play, 68-yard drive to give Furman a 7-0 lead with 5:09 to go before halftime.

An 18-yard touchdown run by VMI's Leo Boehling tied the game, but Furman answered with a 6-play, 6-yard drive that took just 30 seconds and ended with a leaping grab by James to haul in a 17-yard touchdown pass with 30 seconds left in the half. **Jayquan Smith** rushed for the two-point conversion to give the Paladins a 15-7 halftime advantage.

Smith added a touchdown of his own to cap a 12-play, 85-yard drive to increase the lead to 22-7.

Ben Croasdale scored on a one-yard plunge early in the fourth quarter and senior **Ian Williams** added a 51-yard field goal to extend the margin to 32-7 before VMI capped the scoring with a 17-yard scramble by Nana Utsey in the final minute.

With nine catches for 70 yards on the day, James established a new Furman freshman season receptions record. He also owns the school record for receiving yards in a season by a freshman.

Ja'Keith Hamilton added eight catches for 90 yards while Croasdale rushed 14 times for 70 yards and a score as the Paladins compiled 448 yards without a turnover. The Furman defense limited VMI to 244 yards, 76 of which came on the Keydets final possession against Paladin reserves.

LAST MEETING

CLEMSON, S.C. (Sept. 10, 2002) — DJ Uiagalelei passed for two touchdowns and Will Shipley rushed for two scores to lead FBS fifth-ranked Clemson to a 35-12 victory over Furman in front of a crowd of 78,302 at Memorial Stadium.

Furman's **Tyler Huff** completed 30-of-39 pass attempts for 256 yards and a touchdown while senior tight end **Ryan Miller** matched a school record with 13 catches for 95 yards, including a 25-yard scoring reception in the second quarter.

The Paladins outgained the Tigers 384-376 and held Clemson to just seven second half points — a Uiagalelei touchdown toss to Beaux Collins with 10:08 to go in the third quarter.

Clemson scored on its first three possessions to take a 21-3 second quarter lead.

Furman took the ensuing possession and covered 45 yards to the Clemson 28, where Huff hit Miller over the middle to the Tiger 12, but the Paladin All-American was stripped of the football and the Tigers' Fred Davis recovered at the 10.

Following a Clemson punt the Paladins didn't miss on their next opportunity, moving 54 yards in five plays for a 25-yard scoring strike from Huff to Miller, who split a pair of Clemson

safeties to reach the end zone. A missed PAT made it a 25-9 game with 1:53 remaining in the second half.

Uiagalelei's second touchdown pass of the game, a 9-yard toe-tapping completion to Beax Collins at the side of the end zone, opened the second half scoring.

Furman's **Axel Lepvreau**'s 30-yard field goal with 48 second remaining in the third period cut Clemson's lead to 25-12.

The Paladins couldn't convert a couple of fourth quarter scoring opportunities, including a drive to the Clemson 1, where a fourth-down rush left left guard was stopped shy of the line of scrimmage.

NOTING THE VMI GAME

Furman's 32-14 win over VMI marked its 17th consecutive win over the Keydets in Greenville and improved the Paladins to 16-0 versus VMI in Paladin Stadium. Furman's 174 rushing yards (38 att.) represented a season high, topping the 142 registered in the 31-22 win over East Tennessee State. The win also marked the 60th coaching victory for Clay Hendrix, who is in his ninth season as the Paladins' head coach.

IMPROVEMENT

Winning six games in a season has never been a goal of Furman football, especially over the last half century that has seen the Paladins claim 15 Southern Conference championships and a national title (1988), but it should be noted Furman has doubled its overall and Southern Conference win totals this year after going 3-8 overall and 2-5 in SoCon play a year ago. Depending on results this coming Saturday, the Paladins will appear likely to finish fourth in the league standings, which is also up from last year's eighth place finish.

CLEMSON CONNECTIONS

Separated by only 30 miles, Furman and Clemson have enjoyed a number of football connections over the years. Two former Paladin players **Michael Dooley '98** and **Jordan Sorrells '09**, currently serve Clemson's football program. Dooley, a three-year letterman as a defensive end from 1993-95, is in his 21st year at Clemson, where he serves as director of football administration and player personnel. Sorrells, meanwhile, was a standout quarterback for the Paladins who passed for 6,278 yards (2nd in FU history) and 42 touchdowns (T1st in FU history). A member of the Tigers' program since 2014, he is general manager of Clemson's football program.

JAMES SETS FU FRESHMAN RECEIVING STANDARDS

Furman wide receiver **Evan James** caught nine passes for 70 yards and two touchdowns (8, 17 yds.) in Saturday's 32-14 win over VMI and, in the process, established new Furman freshman receptions and receiving yards standards. He heads into Saturday's season finale versus Clemson with 59 receptions for 760 yards and six touchdowns — all team bests. His six TD grabs are also a Furman freshman standard. James' record setting campaign has come despite missing three games (vs. East Tennessee State, Western Carolina, Wofford) with a shoulder injury sustained in a 31-13 win over Samford on Sept. 27.

MORE ON EVAN JAMES

Evan James registered a 10-reception, 134-yard, TD performance in the Paladins' 28-24 road win over Campbell on Sept. 13. The 10 catches set a Furman freshman record and included a 30-yard touchdown grab with 4:50 remaining to put the Paladins the lead for good. His performance versus Campbell netted him Stats Perform National Freshman Player of the Week honors and helped him make the FCS Stats Perform Jerry Rice Award Watch List for top freshmen in the division.

STONEKING TOPS FCS IN TACKLES FOR-LOSS, SACKS

Redshirt sophomore defensive end **Joshua Stoneking** continues to lead the FCS in both total tackles for-loss (20.0) and sacks (13.5) — a run that now extends for eight consecutive weeks. He garnered six tackles and sack for a loss of nine yards, a pass breakup, and a hurry in Saturday's 32-14 triumph over VMI. He is tied for the team lead (with safety **Taylen Blaylock**) with 73 tackles. Stoneking recorded four tackles, 2.5 TFLs for a loss of 17 yards, 2.0 sacks for a loss of 14 yards, and a forced fumble in Furman's 24-14 win over The Citadel — a performance that netted him SoCon Defensive Player of the Week honors for a third time this season. That followed a stout performance in a 31-22 win over ETSU on Oct. 4 when he registered seven tackles, three sacks, and two quarterback pressures. His three sacks fronted Furman's four-sack performance against the Bucs, and his second pressure, on the game's final play, led directly to an under-thrown pass that cornerback **Jordan Miller** intercepted and returned 95 yards for a touchdown to complete the 31-22 victory. He led the Paladins' solid defensive effort that tallied seven sacks in the 31-13 victory over Samford (Sept. 27), accounting for three takedowns on the way to earning his second SoCon Defensive Player of the Week scroll. In Furman's 28-24 win over Campbell (Sept. 13) he tallied six tackles, including 4.5 for-loss of 21 yards, 2.5 sacks, and a forced fumble. His final sack, which came on fourth down and with 16 seconds on the clock and Campbell at Furman's 17-yard line, secured the victory and earned him SoCon Defensive Player of the Week honors, as well as FCS National Radio National Defensive Player of the Week laurels. His 13.5 sacks thru 11 games this season ranks fifth in program season history.

TRIPLE THREAT SPECIALIST

Furman preseason first team All-America placekicker **Ian Williams** is perhaps FCS's top three-way specialist, and that was on display again in Furman's recent 24-14 victory over The Citadel. Williams contributed significantly in three areas of special teams play, converting all three field goal attempts covering 45, 36, and 21 yards to give Furman a 9-0 first half lead. In the second half, after The Citadel went up 14-9, he delivered a game turning 47-yard punt that was downed at the Bulldog 3-yard line. Three plays later, and following a punt from The Citadel 4, Furman regained possession at the Bulldog 40 to set up a four-play, go-ahead touchdown drive for a 17-14 lead. Three of Williams' five punts were downed inside The Citadel 20-yard line, and he recorded five touchbacks on six kickoffs. His performance versus The Citadel earned him his third league player of the week honor this year and sixth league weekly scroll in his Paladin career. In accounting for six points versus VMI (3x3 PATs, 51-yard FG), the Charlotte, N.C., product, climbed to 10th on Furman's career scoring chart with 228 points and into fifth sixth on FU's kick scoring ledger. Williams is 54-of-74 (.730) on field goals as a Paladin. His career kickoff touchback percentage (.730) is composed of 192 touchbacks on 263 kicks, with only two out-of-bounds kicks.

HEDDEN ON THE CHARTS

Furman quarterback **Trey Hedden** threw for 275 yards and two touchdowns in Saturday's victory over VMI and, in the process, climbed to third on Furman's single season passing yards ledger with 2,788 yards, trailing only **Ingle Martin** (2004-05), who holds the standard (2,959 yards, 2005) and second best mark (2,792 yards, 2004) in Paladin history. Hedden, who already has set season records this season for most completions (265) and attempts (365), needs 172 passing yards on Saturday to become Furman's new season record holder. The Tampa, Fla., product connected on 36 of 49 passes for a career high 358 yards and two touchdowns in a 31-22 win over East Tennessee State — the 36 completions representing the second most in Furman history while the 49 attempts ranking fourth. The 358 yards were the third most by a Paladin quarterback. Hedden's 4,555 passing yards rank eighth in program history.

INJURY, ROSTER UPDATES

Furman preseason All-SoCon sophomore tight end **Jackson Pryor**, who has seen action in only four games this year, underwent ankle surgery recently and will redshirt this year. Starting running back **Gavin Hall**, the Paladins' leading rusher this fall (437 yds., 3 TDs), suffered a fractured wrist against The Citadel and also recently underwent surgery. Inside linebacker **Ryan Earl** (11 tackles), a starter in the first two games (14 tackles), underwent hand surgery in September and is out for the season. Nose guard **Caldwell Bussey** (24 tackles, sack, blocked FG), who earned starts in Furman's first 10 games, exited the Chattanooga game early in the second half with a head/neck situation that required transport to Chattanooga's Erlanger Hospital, where he was released later that evening. He did not play versus VMI and will also miss the season finale against Clemson. Wide receiver **Ethan Harris** (21 rec., 223 yds.), who earned a pair of mid-season starts, has missed the last five games with a groin injury. He is not expected to play vs. Clemson. True freshman return specialist **Caleb**



Easterling has maxed out his NCAA four-game allowance that will still allow him to redshirt this year, thus he will not play versus Clemson. His 100-yard kickoff return against Mercer was the eighth 100-yard return in Furman history and first since Jerodis Williams' 100-yard return against Appalachian State in 2012. Easterling, who had a 76-yard kickoff return the next week against Chattanooga, averaged 38.6 yards on eight returns over his four games.

WELCOME BACK...

Furman welcomed back several players who were sidelined for much — if not all — of the 2024 season. The most notable return is redshirt junior running back **Jayquan Smith**, who was sidelined after sustaining a knee injury versus The Citadel in 2023 — an injury that kept him out for the 2024 season, in addition to spring practices in both 2024 and '25. Smith had six rushes for 21 yards against William & Mary, including a game clinching eight-yard run on a third-and-three play that gave Furman a first down at the Tribe 15, allowing the Paladins to run out the clock. Graduate tight end **Joshua Burrell** is back after a 2023 season that saw register starts versus Ole Miss and Charleston Southern before he suffered a season ending ankle injury four plays into the CSU contest. His return saw him catch five passes for 26 yards against William & Mary. Two players, safeties **AK Burrell**, a redshirt sophomore, and graduate **Justin Hartwell**, who a year ago were projected to start before injuries in the preseason sidelined them for the year, are also back this fall.

TWINS REUNITED

The 2025 season brings with it a reunion of twins **Joshua** and **Jordan Burrell**, both graduate members of the Paladin program and Blythewood, S.C. products. It's year two in Greenville for Joshua, a tight end and December 2023 graduate of Florida State who saw his 2024 season at Furman end early with an ankle injury. Jordan, meanwhile, is in his first year with the Paladins after playing the last two years at Lenoir-Rhyne prior to graduating last December. He spent the first two years of his football career at Army-West Point.

THREE SCRUBBED GAMES IN HENDRIX ERA

Due to devastating effects of Hurricane Helene last year's Furman-Samford game was canceled, marking the third Paladin contest — all home games — to get canceled in head coach **Clay Hendrix's** eight seasons as head coach. Other games canceled during the Hendrix era include a Sept. 15, 2018, home game versus Colgate, and a Apr. 17, 2021, home contest versus Wofford after the Terriers opted out of the pandemic spring finale. The canceled Colgate game was likely very costly, because the Paladins claimed a share of the 2018 SoCon championship in a 6-4, 6-2 SoCon campaign, but the six wins all but crushed their chances to earn an at-large playoff bid.

NFL PALADINS

Furman has four players on NFL rosters — wide receiver **Ryan Miller '23** of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, cornerback **Micah Robinson '23** of the Green Bay Packers, long snapper **Julian Ashby '24** of the New England Patriots, and tight end **Mason Pline** of the New Orleans Saints. Miller made Tampa Bay's 53-man roster, as did both Robinson with Green Bay and Ashby with New England. Pline is on New Orleans' injured reserve squad after being sidelined



in a preseason contest.

Miller, a three-time All-America selection for the Paladins, played in 54 games and made 43 starts during his Paladin tenure (2019-22) on the way to recording 151 receptions (4th in FU history) for 2,146 yards (5th in FU history) and a school career standard 28 touchdown catches. He signed as a free agent with the Buccaneers in spring of 2023.

Robinson was a four-year letterman (2020-23) for the Paladins who saw playing time in 42 games and made 22 starts while registering 103 tackles, five interceptions, and 21 passes defended. As a senior he tallied 34 tackles and two pickoffs in helping the Paladins to a 10-3 record, SoCon championship, and quarterfinal round appearance in the FCS playoffs. After securing his undergraduate degree in communications from Furman, he played the 2024 season at Tulane, where he totaled 33 tackles and a pair of interceptions. He was selected by the Packers the seventh round of the 2025 draft.

Ashby was also a four-year letterman (2020-23) for Furman and one of the school's most highly decorated student-athletes. He received the Dr. John M. Block Academic Award, which is presented to the male senior with the highest highest GPA, and the Dr. Gary Clark Student-Athlete Achievement Award that "recognizes a senior, female or male, who has embodied throughout their entire Furman career what it truly means to be a Paladin student-athlete through academics, athletics, campus involvement, and community service."

A summa cum laude graduate with a 3.96 grade point average in physics, he landed both Phil Steele All-America honors and College Sports Coordinators Academic All-America laurels for Division I, encompassing both Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) and Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). He handled snapping duties for all Furman PATs, field goals, and punts over his four seasons, successfully executing 412 snaps. He also played a key role in Furman's 10-3 campaign in 2023 that was highlighted by the Paladins' SoCon championship and quarterfinal round appearance in the FCS playoffs. Furman finished the campaign ranked sixth in the AFCA FCS Poll.

Ashby played the 2024 season at Vanderbilt, where he saw action in all 13 games and collected the second CSC Academic All-America citation of his collegiate career.

Pline played for Furman in 2023 after graduating from Ferris State. As a Paladin he caught 32 passes and two touchdowns on the way to earning All-SoCon honors. He inked a free agent deal with San Francisco in the spring of 2024 and was on the 49ers' practice roster all last season before being cut ear earlier this month and signed by the Saints.

Introduced as Furman's new head football coach on December 19, 2016, Clay Hendrix in eight seasons has returned Paladin football to its long respected level of national prominence and securely fixed his winning stamp on a program he has served for 31 years spanning four decades.

The latest evidence of Hendrix's successful work came in 2023 when Furman posted another 10-win season, reeled off eight straight victories, and claimed the program's Southern Conference best 15th championship, thereby clinching the league's FCS playoff berth and first-round bye. After knocking off Chattanooga, 26-7, in a round of 16 clash, the Paladins dropped a 35-28 overtime decision at second-ranked Montana, the eventual national runner-up. Furman completed the season ranked No. 6 in the AFCA final poll — the Paladins' highest finish since 2005.

The FCS playoff appearance in 2023 marked the fourth for the Paladins under Hendrix, who has compiled a 54-37 overall (.593) record and 42-21 (.651) SoCon worksheet as a head coach.

Furman's success under Hendrix, honored in 2023 as SoCon and AFCA Region II Coach of the Year, has been the product of many factors, including solid recruiting and player development/retention. That season five Paladins earned All-America honors and 19 players landed All-SoCon laurels, led by league offensive player of the year, quarterback Tyler Huff, and Jacobs Blocking Award recipient, offensive guard Jacob Johannung. In addition, two Paladins — Johannung and tight end Mason Pline — signed free agent contracts with the Las Vegas Raiders and San Francisco 49ers, respectively. This past spring two other program graduates, long snapper Julian Ashby and cornerback, Micah Robinson, were seventh round draft selections of the New England Patriots and Green Bay Packers, respectively.

In addition to on-the-field accolades, Furman registered impressive performances in other areas, including Huff capturing the prestigious Armed Forces Merit Award, as selected by the Football Writers Association of America. Approximately 60 percent

of the program's student-athletes over the last two years have earned SoCon Academic Honor Roll recognition, and Paladin football has remained a major factor in ranking among the nation's best in NCAA Academic Performance Rating (APR) and Graduation Success Rate (GSR) metrics.

Furman's results under Hendrix have extended his winning legacy, evidenced in the fact that in now 43 years of collegiate football, spanning his years as a player, assistant coach, and head coach, he has been part of 35 winning teams that have combined to go 336-188-3 (.640).

Hendrix returned to his alma mater in Dec. of 2016, following a decade as an assistant coach at the United States Air Force Academy. In his first season at the helm, he engineered Furman to an 8-5 campaign and FCS playoff appearance, improving on a three-win 2016 season and defying a preseason No. 7 SoCon tab by playing for a share of the league title in the regular season finale en route to finishing as a consensus No. 20 in two major FCS polls — a body of work that netted him SoCon Coach of the Year honors.

In 2018 Furman took another step under Hendrix's guidance, overcoming an 0-3 start and having its home opener against Colgate canceled due to Hurricane Florence by winning six of its final seven games, including a 34-14 triumph over FCS No. 4 Wofford. The Paladins' 35-30 road victory over Mercer in the regular season finale secured a 6-4 record and share of the program's 14th SoCon championship — the most by any school in league history.

In 2019 the Paladins delivered again, posting an 8-5 record and earning an at-large bid to the FCS

playoffs and AFCA No. 19 final national ranking.

After navigating through the pandemic season of 2020, Hendrix's 2021 squad won its final two games to finish 6-5 and set the stage for the 10-3 campaign in 2022 — the program's best since 2005. Furman paced the FCS in turnovers gained (29) and blocked kicks (10) in 2022, and produced the first three-time All-American in program history in tight end Ryan Miller, now with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers.

That Hendrix has orchestrated an impressive rebound of Paladin football was just what Furman football supporters envisioned when he was named the 23rd head coach in program history, which dates from 1889.

While at Air Force, where he coached the offensive line and served as offensive coordinator for five seasons, as well as associate head coach over the final seven campaigns, Hendrix played a pivotal role in the Falcons producing some of the top rushing attacks in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS). That productivity translated into a 77-53 record (.592), nine bowl game appearances, and four Commander-in-Chief Trophies, which is awarded annually based on head-to-head results among the three service academies.

Air Force led the Mountain West Conference (MWC) in rushing and ranked in the top 10 nationally eight times in the last 10 years due, in part, to the quality work of Hendrix-directed offensive lines. All told 19 Falcon offensive linemen garnered all-conference recognition and 21 players under Hendrix's guidance landed Academic All-MWC honors during his tenure in Colorado Springs.

In 2016 Air Force posted a 10-3 record and 5-3





mark in the MWC, won its fourth Commander-in-Chief Trophy this decade, and defeated South Alabama in the Arizona Bowl following a 27-20 win over 19th-ranked Boise State on Nov. 25. The Falcons ranked third nationally in rushing offense (322.8 ypg), seventh in FBS in third down conversion percentage (51.4), and averaged over 451.4 yards per game in total offense along with 34.3 points per game.

The victory over Boise State represented the final win in an impressive list of Air Force triumphs with Hendrix on staff. In 2014 the Falcons defeated 21st-ranked Colorado State (27-24) during the regular season and knocked off Western Michigan (38-24) in the Idaho Potato Bowl to complete a 10-3 campaign. In 2010 Air Force downed Georgia Tech (14-7) in the Independence Bowl, a year after beating 25th-ranked Houston (45-20) in the Armed Forces Bowl. In his first season there, the Falcons handed Notre Dame its biggest setback (41-24) to a service academy since 1963.

Hendrix paved his way to Air Force with an exemplary 19-year record of accomplishment as an assistant coach at Furman, where he served as offensive line coach each year, recruiting coordinator for three seasons, and assistant head coach over his final five campaigns. From 1988-2006 he helped the Paladins post a 155-77-1 record (.667), including a 100-45 Southern Conference mark (.690) that led to six league championships, 11 NCAA FCS (formerly I-AA) playoff appearances, a national runner-up finish in 2001, and the 1988 national championship — the first by a SoCon member school and a private university in FCS history.

Over his final eight seasons on the Paladin staff (1999-06), Furman registered a 73-28 record (.723) and 47-14 worksheet (.770) against SoCon competition en route to three league championships, seven FCS playoff berths, 2001 national runner-up campaign, and seven top 10 final national rankings.

Hendrix-directed offensive lines and powerful rushing attacks were central in one of the greatest eras in Furman history. In 1999 Furman knocked off North Carolina (28-3) on the strength of a 177-yard rushing performance by tailback Louis Ivory, and in 2000 averaged a school record 307.1 yards per game rushing to spearhead Ivory's run to the Walter Payton Award, the FCS equivalent to the Heisman Trophy. The next year a Paladin line featuring three All-Americans keyed a 12-3 campaign, highlighted by a 24-17 playoff semifinal road win over Georgia Southern that halted the Eagles' NCAA record 39-game home winning streak.

In 2005 a potent Paladin ground game was central to Furman scoring 64 touchdowns and averaging 470.0 yards per game — both school standards.

In recognition terms, 25 Hendrix-coached players earned first team all-conference honors and 13 garnered All-America laurels during his Paladin assistant coaching tenure. In addition, five products — center Steve Duggan (1990), guard Ben Hall (1999), tackle Josh Moore (2000), tackle Donnie Littlejohn (2001), and tackle Ben Bainbridge (2004) — captured the SoCon's Jacobs Blocking Award. A sixth recipient,

tackle Joel Bell, who was recruited and developed by Hendrix, garnered the award in 2008 and was inducted into the university's athletic hall of fame in 2022. Tackle Matthew Schmidt became the seventh Hendrix player to land the prestigious Jacobs Blocking Award in 2017, and guard Jacob Johanning selection in 2023 made it eight honorees.

Four of Furman's SoCon leading 15 Academic All-Americans — guards Eric Walter (1990 & '91), Adi Filipovic (2006), and Julian Ashby (2023) — are Hendrix products.

A native of Commerce, Ga., where he was a three-sport standout in football, wrestling, and golf as a prep, he starred as an offensive guard on the gridiron, helping Commerce High School to a 13-1 record and 1981 Class 2A state championship.

He came to Furman in 1982 on scholarship under head coach Dick Sheridan and over the next four years, including three seasons as a starter under the tutelage of offensive line coach Robbie Caldwell, played a role in the Paladins posting a 39-10-1 record, winning SoCon championships in 1982, '83, and '85, and finishing as national runner-up his senior year — a season that netted him all-state recognition. Furman also recorded impressive wins over South Carolina (1982), Georgia Tech (1983), and North Carolina State (1984 & '85) during his playing tenure.

Following graduation in 1986, he joined Sheridan's staff at N.C. State for the 1986 and '87 seasons — the first of which featured a Peach Bowl appearance. The Wolfpack beat ACC regular season cham-

pion Clemson in 1986 and the seventh-ranked Tigers again the following year.

He returned to Furman in 1988 as offensive line coach under head coach Jimmy Satterfield, and his influence quickly led to success as Furman registered a 13-2 record and claimed the NCAA FCS championship with a 17-12 triumph over Georgia Southern — the first national title by a SoCon school and first by a private institution in division history.

He and his wife, LeeAnn Hedgpeth '90 of Taylors, S.C., have two sons, Cal and Mac.
