COACH RIDDER ERA

Mercer head coach Ryan Ridder begins his second season with the Bears in 2025-26. He is the 30th head coach in program history, and came to Macon from UT Martin, where he led the Skyhawks to the 2023-24 OVC regular season title.

Across his first 11 seasons as a head coach at Daytona State, Bethune-Cookman, UT Martin, and Mercer, Ridder has posted a record of 205-139 and won six conference championships.

In his first season as head coach with the Bears, Ridder finished 14-19 and 6-12 in conference play. The Bears defeated regular season SoCon champion Chattanooga in the conference opener on New Year's Day.

NEW YEAR, NEW FACES

The 2025-26 edition of Mercer men's basketball is comprised of five returners and 11 newcomers.

Brady Shoulders, TJ Grant, Braeden Carlsen, Petras Padegimas, and Alex Koch return to Macon for the 2025-26 campaign. Only Shoulders, Grant, and Koch saw playing time with Shoulders starting 24 games for the Bears as a freshman.

Notable newcomers include Zaire Williams who transferred in from Wagner where he was named All-Northeast Conference (NEC) Third Team.

He was selected to the NEC's All-Defensive Team. He appeared in 26 games, making 24 starts and averaged a team-high 12.1 points with four rebounds and 1.9 assists. Williams finished 14th in points per game in the NEC and second in steals per game with 1.8

Ridder went to the junior college ranks to get Quinton Perkins II from junior college powerhouse Indian Hills.

Perkins was named an NJCAA DI Men’s Basketball All-Region 11 Second-Team selection and was a two-time ICCAC DI Men’s Basketball Athlete of the Week.

He averaged 8.0 points per game on 51.5 percent shooting from the floor, 48.4 percent from three-point range, and 78.0 percent from the free throw line. Perkins recorded eight games in double-figures, including five games with at least 20 points

Kyle Cuffe Jr joins the Bears after stints with Kansas and Syracuse. Cuffe appeared in 30 games for the Orange last season, averaging 12.4 minutes per game and 5.1 points per game. Had a season high 14 points and six rebounds against Wake Forest and scored 13 points while going 10-for-10 from the free throw line in a win against Notre Dame.

Baraka Okojie comes to Macon after helping lead the Memphis Tigers to the NCAA Tournament last season. Okojie played in 31 games for the Tigers making two starts. He scored a season high five points twice, against UAB and USF. Okojie had a season high four rebounds twice, against Missouri and USF. He led Memphis with four assists in its NCAA Tournament First Round game against Colorado State.

Armani Mighty joins the Bears after starting his collegiate career at Boston College where he played for two sesons before transferring to Eastern Michigan where he was forced to miss the entire season to due an injury.

In his sophomore seasonat Boston College Mighty played in 35 games, averaged 5.6 minutes per game, 0.8 points and 1.2 rebounds per game. He converted 9-22 field goals (40.9 percent), grabbed 19 offensive rebounds and blocked nine shots. Mighty tallied season-highs of six points at Virginia Tech (Jan. 23) and five rebounds at The Citadel (Nov. 10).

2024-25 SEASON RECAP

Last season the Bears finished 14-19 overall and went 6-12 in conference play. Mercer had notable wins including defeating SoCon regular season champion Chattanooga which was one of the Mocs’ thre regular season conference losses. The Bears also handed UNCG its first home loss of the season on Jan. 22, overcoming a 13-point halftime deficit.

Mercer averaged 76.1 points per game which was fourth most in the conference. Mercer’s leading scorer was Ahmad Robinson who finished with 16.9 points per game which ranked third in the SoCon.

THE 2025-26 SLATE

Mercer's schedule features 13 non-conference games in addition to the 18-game Southern Conference schedule. The Bears will play 15 games at home inside Hawkins Arena this season.

Mercer will travel to face an SEC opponent in its season opener which is set for Monday, Nov. 3 at Tennessee. Following the trip to Knoxville, the Bears will welcome LaGrange to Hawkins Arena for the home opener on Wednesday, Nov. 5.

Mercer will play two ASUN teams as part of the SoCon vs ASUN Challenge. The Bears will host Lipscomb on Sunday, Nov. 9 and travel to face Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Nov. 22.

Three of Mercer's final four non-conference games of the year are on the road. The Bears will visit Clemson on Saturday, Dec.13, Mercer will then head down to Orlando, Florida to play UCF on Wednesday, Dec.17, followed by a west coast trip to Pullman, Washington to play Washington State on Saturday, Dec. 20.

The Southern Conference slate starts on New Year's Eve when Mercer will visit Furman. Mercer's first home conference game is on Wednesday, Jan. 7 as The Citadel makes the trip to Macon.

The 2026 Ingles Southern Conference Basketball Championship will take place at Harrah's Cherokee Center in Asheville, North Carolina, from March 6-9.

SOCON/ASUN CHALLENGE

The SoCon and the Atlantic Sun agreed enters its second year of its scheduling partnership Each team from each league will play two crossover games against teams from the other conference.

Mercer's two opponents for the 2025-26 season were Lipscomb and Eastern Kentucky. The Bears defeated Lipscomb at home 92-77 on Nov. 9. The Bears followed the win over Lipscomb with a 95-83 win at Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 22.

SCOUTING CLESMON

Clemson is 7-3 this season, and is coming off a 67-64 loss to No. 10 BYU Tuesday night in Madison Sqaure Garden. The Tigers are undefeated at home this season at 5-0.

Clemson was picked to finish seventh out of 18 teams in the 2025 ACC Preseason Poll.

Clemson underwent its largest roster turnover under coach Brad Brownell. This past offseason that saw the 13 players from last season's team exhaust their eligibility or transfer.

Clemson was active in the transfer portal, adding Nick Davidson (Nevada), Carter Welling (Utah Valley), RJ Godfrey (Georgia), Jake Wahlin (Utah), Butta Johnson (UAB) and Jestin Porter (Middle Tennessee State). In addition to these six, Clemson also brought in four freshman.

Clemson is averaging 83.0 points per game and allowing 66.7 points per game. The Tigers are shooting 45.4 percent from the field and 32.6 percent from three-point range. Clemson's leading scorer is senior forward RJ Godfrey who is averaging 12.2 points per game.

TENNESSEE RECAP IN SEASON OPENER

Despite suffering a season opening loss at No. 18 Tennessee, 76-61, the Bears could take away positives from the game in what was the first game of the season that saw nine different players get playing time for Mercer who either weren't on the team last year or didn't see game action the previous season.

The Bears greatly won the turnover battle as Tennessee had 19 turnovers to just five for Mercer. Brady Shoulders tied his single-game career high with six steals and Mercer as a team had 15 steals in the game.

Down 33-21 at halftime, Mercer got into more of a rhythm offensively in the second half as the score over the final 20 minutes of the game was 43-40, Tennessee.

EFFICIENT OFFENSE IN WIN OVER LIPSCOMB

In Mercer's 92-77 win over Lipscomb on Nov. 9, the Bears shot 56.9 percent from the field and 45.0 percent from three-point range. All five Mercer starters scored at least 14 points in the game and three had double-doubles.

Armani Mighty and Baraka Okojie each recorded their first career double-double. Brady Shoulders had a single-game career high 14 rebounds to go with 14 points in a double-double.

BEARS GO 2-0 IN SOCON/ASUN CHALLENGE AFTER WIN AT ECU

Six Mercer players scored in double figures led by Quinton Perkins II with 20 points and Mercer rolled to a strong 95-83 win over Eastern Kentucky. Mercer went 34-for-61 (55.7%) from the field and 13-for-23 (56.5%) from three-point range.

HAWKINS ARENA

Hawkins Arena was originally opened in 2005 as The University Center and immediately vaulted Mercer to a position among not only the best, but most efficient facilities for any university of its size. The arena facility not only provides a premiere venue for athletics competition – basketball and volleyball – but as serves as a centerpiece for Mercer’s vibrant campus life.

The 3,200-seat main arena was renamed Hawkins Arena in the spring of 2012 in response to a \$1 million donation by Macon cardiologist, Dr. Chuck Hawkins, and his wife, Kathy. Hawkins Arena is home to Mercer’s men’s basketball, women’s basketball and women’s volleyball teams.

Hawkins Arena served as host to the 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 Atlantic Sun Men’s and Women’s Basketball Tournaments.

The facility is comprised of three main floor levels. The bottom level is home to Mercer’s Athletics Department offices and conference rooms. The lower level (arena floor level) houses team/locker rooms for each of Mercer’s varsity programs, visiting team and officials locker areas, sports medicine offices and athletics training facilities, as well as an aquatics area. The upper level includes Mercer’s ticket office, Board of Trustees meeting room, the President’s Dining Room, Bear Market and Heritage Hall.

Adjacent to the arena via the upper level of the facility is a food court and solarium-style eating and congregation area, floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the pool, weight room and exercise rooms, a fitness center, offices for University Center employees and offices for Recreation Sports and Wellness.

RYAN RIDDER

Head Coach ♦ 12th Season Overall ♦ 2nd Season at Mercer ♦ Embry-Riddle, 2008

A 16-year collegiate coaching veteran who has already left a trail of success through the first three stops of his head coaching career, Ryan Ridder was announced as the 30th head coach in the history of the Mercer men's basketball program on March 15, 2024.

Ridder trekked to Middle Georgia after leading UT Martin to 48 victories across three seasons, including a 21-11 mark in 2023-24. He has amassed a 205-139 (.596) record in 11 seasons as a head coach – a career that also includes previous head-coaching stops at both Daytona State and Bethune-Cookman.

Ridder bridged his first and second seasons in northwest Tennessee by leading the Skyhawks on a 9-1/2 game turnaround as UT Martin posted 19 victories during the 2022-23 campaign, a third-place finish in the final Ohio Valley Conference regular season standings and the program's fifth appearance all-time in the OVC Tournament semifinals. The 19 wins marked the fifth-most victories for the program in its more than three decades on the NCAA Division I level.

UT Martin boasted NCAA Division I's 23rd-ranked scoring offense (81.5 points/game) this past season, while also showcasing one of the nation's top rebounding teams as well. The Skyhawks captured 12 of their final 14 regular season contests to claim a share of the OVC regular season crown and the No. 2 seed in the OVC Tournament. It was just the ninth time in the 73-year history of the program that the Skyhawks had rattled off



20 or more victories, and the first time it had accomplished that feat since the 2016-17 campaign.

Prior to taking the reins at UT Martin, Ridder compiled 48 wins across three seasons as the head coach at Bethune-Cookman, including a pair of winning campaigns as the skipper of the Wildcats. In just his first season as an NCAA Division I head coach, Ridder steered the Wildcats to 18 wins and the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference crown. Following that magical season, he was selected as the recipient of the Joe B. Hall Award which is presented annually to the top first-year head coach in the NCAA Division I ranks. He was also named to ESPN's "40 Under 40" list of the nation's top assistant and head coaches in May 2020.

Ridder jump-started his head coaching career at Daytona State (Fla.) College where he amassed a 95-28 (.772) record and four conference championships from 2013-17, including back-to-back 25-win seasons in his final two years at the junior college powerhouse. The Falcons were consistently ranked on both the regional and national levels under Ridder who claimed four consecutive conference coach of the year laurels as well.

Ridder made the leap into the coaching world as a volunteer assistant coach for his father, Steve Ridder, at Embry-Riddle (Fla.) in 2009-10. He also served as an assistant coach at Campbell for three seasons (2010-13).

A native of Lexington, Ky., Ridder starred as a player at the College of Wooster from 2003-05 before closing out his collegiate playing career for his father at Embry-Riddle in 2005-06. He earned his bachelor's degree in aerospace studies from ERAU in 2008, and accepted a role as an assistant at North Raleigh Christian High School in North Carolina for the 2008-09 campaign. He earned his master's degree in sport management with a concentration in intercollegiate athletic administration from California (Pa.) in 2009.

Ridder and his wife, the former Jen Calnan of Daytona Beach, Fla., have three daughters - Brixton, Remi and Marlee.

JONATHAN MITCHELL

Assistant Coach ♦ 2nd Season at Mercer ♦ Rutgers, 2011

Jonathan Mitchell enters his second season as an Assistant Coach with the Bears in 2025-26. Mitchell joined Mercer after spending one season as an assistant coach with NBA G League's Birmingham Squadron in 2023-24.

Mitchell worked with G League players on their continual development of their game in hopes of being called up to the NBA. Mitchell worked with players such as Trey Jameson III who signed a two-way deal with the New York Knicks prior to the 2025-26 season.

Mitchell was selected to attend the TopConnect Basketball Symposium in the summer of 2025. TopConnect identifies the top assistant coaches in the nation and offers elite networking and professional development opportunities.

Before joining the Birmingham Squadron, Mitchell's most recent coaching stop at the collegiate level was at Stetson University where he was an assistant coach for four seasons from 2019-2023. Mitchell coached three All-Conference players and two ASUN Freshman of the Year players over his four seasons at Stetson.

In his last season at Stetson in 2022-23, the Hatters had one of their best seasons in program history, going 12-6 in conference play which was the second-best conference record in school history. That season, the Hatters ranked third in the ASUN in scoring and field goal percentage.

Prior to his time at Stetson, Mitchell spent one season in 2018-19 at Georgia under head coach Tom Crean where he served as a graduate assistant. At Georgia, Mitchell coached current Brooklyn Net, Nic Claxton who recently signed a 4-year, \$100M contract with the Nets in 2024. In his sophomore season at Georgia, Claxton was named a Second Team All-SEC selection while leading the Bulldogs in Led scoring (13.0 ppg), rebounding (8.6 rpg), blocks (81) and steals (34). Prior to beginning his coaching career, Mitchell embarked on a seven-year professional career, playing in several European countries including Spain, Israel, France, Greece, Hungary, and Iceland.

As a collegiate student-athlete, Mitchell was a reserve forward on Florida's 2007 NCAA Championship squad as a freshman. During his sophomore season, he appeared in 35 games for the Gators before transferring to Rutgers for his final two years. In two seasons with the Scarlet Knights, Mitchell was highly productive as a player, averaging 11.8 points and 6.1 rebounds as a junior, and leading the team in scoring at 14.4 points per game while being named All-Big East as a senior.

In high school, Mitchell was named as the New York State Gatorade Player of the Year in 2006.

Mitchell graduated from Rutgers in 2011 with a degree in Communications.



DANIEL MONDRAGON

Assistant Coach ♦ 2nd Season at Mercer ♦ Embry-Riddle, 2013

Daniel Mondragon enters his second season as an assistant coach for Mercer after spending the last five seasons as the head coach of Davis & Elkins College (NCAA D2) in Elkins, West Virginia.

In Mondragon's last two seasons (2022-24) at Davis & Elkins he led the program to back-to-back winning seasons for the first time in nearly 70 years. In the 2022-23 season, Mondragon led the senators to a historic campaign as the Senators finished with an overall record of 19-11 which marked the first winning season in 42 years and the most wins since 1959. Mondragon was tabbed the 2023 Mountain East Conference Coach of the Year. Mondragon coached two MEC All-Conference players in the 2022-23 season.

Before his stint at Davis & Elkins College, Mondragon spent the previous three seasons as the head coach DME Academy High School National Team. He was the first head coach of the new program and helped grow it into a nationally recognized prep team by competing in national high school circuits like the Grind Session. While at DME Mondragon coached several college players including now G-league player and former McDonald's All-American, Moussa Diabate.

Mondragon began his coaching career as an assistant coach at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in Daytona Beach, Florida from 2013 to 2016, helping to guide his alma mater to a conference championship and a 35-2 record in 2014-15.

Mondragon played for the Embry-Riddle Eagles from 2009-13. He became the first player in program history to be named a team captain as a walk-on. He was a member of three Sun Conference championships and an NAIA Tournament appearance in 2013. As a two-year team captain, he averaged 9.0 points per game and 4.9 assists per game as a senior



REED RIDDER

Assistant Coach ♦ 2nd Season at Mercer ♦ Embry-Riddle, 2016

Reed Ridder enters his second season coaching alongside his brother Ryan in Macon. Ridder joined the Mercer coaching staff prior to the 2024-25 season after spending the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at UT Martin.

In his last season at UT Martin, the Skyhawks boasted NCAA Division I's 23rd-ranked scoring offense (81.5 points/game), while also showcasing one of the nation's top rebounding teams as well. The Skyhawks captured 12 of their final 14 regular season contests to claim a share of the OVC regular season crown and the No. 2 seed in the OVC Tournament. It was just the ninth time in the 73-year history of the program that the Skyhawks had rattled off 20 or more victories, and the first

time it had accomplished that feat since the 2016-17 campaign.

In 2022-23, the Skyhawks finished second in school history in scoring (2,658 points) and rebounding (1,293) while ranking in the top-15 in NCAA Division I men's basketball and topping the OVC in defensive rebounding per game (28.7, seventh), fast break points (15.09 per game, ninth), scoring offense (80.5 points per outing, 14th) and rebounding per game (39.18, 15th).

The Skyhawks set a school record for most single-season All-OVC honorees (three) in 2022-23 in Parker Stewart (first team), Jordan Sears (first team and All-Newcomer) and KJ Simon (second team).

Prior to joining UT Martin, Ridder spent one season as an assistant coach at Daytona State in Daytona Beach, Florida. While at Daytona State, Ridder was instrumental in the development of a trio of NJCAA All-Central Conference honorees while Daytona State ranked third in the country in three-point field goals per game (10.2).

Ridder spent one season at Georgia Southern in a recruiting/player development role. He helped the team to a 13-13 season in the first year of a rebuilding process. After the Eagles returned just two scholarship players from the previous season (the fourth least amount in NCAA Division I), Georgia Southern led the Sun Belt Conference with 15.8 forced turnovers per contest.

As a graduate assistant at Georgia from 2018-2020, Ridder worked closely with a pair of eventual NBA Draft picks in Anthony Edwards (No. 1 overall pick in 2020) and Nicolas Claxton (No. 31 overall pick in 2019). Edwards was crowned as Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Year before the Minnesota Timberwolves made him the first Bulldog to become the top pick in the NBA Draft.

Ridder played professionally for two seasons following his collegiate career, competing in Spain (2017-18) and Australia (2016-17).

As a player, Ridder racked up 1,003 career points at a pair of NCAA Division II universities. He spent his freshman season at Lynn University in Boca Raton, Fla. before transferring to play his final three years for his father Steve Ridder at Embry-Riddle University in Daytona Beach, Fla.

An Ormond Beach, Fla. native, Ridder graduated from Embry-Riddle with a degree in business administration in 2016. He



LANGSTON HALL

Assistant Coach ♦ 1st Season at Mercer ♦ Mercer, 2014

Langston Hall, one of the most decorated Mercer men's basketball players in the history of the program, joined the men's basketball staff as an assistant coach in the summer of 2025.

Hall's No. 21 jersey hangs in the rafters of Hawkins Arena after having his number retired in 2019. Hall was a three-time All-Atlantic Sun (ASUN) selection and is Mercer's career leader in assists (633) and three-point goals made (256) and is second in steals (177). He is the eighth leading scorer in school history with 1,579 career points.

A 6-4 guard from Atlanta, Georgia, Hall was a four-year starter for the Bears from 2010-2014, starting 134 of the 138 games he appeared in. His senior season in 2013-14, he led the Bears to a 27-9 record that included Atlantic Sun Conference regular season and tournament championships and an NCAA Tournament berth that saw Mercer knock off No. 6 ranked Duke.

As a senior, Hall averaged a team-best 14.6 points per game, along with 5.6 assists and 3.1 rebounds per outing. He was named the 2014 ASUN Player of the Year and was chosen to the NABC Division I All-District 3 first team. Additionally, Hall was presented the Lou Henson Mid-Major Player of the Year Award.

After his playing career at Mercer, Hall played 11 years of professional basketball in Europe. He played professionally in Italy, Germany, Greece, Serbia, and Turkey. Some of Hall's accomplishments while playing overseas included being named to the Greek All-Star Game in 2018, helping guide Crvena Zvezda to the Serbian league title in 2021, and winning the FIBA Europe Cup championship in 2022 while playing in Turkey with Bahçeşehir Koleji.
