NUGGETS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Head Coach Nate Oats' 145 wins in his first six seasons at Alabama stands as the most wins in a six-year span in program history
- Alabama last faced Clemson in the Elite Eight in 2024, defeating the Tigers 89-82 to advance to the program's first-ever Final Four
- Alabama has scored 100 points or more in 101 games in program history, with Coach Oats' teams accounting for 33 percent of that number (33 games)
- The Crimson Tide are 1-1 in the ACC/SEC Challenge under Oats and will host Clemson for the second time at Coleman Coliseum in the Challenge
- Aiden Sherrell's five blocks against Maryland was the first UA player to reach that feat since Grant Nelson in 2024 vs. North Carolina in the Sweet 16
- Labaron Philon Jr. is the only player in the SEC to rank in the top-three in both scoring (No. 3, 20.6 ppg) and assists (No. 2, 5.7 apg)
- With the Crimson Tide being ranked No. 11 in the AP Top 25 Poll, Alabama has now been ranked in 35 consecutive AP Top 25 Polls (began on 1/29/24)
- Oats has won a program-record 33 AP Top-25 games during his tenure at UA, surpassing Wimp Sanderson (25 games)
- During Alabama's seven seasons under Oats, the Tide is 11-12 against AP Top 25 opponents during non-conference play, including two wins over the No. 1 team in the country and six victories over top-10 opponents
- Since Oats took over at The Capstone, Alabama has won 75 Southeastern Conference games and 150 games overall, which is the most in the SEC during that span
- Over the past six seasons the Crimson Tide has won 134 games, which ranks No. 8 in the country and No. 1 in the SEC.
- Going into his sophomore season, Philon was named a First Team All-SEC Preseason honoree and was named to the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List



LAS VEGAS, Nev. – The No. 8/9 Alabama men's basketball team surpassed the century mark for the second game in a row in a commanding 105-72 victory over the Maryland Terrapins to conclude the Players Era Festival.

Alabama (5-2) saw most of its offensive production from its backcourt duo of Labaron Philon Jr. and Aden Holloway. The pair combined for 37 points with Philon scoring 20 and Holloway adding another 17, along with a total of 16 assists between the two of them.

The Tide had five others in double figures including Taylor Bol Bowen (12 points), Davion Hannah (12 points), Aiden Sherrell (11 points), London Jemison (11 points) and Amari Allen (10 points). The performance marks the second straight game that six or more Alabama players scored in double digits.

Maryland (5-3) was led by Darius Adams' 20 points, off 7-for-17 shooting, including five three-pointers, to go along with three rebounds in 27 minutes of action.

TEAM STATS

- Alabama's scoring outing marks the third time in the last two seasons that Oats has had back-to-back 100-point games and his 33rd time surpassing the mark overall
- Alabama dished out 29 assists, a season-high, on 38 made field goals led by Aden Holloway's career-high 10 assists
- UA dominated the rebounding battle with a season-high 49 rebounds compared to 30 from the Terps
- The Tide shined on the defensive end of the floor as well, amassing a seasonhigh nine blocks, led by Aiden Sherrell's career-high five rejections, marking

the first time an Alabama player had five blocks in a game since March 28, 2024 against North Carolina in the Sweet 16

- Holloway (17 points, 10 assists) is the first Alabama player to record a double-double since Clifford Omoruyi's 10 point and 11 rebound double-double against Saint Mary's (CA) in the Round of 32 of the 2025 NCAA Tournament
- All 10 Crimson Tide players who recorded minutes netted points in the high-scoring contest
- The entire game was in Alabama's control, taking the lead just 16 seconds into the game and retaining it the entirety of the matchup with the biggest lead being 39 points (98-59), coming with 3:24 left in the second half
- As a team, Oats' squad shot 38-for-66 from the field (57.6 percent) from the field, 14-for-31 (45.2 percent) from three and 15-for-18 (83.3 percent) from the charity stripe

COACH OATS POSTGAME COMMENTS

"I thought it was a good two games after we took the loss against Gonzaga. We emphasized two main things. The first was rebounding; last night we outrebounded UNLV by 20, tonight we outrebounded Maryland by 19 and it was getting the ball moving more. Tonight, we had 29 assists and only 12 turnovers. It was the first career double-double for [Aden] Holloway. He had 10 assists with only two turnovers. I thought Labaron [Philon Jr.] had it moving along with Amari [Allen], they had six assists each. Kind of our three point guards that do most of the handling had 22 assists. I thought when we got the ball moving, we shot the ball better from three. When it moves like that, we were able to get some offensive rebounds and we kind of put them in a blender on offense."

- Non-Conference Success: For the first time under head coach Nate Oats and first time since the 2011-12 season, Alabama won 11 games during its non-conference schedule in 2024-25

When Nate Oats was formally introduced as head men's basketball coach at The University of Alabama on March 28, 2019, he promised fans would see an entertaining, up-tempo and fast-paced style of play. And that's exactly what he has delivered during his five years in Tuscaloosa highlighted by Alabama's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Final Four.

Oats continues to lead the Crimson Tide men's basketball resurgence to national prominence, having guided his team to 117 wins, highlighted by a pair of SEC Regular Season championships, two SEC Tournament championships, three trips to the Sweet 16 and the program's first ever appearance in the Final Four. Oats the only coach in program history to win multiple SEC regular season and tournament championships. He has compiled a record of 117-54 (.684) in his five years at The Capstone. In fact, in his nine years as a head coach, Oats owns an impressive record of 213-97 (.687) and has led his teams to NCAA Tournament appearances seven separate times with one of those years being the global pandemic.

After agreeing to contract extensions in 2021 and 2023, Oats received a third contract extension during the 2024 season that is set to keep him in charge of the Crimson Tide basketball program through the 2030




