THE OPENING TIP

- Pitt and Clemson play for the 17th time Saturday as the two teams meet for ACC play inside the Petersen Events Center. The game will be televised on The CW with tipoff scheduled for noon.
- Tom Werme (play-by-play) and Seth Davis (analysis) will be on the call on The CW.
- The game will also be broadcast on the Panthers Radio Network (flagship 93.7 The Fan) with Bill Hillgrove (play-by-play) and Curtis Aiken (analysis) providing the commentary.
- Clemson holds a 13-3 advantage in the all-time series, including 13 straight victories. It is Pitt's longest active losing streak against any program.

- Clemson is one of eight teams in the ACC to open conference play at 1-0 following their 64-61 win at Syracuse Wednesday. They are one of three teams to open ACC play with a road victory. Pitt dropped its ACC opener to Miami 76-69.
- Pitt is 5-7 all-time in ACC home openers and defeated Cal a year ago, 86-74.
- Along with the 13-3 record against Pitt, Clemson is 7-1 inside the Petersen Events Center. The Panthers' lone win was the first meeting inside PEC, a 76-43 blowout in January of 2014.
- In the last four years, Pitt has started 2-0 in ACC play twice and 0-2 in league action twice. Pitt has not begun 1-1 since the 2020-21 campaign.

SUCCESS AMONG ACC PEERS

• From the beginning of the 2022-23 season through the present, Pitt ranks tied for fifth in the ACC in league wins. Saturday's opponent Clemson is second with 44 victories. No other team than the six listed below have more than 28 wins.

SERIES NOTES

- This will be the 17th meeting all-time between Pitt and Clemson. Clemson leads the all-time series 13-3, which includes 13 consecutive victories. For Pitt, it is the longest active losing streak against any one team.
- Pitt is just 2-7 at home against Clemson, including a 1-7 mark inside the Petersen Events Center.
- The two programs have played a pair of overtime games, including last year's 78-75 Clemson victory. That contest snapped Pitt's 15-game home winning streak. Pitt won an 83-78 overtime affair on March 8, 2014, which also happens to be Pitt's last win in the series.
- Last year, Pitt rallied from a double-digit second half deficit and nearly won in regulation as Ishmael Leggett's halfcourt three caromed off the back of the rim.
- This is the first of two games between Pitt and Clemson this month. The squads will square off again at Clemson on Jan. 31 at noon.

NUMBERING THE NIGHTS

- Entering the Clemson game, Pitt has played 2,993 men's basketball games in program history. Game number 3,000 is scheduled for Jan. 27 vs. Wake Forest.
- Pitt has an all-time record of 1,728-1,265 for a winning percentage of .577.

LAST TIME OUT

- Cameron Corhen scored a team-high 17 points and Pitt put together a historic 20-0 first-half run, but the Panthers were unable to hold on as Miami rallied for a 76-69 victory Tuesday night at Watsco Center in both teams' Atlantic Coast Conference opener.
- Pitt led 43-33 at halftime after dominating the final 11 minutes of the opening period, which included a 20-0 run that is the largest Pitt unanswered spurt in ACC history. Miami stormed back in the second half with multiple runs to erase the deficit and claim the victory in the 50th all-time meeting between the programs.

- The historic run began with Pitt trailing 25-15 with 9:31 remaining in the first half. Corhen stopped a Miami 11-0 spurt with a basket off an Omari Witherspoon assist, and the Panthers were off and running. Damarco Minor gave Pitt the lead with a driving layup to make it 26-25, and Barry Dunning, Jr. capped the surge with a baseline three-pointer for a 35-25 advantage. The 20-0 run lasted more than six minutes as Miami missed eight consecutive field goal attempts.
- Miami took control in the second half with an 11-0 run early in the period to tie the game at 45-45, then took its first lead since the first half on the next possession. The Hurricanes built their advantage and sealed the victory at the free-throw line, making 20-of-26 attempts for the game compared to Pitt's 9-of-17.
- Corhen finished with 17 points on 8-of-12 shooting and added eight rebounds. Dunning, Jr. contributed 16 points, while Minor added 14 points and four assists. Roman Siulepa, who entered the game averaging 20.0 points over the past two contests, finished with 10 points.
- Pitt shot 45.0 percent from the field (27-of-60) for the game, including 53.3 percent (16-of-30) in the first half, but managed just 36.7 percent (11-of-30) in the second half. The Panthers were 6-of-25 (24.0 percent) from three-point range for the game. Miami finished at 44.8 percent (26-of-58) from the field and controlled the glass, holding a 43-28 advantage on the boards.

SCORIN' WITH CORHEN

- After averaging 11.0 points and 5.2 rebounds per game in 2024-25, Cameron Corhen has taken the next step in his game in 2025-26. He has increased those averages to 13.6 points and 8.6 rebounds per game, while shooting a team-best 54.5 percent from the field. He's blocked 10 shots and even knocked down six three-pointers, while also having the third-most assists on the team.
- Corhen is one of five players in the ACC (and one of 42 nationally) to be averaging at least 13 points and eight rebounds per game. He is one of 30 players in the country with those statistical averages while shooting at least 50 percent from the field.
- Corhen has four double-doubles on the season, tied for sixth among all ACC players. Three of those double doubles have come against high major opponents, averaging 14.3 points and 8.9 rebounds against those seven teams.
- His 33:56 minutes per game ranks fifth in the ACC and ninth in the country among non-guards. His 39 minutes against Miami were the most in any non-overtime ACC game (Virginia/Virginia Tech went three overtimes).
- In the season opener against Youngstown State, Corhen finishing with 23 points and 12 rebounds, while shooting 8-of-11 from the field. He followed that up with 14 points and 10 rebounds, while blocking two shots and adding two assists and two steals against West Virginia.
- Corhen's third double-double came in a 17-point, 11-rebound performance against UCF. He then posted his fourth double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Ohio State.
- In 2024-25, Corhen had a true shooting percentage of .635, ranking fourth in the ACC among those with at least 200 field goal attempts. True shooting percentage measures a player's scoring efficiency by accounting for two-

point field goals, three-point field goals, and free throws.

ALL GAS, NO BREAKS

- While Cameron Corhen ranks fifth in the ACC in minutes played in 2025-26, he's not the only Panther logging big minutes.
- Corhen, Omari Witherspoon, Barry Dunning, Jr. and Brandin Cummings each played all 20 minutes of the second half against Hofstra. Dunning played all 40 minutes of the game, the only time this year a Pitt player has never left the court.
- In the ACC opener at Miami, Corhen played 39:00 minutes, the most by any player in a non-overtime ACC game thus far (Virginia/Virginia Tech went three overtimes). Dunning's 37:55 was the third-most.
- Dunning had played at least 36 minutes in five consecutive games until Pitt's 40-point win over Binghamton in which he only played 24 minutes. He played MORE than 40 minutes in a game five times a year ago at South Alabama, peaking with 42:02 when he scored 46 points at Texas State.
- Since moving into the starting lineup for the last eight games, Dunning is averaging over 35 minutes per contest.
- Not even mentioned yet, Damarco Minor ranks tenth in the ACC in minutes played at 31:43. He has exceeded the 30-minute mark in 11-of-14 games this year.

ROMAN'S EMPIRE

- Freshman Roman Siulepa plays with a bruising style that complements his rugby background. He has a pair of 20-point games this year, tied for the most on the team in 2025-26.
- Siulepa made 9-of-12 shots and had a then-career-high with 20 points and eight rebounds against Quinnipiac. He also posted an assist, a blocked shot and four steals.
- That, however, was just a precursor to his 28-point performance against Penn State in Pitt's final non-conference game of the year. Siulepa was 10-of-16 shooting, including 5-of-6 from deep. He entered the game just 3-of-20 from three-point range on the season.
- Following the Quinnipiac game, Siulepa seemed to hit a freshman wall, scoring just eight points over the next four games. But he broke out with 12 against Binghamton followed by the 28-point effort against Penn State.
- His performance against Penn State places him among the top 10 freshman single game performances at Pitt in a number of statistical categories including: points (28 - t8th), field goals made (10 - t7th), three-pointers made (5 - t5th), and three-point percentage (.833 - t3rd).
- The top basketball prospect out of Australia and someone who has appeared on the radars of NBA teams since the age of 16, Siulepa was also one of the best youth rugby players in the country. Commentators praised him as one of the best high-school rugby players ever through the GPS system.
- Siulepa's basketball resume has led to claims

that he is the best prospect out of Australia since Ben Simmons. He has drawn comparisons to past notable NBA prospects such as Zion Williamson.

THE BATTLE OF THE BOARDS

- Pitt has been outrebounded in a game just four times this season and has won the rebounding battle in all seven team victories this year. In fact, Pitt is +9.4 on the boards in its seven wins and -2.4 in the seven losses.
- Five different players are averaging at least 3.5 rebounds per game and three players have at least 25 offensive rebounds on the season. Only six teams have more players (each has four players) with at least 25 offensive rebounds this year.
- As a team, Pitt has 29 more offensive rebounds (2.1 per game) than their opponents on the season. The Panthers have at least 10 offensive rebounds in seven of the past 10 games.
- Cameron Corhen is eighth in the ACC at 8.6 rebounds per contest and he has five double-figure rebounding games. Corhen has at least six rebounds in every game this year and is one of five players in the country to have 6+ rebounds in a game 14 times this year.
- Papa Amadou Kante had 10 against Youngstown State and then a career-high 11 against Bucknell and is averaging 5.4 per contest.
- Barry Dunning, Jr. is up to 4.8 per game for the full season. Starting point guard Damarco Minor is fourth on the team at 3.9 per contest. Roman Siulepa is fifth at 3.6 rebounds per game.

BRANDIN'S BREAKOUT

- Expected to be a key contributor for the Panthers in 2025-26, Brandin Cummings has been hampered by injury during much of non-conference play. But he put that behind him and looked like one of the top scorers in the country against Hofstra.
- Cummings came off the bench to score a career-high 34 points, including 30 in the second half, as he tried to rally Pitt back from a 17-point deficit. He went 8-for-12 from the field over the final 20 minutes, burying five three-pointers, and made all nine of his free-throw attempts.
- The 34 points were the most in Pitt history by a player coming off the bench and were the second-most by a Pitt player in Petersen Events Center history.
- Cummings' 30 second-half points were the second-most in a half in program history as well.
- As a freshman in 2024-25, Cummings showed his scoring potential in mostly limited minutes, averaging 6.3 points per game. He had a season-best 30 points in a win over Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 11, 2024.
- When healthy, Cummings has been the most lethal scoring threat on the roster. He averaged 18.5 points on 9-of-18 shooting (7-of-12 from three) over the first two games of the season. He then missed the team's game against Eastern Michigan and then two more (UCF and Quinnipiac) later in non-conference play. He played a scoreless 19 minutes in his return against Texas A&M before exploding in the second half of the Hofstra game.
- Cummings has found some rhythm coming off the bench this year. He has played five games off the bench, including the last three, averaging 13.2 points as a non-starter. He is shooting 43 percent from three off the bench and 54 percent from the field.

• Damarco Minor’s buzzer beating three-pointer against Ohio State set off “Pandemonium at Pitt” last Friday in the 67-66 victory.	
• It was the 40th game-winning shot in the final seconds in Pitt program history and the first since Zack Austin buried an overtime game-winning three pointer in a 91-90 win over the same Ohio State program on Nov. 29, 2024. Minor’s shot came 364 days after Austin’s.	
• While there were still 0.4 seconds remaining after Austin’s shot a year ago, Minor’s three-ball was the first walk-off winner that took Pitt from defeat to victory since Ashton Gibbs sunk a similarly long three-pointer to beat Providence 73-71 on March 4, 2010.

- Pitt had one of its most impressive offensive outings in program history in a 103-63 win over Binghamton just prior to the Penn State game.
- By shooting 62.1 percent (36-of-58) from the field and 59.3 percent (16-of-27) from three, Pitt had an effective field goal percentage of 75.9 percent. That ranks as the fifth-highest eFG% dating back to the 2004-05 season.

SUCCESS WHEN SCORING 80+

- Pitt is 53-2 under Jeff Capel when reaching the 80-point mark in a game, including a 12-0 mark during the 2024-25 season and a 3-0 record in 2025-26.
- The Panthers have reached the 80-point plateau three times so far in 2025-26, including two consecutive games to close non-conference play.

EARLY RETURNS

- Pitt started a pair of true freshmen in the season opener against Youngstown State -- Roman Siulepa and Omari Witherspoon.
- It was the first time Pitt started multiple freshmen in the season opener since Head Coach Jeff Capel put three freshmen in his starting lineup to open the 2018-19 season.
- Siulepa has started all 14 games thus far. Witherspoon started each of the first 10 games before coming off the bench for the first time at Villanova.

WHO'S GOT NEXT

- Although the 2026-27 season hasn't tipped off yet, Pitt is making waves nationally for its high school recruiting class ahead of next year.
- As announced on Nov. 13, Pitt has signed Chase Foster (IMG Academy / Baltimore, Md.), Anthony Felesi (Utah Prep / Hurricane, Utah) and Jermal Jones (IMG Academy / Riverview, Fla.).
- Foster is ranked No. 32 nationally by 247Sports and Felesi is ranked No. 48. Jones is currently No. 109.
- The class is ranked No. 6 in the country by 247Sports and was ranked No. 4 by ESPN.

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR

- Pitt went 17-15 during the 2024-25 season but the season had the potential for another 20-win campaign as the Panthers lost a number of close contests.
- Pitt lost six ACC games in which it led, was tied or was within one possession in the final minute of regulation. The Panthers' ACC Tournament loss to Notre Dame was a seventh such contest.
- In total, Pitt lost 10 games in which it led, was tied or was within one possession in the final six

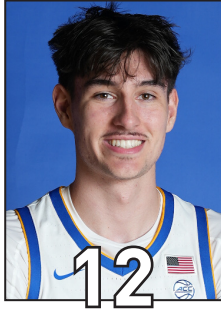

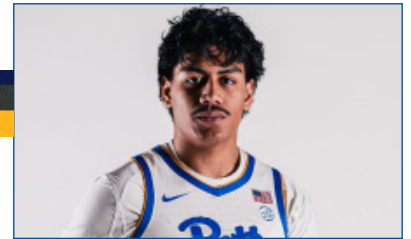
