THE OPENING TIP

- Coming off of a pivotal overtime victory against Wake Forest, Pitt travels to South Carolina to face No. 22/19 Clemson Saturday at noon. The game will be televised on the ACC Network.
- Doug Sherman will be on play-by-play with Scott Williams serving as the analyst on ACC Network.
- The game will also be broadcast on the Panthers Radio Network (flagship 93.7 The Fan) with Bill Hillgrove (play-by-play) and Curtis Aiken (analysis) providing the commentary.
- This will be the second meeting this year between the two programs. Clemson won the first meeting inside Petersen Events Center on Jan. 3

by a score of 73-68. Pitt led by one at the half and was tied with eight minutes to play, but the Tigers made plays down the stretch for the win.

- This game begins Pitt's toughest stretch of the season as the Panthers face four ranked opponents in the next five games (with all five teams receiving votes in the AP Poll).
- At 2-6 in the ACC, Pitt is in a five-way tie for 14th place in the league standings. The top 15 teams will qualify for the ACC Tournament.
- Clemson enters the game at 7-1 in ACC play and holds sole possession of second place (one game behind 8-0 Duke). Three teams are chasing Clemson just a game back.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES

• Clemson leads the all-time series with Pitt 14-3 and that includes 14 consecutive victories heading into Saturday's game. That is Pitt's longest active losing streak against any program.

• Clemson defeated Pitt on Jan. 3, 73-68. Pitt led 35-34 at the half and the game was tied with eight minutes to play before the Tigers pulled away down the stretch.

• Pitt has never won at Littlejohn Coliseum, going 0-5.

• Although Clemson has dominated the

win-loss record in the series, each of the

last five games between the two teams have

been decided by single digits.

LAST TIME OUT

• Freshman guard Omari Witherspoon drilled a step back baseline jumper with 15 seconds remaining in overtime to lift Pitt to an 80-76 victory over Wake Forest Tuesday night at the Petersen Events Center in the 3,000th game in program history.

• Witherspoon's go-ahead bucket capped a wild overtime period that featured six lead changes, and it came after Wake Forest had taken a 76-74 advantage on a three-pointer with just over two minutes remaining. After grabbing a defensive rebound off a missed Wake Forest three-pointer, Witherspoon was fouled with 6.7 seconds left and calmly sank both free throws to push the lead to 79-76. Roman Siulepa then picked off the inbound pass and Barry Dunning, Jr. was fouled, hitting 1-of-2 from the line to seal the victory.

• Siulepa delivered another dominant performance on the glass, posting his third consecutive double-double with 15 points and a game-high 15 rebounds, including eight on the offensive end. Dunning also finished with 15 points and nine rebounds for the Panthers, while Witherspoon tallied 13 points, four assists and two blocks. Brandin Cummings added 13 points, connecting on three triples, including a crucial wing three in overtime that gave Pitt a momentary 74-73 lead.

• Pitt trailed for 37 minutes and 16 seconds

of game time, but the Panthers never stopped battling. Wake Forest raced out to a 7-0 lead and built its advantage to as many as 12 points (23-11) in the first half. Siulepa kept Pitt within striking distance, posting 10 points and eight rebounds before the break, including six offensive boards.

• Down 36-30 at halftime, Pitt opened the second half on a 5-0 run as Cummings hit a three-pointer and Dunning threw down a dunk to pull within one. The Panthers continued to battle and eventually grabbed their largest lead of the game at 55-50 on a Nojus Indrusaitis three-pointer with 10:29 remaining, capping a stretch of four consecutive made field goals. Indrusaitis finished with eight points, going 2-of-3 from beyond the arc.

• Wake Forest battled back to take a 66-62 lead with just over two minutes remaining in regulation. Dunning answered with a driving layup to make it 66-64, followed by a Siulepa steal and thunderous dunk to tie the game at 66-66 with 1:02 remaining.

• Witherspoon's three-point attempt with 17 seconds left came up short, but he came up with a critical block on Wake Forest's final shot attempt to send the game to overtime.

• In the extra session, Siulepa opened Pitt's scoring with a three-pointer to give Pitt a 69-68 edge. Dunning pushed the lead to 71-68 with a pair of free throws before Wake Forest rallied to take a 76-74 lead. That set the stage for Witherspoon's heroics in the final 90 seconds.

• Pitt finished with a 42-37 rebounding advantage, including 16 offensive boards, that led to 20 second-chance points. The Panthers also converted Wake Forest's 13 turnovers into 17 points.

• Cameron Corhen contributed eight points, five rebounds and three steals, while Macari Moore provided a spark off the bench with five points, including a corner three and a transition layup that gave Pitt a 49-48 lead midway through the second half. Pitt's bench outscored Wake Forest's reserves, 26-16.

• With the victory, Pitt improves to 55-2 under head coach Jeff Capel when scoring 80 or more points.

SO CLOSE...

• Pitt's start to ACC play mirrored what the Panthers did a year ago when the team lost eight regular season ACC games in "close" fashion.

• In 2024-25, Pitt led, was tied or was within one possession in the final six minutes of regulation in eight of its 12 ACC losses. This year, four of the team's five losses in league action have been "close" defeats.

• On top of that, Pitt lost six ACC games a year ago in which it led, was tied or was within one possession in the final minute of

regulation. The Panthers' ACC Tournament loss to Notre Dame was a seventh such contest.

- Pitt became the 41st program in NCAA Division I history to play 3,000 basketball games when it defeated Wake Forest Tuesday night, 80-76 in overtime.
- Pitt became the eighth ACC team to reach 3,000 games all-time, behind North Carolina, Duke, Notre Dame, Syracuse, Virginia, Cal and NC State.
- Pitt has an all-time record of 1,730-1,270 for a winning percentage of .577.

DOUBLE DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Bear with us as we explain ... if two players have a double-double, those would be double double-doubles, correct? If so, then we'd call it double double double-doubles if those same two players had double-doubles in the next game as well, right?
- Cameron Corhen and Roman Siulepa paired up for the rare Quad D (here at the Institute for Naming Things, we think that's catchier than double double double-doubles) against Boston College and NC State with both players recording at least 10 points and 10 rebounds in back-to-back games.
- Corhen earned his fifth double-double of the season at Boston College, posting 13 points and 12 rebounds. Siulepa had his first double-digit rebounding game of his

career the same night, grabbing a career-high eight on the offensive glass, for 13 points and 11 rebounds.

• The duo did it again last Saturday against NC State. Siulepa followed up his first career double-double by grabbing eight more offensive rebounds and finishing with 15 points and 13 rebounds. Corhen had seven offensive rebounds and ended with 10 points and 10 rebounds for the 10th double-double of his career.

...BUT IT DIDN'T END FOR SIULEPA

- Roman Siulepa followed up those two performances with a third consecutive double-double Tuesday night as he went for 15 points and 15 rebounds in the 80-76 overtime win over Wake Forest.
- He is the first Pitt freshman to record a 15/15 game since DeJuan Blair had 15 points and 20 rebounds on Dec. 20, 2007.
- Siulepa also became the first Pitt player to record three consecutive double-doubles since current Washington Wizards player Justin Champagnie had four straight from Feb. 17 through March 2 of the 2020-21 season.

SPEAKING OF SIULEPA...

- Freshman Roman Siulepa plays with a bruising style that complements his Australian rugby background. His three consecutive double-doubles entering Saturday's game are the first three of his career.
- He has found a consistent groove over the past 10 games. He has scored in double-figures nine times after doing so just three times in the first 11 games. He is averaging 13.7 points and 7.6 rebounds during that stretch, shooting 50.5 percent from the field.

- Maybe the most impressive thing about Siulepa's game has come on the offensive glass, where he has recorded eight offensive rebounds in three straight games. He's also had at least five offensive rebounds in five of the past six games and leads the ACC in offensive rebounding (5.1 per game) in conference action only.
- Siulepa is one of only three players in the country averaging at least 5.0 offensive rebounds per game in league play, joining Mercer's Armani Mighty (5.4 per game) and Houston's Joseph Tugler (5.0 per game).

- In Pitt's final non-conference game of the year, Siulepa broke out with a 28-point performance in a blowout win of Penn State. He was 10-of-16 shooting, including 5-of-6 from deep. He entered the game just 3-of-20 from three-point range on the season.
- His performance against Penn State places him among the top 10 freshman single game performances at Pitt in a number of statistical categories including: points (28 - t8th), field goals made (10 -

BOARD MEETING

- Behind the ferocious rebounding of Roman Siulepa, Pitt has become one of the best offensive rebounding teams in the country. The Panthers rank third in the ACC in offensive rebounding at 13.0 offensive rebounds per game in league play.
- That doesn't tell the entire story, though, as Pitt has posted at least 15 offensive rebounds in each of the last three games and is averaging 19.0 per game during that stretch. Pitt is outrebounding its opponents by 10.3 per game over those last three games.
- Pitt had a remarkable 26 offensive

rebounds against NC State, winning the rebounding battle 52-31. That was the most lopsided Pitt rebounding total since the Panthers held a 46-24 advantage in the season opener against Youngstown State.

- The last time Pitt had at least 26 offensive rebounds in a game came when the team also had 26 against Wake Forest on Feb. 16, 2016.

CONSISTENT CAM CORHEN

- After averaging 11.0 points and 5.2 rebounds per game in 2024-25, Cameron Corhen has taken the next step in his game in 2025-26. This year, he averages 12.3 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Corhen leads the team with a field goal percentage of 52.9 percent and has made 8-of-21 three-pointers (38.1 percent).

- Corhen has been Mr. Reliable for the Panthers in 2025-26. He has scored in double figures in 15-of-21 games this year and had brought down at least six rebounds 17 times. Corhen ranks third in the ACC in minutes played at 34:09 per contest.

- Corhen also has six double-doubles on the season with five of those coming against high major opponents.

- In the season opener against Youngstown State, Corhen finishing with 23 points and 12 rebounds, while shooting 8-of-11 from the field. He followed that up with 14 points and 10 rebounds, while blocking two shots and adding two assists and two steals against West Virginia.

- Corhen's third double-double came in a 17-point, 11-rebound performance against UCF. He then posted his fourth double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Ohio State.

- Against Boston College, Corhen posted another double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds. He followed that up with 10 points and 10 rebounds last Saturday against NC State for back-to-back double-doubles.

- At 34:09 minutes per game, Corhen ranks third in the ACC. He is ninth in the country in minutes played among non-guards.

- Against Syracuse, Corhen played all 40 minutes for the first time in his career and he ranks fourth in the league in minutes

played in ACC games only at more than 35 per contest.

- Teams are shooting 34.7 percent from three-point range this year against the Panthers. But the split between wins and losses has been stark.
- Opponent three-point shooting has been a critical factor in determining Pitt's games. The Panthers are holding opponents to just 29.6 percent from three in their nine wins but opponents are shooting 38.5 percent in the team's 12 losses.

BENCH MOB

- Head Coach Jeff Capel has employed an eight-man rotation (and sometimes seven) for most of the 2025-26 season, with varying levels of production throughout much of non-conference play. But once ACC play began, the Pitt bench has become one of the best in the league.
- Pitt's bench has outscored its opponent's bench in six straight games and 7-of-8 ACC games in total, only being outscored 26-19 by Clemson.
- The Panthers got a season-high 39 points from its bench at Georgia Tech as Pitt rolled to a win. Pitt's ACC low has been 12 points but it still outscored Miami's bench in that game, 12-2.
- Pitt's bench has reached double-digits in scoring in 13 straight games since being shut out in a win over Ohio State and is averaging 22.4 points in ACC play.

ACC-LIMATION PERIOD

- Nojas Indrusaitis got off to a slow start in ACC play, going 0-for-12 from the field, missing all five of his three-point attempts and two free-throws over the first three games. He went scoreless in those contests.
- Indrusaitis broke out of the slump in Pitt's win at Georgia Tech, tying a career-high with 16 points. In the five games since that early slump, he is 12-of-24 (50.0 percent) from three-point range and has made at least two three-pointers in each of those games.

BRANDIN'S BENCH COOKING

- Brandin Cummings earned a spot back into the starting lineup last week at Boston College. Prior to that, he had led the team in scoring for three straight games while coming off the bench in each of them. He averaged 21.0 points per game during that stretch.
- Cummings was 11-of-17 shooting and 5-of-5 from the free-throw line for 29 points against Syracuse. He followed that up with 23 points at Georgia Tech, making three three-pointers. He had a team-high 11 points against Louisville.
- In his career, Cummings has three of the top five bench scoring performances in Pitt history.
- Cummings came off the bench to score a career-high 34 points against Hofstra on

Dec. 7, including 30 in the second half, as he tried to rally Pitt back from a 17-point deficit. He went 8-for-12 from the field over the final 20 minutes, burying five three-pointers, and made all nine of his free-throw attempts.

- The 34 points were the most in Pitt history by a player coming off the bench and were the second-most by a Pitt player (starter or non-starter) in Petersen Events Center history. It is the most points by a non-starter in the ACC since Virginia's Sean Singletary had 41 against Miami on March 1, 2008.
- Cummings' 30 second-half points were the second-most in a half in program history as well.
- As a freshman in 2024-25, Cummings had a season-best 30 points in a win over

Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 11, 2024. As with the other performances, he came off the bench in that contest.

- Cummings has two of the top three scoring performances by a non-starter in the ACC this year. Combined with teammate Barry Dunning, Jr., Pitt players account for four of the seven highest scoring bench performances in the ACC this year.

MAJOR MINOR

- Fifth-year point guard Damarco "Polo" Minor has taken the long road to get to Pitt, but is leading the Panthers in 2025-26.
- Minor began his collegiate career in junior college at South Suburban College for the 2021-22 season and then spent two years at SIU Edwardsville, culminating in First Team All-OVC honors. He transferred to Oregon State for the 2024-25 season.
- With 1,308 career points and 361 career assists to his name prior to the start of the season, Minor brings experience to the Panthers. He played in his 100th career game at the NCAA Division I level when he got the starting nod against Youngstown State in the season opener.
- In the win over Eastern Michigan, Minor had 12 points, seven rebounds, six assists and four steals, while playing almost 38 minutes. He became just the third player in the NCAA this year to post a 12/7/6/4 game.
- Minor is averaging 9.4 points and 3.6 rebounds, while leading the team in assists (3.6 per game) and steals (1.5 per game).

Minor is also shooting 90.2 percent (37-of-41) at the free-throw line and leads the team from three-point range at 37.4 percent (37-of-99).

HOME SWEET HOME

- Pitt has compiled a 324-102 (.761) record, including a 189-20 (.904) ledger in non-conference play, at the Petersen Events Center.
- Pitt is 28-30 (.483) versus teams ranked in the top 25 of the AP Poll at the Petersen Events Center, with a 14-10 (.583) mark against top-10 teams and a 9-4 (.692) ledger versus teams ranked in the top-5.
- Pitt played six games at home in the month of November, the most since also playing six home games in November of 2021. The Panthers have never played seven games at home in the month of November.

PANDEMONIUM AT PITTS

- Damarco Minor's buzzer beating three-pointer against Ohio State set off "Pandemonium at Pitt" in the 67-66 victory.
- It was the 40th game-winning shot in the final seconds in Pitt program history and the first since Zack Austin buried an overtime game-winning three pointer in a 91-90 win over the same Ohio State program on Nov. 29, 2024. Minor's shot came 364 days after Austin's.
- While there were still 0.4 seconds remaining after Austin's shot a year ago, Minor's three-ball was the first walk-off winner that took Pitt from defeat to victory since Ashton Gibbs sunk a similarly long three-pointer to beat Providence 73-71 on March 4, 2010.
- The Gibbs' winner was eerily similar as Pitt had 3.5 seconds to go the length of the court. Much like Minor, Gibbs caught the inbounds pass and dribbled his way up the court before pulling up and walking it off.

EARLY RETURNS

- Pitt started a pair of true freshmen in the season opener against Youngstown State -- Roman Siulepa and Omari Witherspoon.
- It was the first time Pitt started multiple freshmen in the season opener since Head Coach Jeff Capel put three freshmen in his starting lineup to open the 2018-19 season.
- Siulepa has started all 21 games thus far. Witherspoon started each of the first 10 games before coming off the bench for the first time at Villanova.

WHO'S GOT NEXT

- Although the 2026-27 season hasn't tipped off yet, Pitt is making waves nationally for its high school recruiting class ahead of next year.
- As announced on Nov. 13, Pitt has signed Chase Foster (IMG Academy / Baltimore, Md.), Anthony Felesi (Utah Prep / Hurricane, Utah) and Jermal Jones (IMG Academy / Riverview, Fla.).
- Felesi is ranked No. 35 nationally by 247sports, followed by Foster at No. 37 and Jones at No. 109. In ESPN's individual rankings, Foster is No. 47, Felesi No. 58 and Jones No. 83.

- As of Jan. 29, Pitt's class is ranked No. 8 in the country by 247sports (No. 2 in the ACC) and No. 7 nationally by ESPN (also second in the ACC).

THE PATH TO THE NBA

- As the 2025-26 NBA season is underway, there are four former Pitt players who have seen action in the NBA so far this year.
- Steven Adams ranks third in the NBA with 4.5 offensive rebounds per game.






