PACK TRACKS

- » NC State fell to Georgia Tech, 78-74, on Saturday. NC State shot 38.7 percent in the loss, the second-lowest field goal percentage of the season for the Pack and just the third time this season that NC State has shot below 40 percent from the field.
- » Quadir Copeland led NC State with 16 points and six assists against the Yellow Jackets. He added three steals in the loss. The Philadelphia, Pa., native continues to stuff the stat sheet this season. Over the last 12 games, Copeland is averaging 14.9 points, 6.8 assists, and 2.0 steals per game while shooting 53.8 percent (64-of-119) from the field. The senior has led the Pack in scoring in six of the last 12 games, in assists in 11 of the last 12 games (including the last 10 games) and in steals in six of the last 12 games.
- » NC State tied the program record with 19 made three-pointers in the win over Florida State on Jan. 10. It also tied an ACC record for most three-pointers by a single team in an ACC game. It's the third time in program history that NC State has made 19 three-pointers in a game and the second time this season (NC State also hit 19 three-pointers in the season-opening win over NC Central.) The Pack started the game 1-for-9 from long range, but then made seven straight three-pointers as it made 18 of its final 26 three-point attempts in the win at FSU.
- » NC State has had double-digit three-pointers in 10 of 18 games this season. The Pack has had two games with 19 made three-pointers, a game with 17 made threes and another game with 16 made threes. The Pack currently ranks second in the ACC and 10th in the NCAA with an average of 11.1 three-pointers made per game. NC State leads the ACC and ranks seventh in the NCAA in three point percentage, making 39.8 percent of its attempts from long range this season.
- » Ven-Allen Lubin has shot over 50 percent in every game except for one this season. The Orlando, Fla., native leads the ACC and ranks seventh in the NCAA in field goal percentage at 66.4 percent.
- » Paul McNeil, Jr., has made multiple three-pointers in seven consecutive games and has made 31 three-pointers in the last seven games (4.4 per game) and is shooting 46.9% from long range in those contests. For the season, McNeil is averaging 3.1 three-pointers per game to rank second in the ACC and 35th in the NCAA.

TUESDAY STORYLINES

- » Tuesday marks the return of NC State head coach Will Wade and assistant coach Vernon Hamilton to their alma mater, Clemson. Wade graduated from Clemson in 2005 and served as a four-year student manager from 2001-05 before beginning his coaching career with the Tigers as a graduate assistant in 2005-06 and later as director of basketball operations from 2006-07. Hamilton is a two-time Clemson graduate, earning a Bachelor of Science degree in sports management in 2007 and a master's degree in youth development when he returned to Clemson as a graduate assistant from 2014-16. He remains Clemson's all-time leader in career steals (271) and career steals per game average (2.13). His 83 steals and 2.68 steals per game during the 2005-06 season—when he was named to the All-ACC Defensive Team—remain the best single-season marks in Clemson history.
- » Tuesday's game at Clemson is the fourth ranked opponent the Pack has faced this season, and the second road game against a top-25 foe. NC State's last road win over a ranked opponent was Feb. 24, 2021 when it beat No. 21 Virginia, 68-61, in Charlottesville.
- » Win the Boards, win the game? NC State was outrebounded by nine in its loss to Georgia Tech on Saturday. The Pack is 10-0 when it outrebounds its opponent this season, but just 2-6 when it is outrebounded.
- » The Pack's offense has traveled well this season, as NC State has actually shot better away from Raleigh than at home. In seven road or neutral-site games, the Pack is shooting 48.7 percent, including 44.3 percent from three-point range, and averaging 84.7 points per game. Ven-Alien Lubin leads NC State in scoring in those contests, averaging 14.7 points while shooting 69.0 percent from the field (40-of-58) away from Raleigh. Quadir Copeland is close behind, averaging 14.0 points per game and shooting 62.5 percent (35-of-56) on the road. NC State will face its stiffest road test yet Tuesday at Clemson, as the Tigers lead the ACC in scoring defense at 64.5 points per game. In 10 home games this season, Clemson has held eight opponents to 61 points or fewer, with the most allowed being 70 points against SMU. NC State has scored 70 or more points in 17 of its 18 games this season.
- » The Pack has a +29 turnover margin in its five ACC games this season and leads the ACC and ranks 14th in the NCAA with a +4.4 turnover margin. The only two power conference teams in the NCAA to have a better turnover margin than the Pack are Houston (+6.9) and Iowa State (+5.6). NC State has had the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent in 16 of 18 games this season. VCU and Ole Miss are the only two opponents to have less turnovers than the Pack. Clemson enters the game on Tuesday, seventh in the ACC in turnover margin at +2.5, but the Tigers lead the ACC in fewest turnovers per game, averaging to commit just 9.6 per contest. NC State is close behind Clemson, ranking third in the ACC as the Pack commits just 9.9 turnovers per game.
- » NC State has had double digit steals in four of its five ACC games and has 54 overall in ACC play. Overall, the Pack is second in the ACC with an average of 8.8 steals per game. NC State has eight players that have double-digit steals on the season.
- » The win at Florida State marked the fourth time this season NC State has gone over the century mark. It's the most 100 point games in a single season for NC State since the 1995-96 team had four. For the season, NC State averages 85.8 points per game which is fourth in the ACC and 32nd in the NCAA. The Pack is currently on pace to average its most points since Fire & Ice (Chris Corchiani and Rodney Monroe) led the Pack to an average of 89.3 points per game in the 1990-91 season.
- » In its last three games, NC State passed out 56 assists and had just 22 turnovers. NC State leads the ACC and ranks 15th in the NCAA with a 1.70 assist-to-turnover ratio this season.
- » Ven-Alien Lubin has been unstoppable in the second half of games this season: A missed shot midway through the second half against Liberty on Dec. 10 snapped a streak of 24 consecutive made second half field goals for Ven-Alien Lubin. In 18 games this season, Lubin is shooting 79.2 percent (57-of-72) from the field in the second half.

NC STATE SERIES WITH CLEMSON

- » Tuesday will be the 167th all-time meeting between NC State and Clemson. The Pack leads the series, 105-61, but is just 34-36 all-time in Clemson, including a 20-28 record at Littlejohn Coliseum.
- » **Last Meeting (February 1, 2025):** The Tigers beat NC State, 68-58, last season in the Lenovo Center. Dontrez Styles led all players with 24 points as he made a career-high six three-pointers.
- » Clemson led 34-31 at halftime and scored the first four points of the second half to take a 38-31 lead, but NC State held the Tigers scoreless for over seven minutes to take a 39-38 lead. The Tigers responded with a 13-4 run though to take a 51-43 lead with 7:56 to play, NC State got as close as six with under four minutes to go but a 7-0 Tigers spurt put the game out of reach.

MCNEIL, JR., SETS PROGRAM/TIES ACC RECORD FOR THREES IN A GAME

- » Sophomore guard Paul McNeil, Jr., set a program record and tied the ACC record with 11 made three-pointers in the Pack's win over Texas Southern on Dec. 17.
- » He finished the game 11-of-17 from three, breaking the NC State record of nine that had stood since Dec. 21, 1989 when Rodney Monroe made nine threes in a win over UNC Asheville.
- » He now shares the ACC single game record for threes with Georgia Tech's Dennis Scott (12/28/88) and Wake Forest's Craig Dawson (2/13/02).
- » McNeil, Jr., scored a career-high 47 points against Texas Southern. His final stat line was 12-of-18 shooting, 11-of-17 from three and 12-of-12 from the foul line. He also added a career-high 10 rebounds as he posted his first career double-double. McNeil, Jr.'s 47 points are tied with Sammy Ranzino (Jan. 23, 1951 vs. Virginia Tech) for the fifth-most points in a single game in program history and are the most by an ACC player since Rodney Monroe – NC State's all-time leading scorer – had 48 against Georgia Tech on Jan. 13, 1991.

PACK MAKES STATEMENT IN SEASON OPENER

- » NC State opened the Will Wade era on Monday, Nov. 3 with a resounding 114-66 win over NC Central.
- » In the win, the Pack tied a school record with 19 made three-pointers, and scored the second-most points ever in the Lenovo Center with 114.
- » Seven players reached double figures for NC State, only the second time in the last 25 years that has happened and the first time since No. 10, 2017.

PACK PICKED 4TH: WILLIAMS ACC PPOY IN PRESEASON VOTING

- » Darrion Williams earned ACC Preseason Player of the Year recognition, while the Pack secured a fourth-place ranking in the media's preseason poll that was announced on October 14.
- » Williams is NC State's first ACC Preseason Player of the Year selection since C.J. Leslie prior to the 2012-13 season, while the Pack's preseason pick of fourth is the highest for the program since 2012-13 when NC State was the ACC favorite heading into the season.

WILL LIKES WINNERS

- » The Pack added nine transfers to this season's roster that played at the DI level last season. Of those nine players, six played on teams that played in the NCAA Tournament last season.
- » All six of those players (Houston's Terrance Arceneaux, McNeese's Alyn Breed and Quadir Copeland, Michigan State's Tre Holloman, UNC's Ven-Allen Lubin and Texas Tech's Darrion Williams) were on team's that won at least one game in the NCAA Tournament last season.
- » Arceneaux's Houston team was National Runner-Up while Williams (Texas Tech) and Holloman (Michigan State) were both on teams that advanced to the Elite 8.
- » Overall, NC State's 2025-26 roster has combined to play 549 minutes in NCAA Tournament games in their career. That amount is the most of any ACC team and more than 200 minutes more than second.

WILL LIKES WINNERS, PART 2

- » This year's NC State squad has three of the winningest fourth-year players in college basketball. Terrance Arceneaux has spent the last three seasons on a Houston team that has gone a combined 100-14 in that span (33.3 wins per year). Arceneaux was limited to just 11 games in the 2023-24 season because of an injury in December that caused him to miss the rest of the season, but still played in 85 career games in his three years with the Cougars.
- » Darrion Williams and Tre Holloman join him as two of the winningest fourth-year players in college basketball this season. Williams has won 73 games (24.3 per season) in his previous three seasons of college basketball (two at Texas Tech and freshman season at Nevada) while Holloman was on Michigan State teams that won 71 games (23.7 per season) the last three years.

RED RECKONING ENERGIZES FAN BASE

- » No stranger to being one of the fiercest places to play in college basketball (NC State has consistently ranked in the top-25 year after year in college basketball average attendance), the hiring of Will Wade has energized the NC State fanbase to an even higher level.
- » The program has sold 10,302 season tickets which are the most since the 2016-17 season (11,033 that year).
- » The 10,302 season tickets mark a 14% increase in season tickets over last year (about 1,250 more).
- » There are 783 new season ticket accounts and 2,243 new season tickets sold for this season.
- » Season tickets are sold out on the lower level and the club level is nearly sold out, as well.
- » Mini-plan ticket sales are already 32% higher this year than the final total last season.
- » The Pack's season-opener against NC Central is sold out and it marks the first time since the arena opened in 1999 that the season-opening game is sold out.
- » The sell out against NC Central is the first time NC State has sold out a game against a team that isn't UNC or Duke since Feb. 25, 2023 when the Lenovo Center was sold out for a game against Clemson.

MCNEIL, JR., MAKING MOST OF INCREASED OPPORTUNITY

- » Paul McNeil Jr. entered college last season as one of the most highly regarded prospects in the ACC, but his freshman campaign got off to a slow start. After NC State's 23rd game of the season – Feb. 8 at Stanford – McNeil had not appeared in seven games and had logged three minutes or fewer in nine others. At that point, he was averaging just 1.8 points per game and shooting 27.8 percent (5-of-18) from three-point range.
- » Everything began to change with the Feb. 12 matchup against Louisville. Since then, McNeil has capitalized on his expanded role, showing the promise that made him such a sought-after recruit. Over the final eight games of the 2024-25 season and the first 16 of this year, he's averaged 12 points per game while connecting on 41.1 percent (58-of-141) of his three-point attempts.
- » Through 16 games this season, McNeil, Jr., is third on the Pack in scoring at 13.6 points per game and his average of 2.9 three-pointers made per game is third in the ACC.

NO STRANGER TO THE ACC OR THE LENVO CENTER

- » NC State brought in three transfers – Ven-Allen Lubin (North Carolina and Notre Dame), Jerry Deng (Florida State) and Quadir Copeland (Syracuse) – who have played in the ACC previously.
- » Lubin has actually played against NC State every year of his college career prior to playing for the Pack this season. As a freshman at Notre Dame, he had 10 points and five rebounds in an NC State win in Raleigh. As a sophomore at Vanderbilt, he had 16 points and eight rebounds in a Pack win over the Commodores in Las Vegas. Last season at UNC, Lubin had a combined 17 points and 14 rebounds in two victories over the Pack. Overall in his career against NC State, Lubin has averaged 11.8 points and 6.8 rebounds per game while shooting 58.6 percent (17-of-29) from the field.
- » Last season as a sophomore at Florida State, Jerry Deng played 13 minutes and scored four points in the Pack's overtime win over the Seminoles.
- » Quadir Copeland played against the Pack three times as a sophomore at Syracuse in the 2023-24 season. Copeland enjoyed the best scoring game of his collegiate career inside the Lenovo Center on Feb. 20, 2024. That night, he scored a career-high 25 points on 10-of-13 shooting to lead Syracuse to a win in Raleigh.

FRESHMAN MAKING AN IMPRESSION

- » Who was the first player to commit to Will Wade at NC State? The answer to that trivia question will always be Matt Able who made a verbal commitment to join the Pack on April 5, 13 days after Wade was announced as head coach of the NC State program.
- » In addition to always having the label as Wade's first NC State recruit, Able also is noteworthy as he is the highest ranked freshman recruit to sign with NC State since Dennis Smith, Jr., signed with the Pack in the fall of 2015. A consensus top-30 recruit in the Class of 2025, Able averaged 20.4 points, 5.9 rebounds, 3.7 steals and 2.9 assists per game last season as a senior at Sagemont Prep in Florida and led the Lions to the Florida High School Athletic Association 1A state championship.
- » This summer, Able has been a standout player on the camp circuit, playing at many NBA players prospect camps. He starred at the Donovan Mitchell, CP3 (Chris Paul) and Jayson Tatum Camps and was named MVP at the Formula Zero Camp hosted by Damian Lillard.

PACK'S PORTAL CLASS RANKED AS ONE OF BEST

- » NC State's nine-man transfer portal class is ranked as one of the best in college basketball.
- » The Pack's class is ranked as the second best portal class in the ACC and 14th best in college basketball by 247Sports. 247Sports ranks Darrion Williams as the best portal pickup by an ACC team and the fifth-best overall transfer in the sport.
- » On3 sports also ranks Williams as the best portal pickup by an ACC team and the sixth-best overall transfer in CBB. On3 also ranks Ven-Allen Lubin (42nd), Tre Holloman (68th) and Terrance Arceneaux (80th) in the top-100 of college basketball transfer portal players ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- » NC State's four players ranked in the top-100 of the On3 transfer portal rankings are the most of any ACC team. Louisville is next with three players while no other ACC team had more than one transfer ranked in the top-100.

DARRION WILLIAMS STARTING STREAK AT 109 GAMES

- » Darrion Williams enters the 2025-26 season having started his last 97 games. He did not start the first three games of his collegiate career as a freshman at Nevada, but moved into the starting lineup for his fourth game and he's started every game since.
- » Williams' 109 game start streak is far and away the most of any of his teammates on this year's team. Quadir Copeland who started the last nine games of McNeese's season last year has the second-longest streak currently at 15. Ven-Allen Lubin started 16 of UNC's last 17 games last season, but did not start UNC's senior night game against Duke so his starting streak is just 13 games currently.
- » While NC State has plenty of game experience on its roster (733 combined DI games played entering the 2025-26 season), the Pack lacks a ton of starting experience. Williams accounts for almost 40% of the team's total career starts (97 of 249) on the roster. Ven-Allen Lubin (53 starts in 91 career games) is the only other player on the Pack's roster to start over half of their collegiate games.

LET Q BE Q

- » Let's get this out of the way first - Quadir Copeland is loud ... very loud. Head Coach Will Wade was answering a question in a summer press conference about Quadir and what he brings to the team and in the middle of his answer he stopped and sort of tilted his head and said with a smile, "Q is talking ... a lot" But that is also a good thing, Wade and his staff want Copeland - who is one of just two players on the roster that has played for Wade before - to be a leader on this year's team.
- » Copeland averaged 9.2 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.5 assists in 21.9 minutes a game for McNeese last season. He only started one of the first 11 games of the season, but then started all but one game the rest of the season on his way to Second-Team All-Southland Conference honors. A stat-sheet stuffer, Copeland had 16 points, 7 rebounds and five assists in the Cowboys first round win over Clemson in the NCAA Tournament.
- » Copeland on himself - "Yeah, I'm definitely a yapper, I definitely talk, I definitely chat, but it allows me to be me. It allows me to be Q. I feel like I wouldn't be that leader if I didn't talk. I've got to be able to talk. I've got to be talking all the time. I've got to be building confidence in players. I've got to be checking to make sure everybody's good. I do it with the coaches too. I make sure they're good because at the end of the day, they've got to come in here and coach us. Everybody can have a bad day. We're all human. I just make sure I try to be the light in the room every day."
- » Copeland on his relationship with Wade - "He never judges me. I'm loud as hell sometimes. He never says nothing, never judges me. He might give me a shut up here and there, but it's really rare. He lets me be Q and that's the best part of everything. I'm comfortable here. I think my whole team is comfortable and everybody lets me be myself. I can smile, I can be the loudest, goofy all the time. But they know when I say it, flip that switch."

WADE: "THIS IS NOT A REBUILD"

- » With NC State returning just 4.7% of its scoring, 3.3% of its rebounding and 4.8% of its assists from last season, it would be easy to classify this season as a rebuild, but that's not how Will Wade sees it. Below is a quote from his introductory press conference on March 25, 2025.
- » "I want to be very clear. This is not a rebuild. We're going to be in the top part of the ACC next year and we're going to the NCAA Tournament. This is not something that is going to take a whole lot of time."

WADE'S STAFF HAS CLOSE TIES TO HIM

- » If you talk to Will Wade's staff one word you'll hear come up with all of them when describing the head coach of the Pack's program is "loyalty" He's loyal to them and they are loyal to him. If you look closely at his staff, you'll see a lot of them have gotten their start in college basketball or been with him from the beginning.
- » Assistant Coach Vernon Hamilton was on the Clemson basketball team while Wade was a student manager and graduate assistant. Hamilton was later on Wade's staffs at LSU and McNeese.
- » Fellow assistant coach Brandon Chambers was a student manager with the VCU while Wade was an assistant coach there and then joined Wade's staffs at McNeese and LSU.
- » On the Pack's support staff, Director of Operations Nick Flory and Video Coordinator Brady Jones were both student managers for Wade at LSU and then worked on his staff at McNeese. Special Assistant to the Head Coach Reed Vial was a walk-on basketball player at LSU for Wade and then worked with Wade at McNeese. Director of Pack Performance Greg Goldin was a strength & conditioning grad assistant at VCU in 2012-13 with Wade and then was on his staffs at Chattanooga, VCU and LSU.

PACK BONDED WITH US NAVY SEAL TRAINING IN SEPTEMBER

- » With the first official practice of the season looming on Monday, Sept. 22, Will Wade and his staff took the program's 15 players to Camp Oak Hill, located an hour north of Raleigh near Oxford, N.C. for a weekend retreat that included many different US Navy Seal training sessions.
- » The two night event started with the team discussing its goals and identity for the coming season and included having speakers coming into speak with the team. The team also participated in US Navy Seal training, including a 'hostage' activity that forced different groups to work together to free the hostage.
- » Coach Wade believes in "leading from the front" and he and his staff joined the players in many of the US Navy Seal drills.

SHARING IS CARING

- » There are only 11 players in the 18-team ACC that entered the 2025-26 season with over 250 career assists and the Pack had three of them on their roster. NC State was the only team in the ACC that had three different players enter the season with over 200 career assists.
- » Darrion Williams entered this season with 295 career assists, the eighth most amongst ACC players, while Quadir Copeland had 255 assists (10th most) and Tre Holloman had 250 career assists (11th most).

NEW TO THE PACK BUT NOT TO COLLEGE BASKETBALL

- » With 13 new faces for the Pack, you could come to the conclusion that NC State would have an inexperienced ball club this season, but you would be wrong. Of NC State's 15 players on the roster, seven will be playing their final season of eligibility this season.
- » Overall, NC State added nine players through the transfer portal this offseason. Those nine players combine to have played 733 college basketball games entering this season with a combined 249 starts between them.

PACK TESTING ITSELF IN NON-CONFERENCE

- » NC State will face one of its toughest non-conference schedules in recent history in the 2025-26 season.
- » The Pack is guaranteed to play at least five games in the non-conference against teams that made the NCAA Tournament last season, including two (Auburn and Ole Miss) that advanced to the Sweet 16.
- » Overall, everybody on the Pack's non-conference slate is preseason picked to finish in the top half of their conference.
- » Liberty (Conference USA) and VCU (Atlantic 10) will both visit Raleigh this season and both are the preseason favorite to win their conference. UNC Asheville will also come to the Lenovo Center this season and they were selected second in the preseason Big South poll.
- » NC State will play two teams (Kansas - 19th and Auburn - 20th) that are in the preseason Associated Press top-25.

CHUCKY BROWN JOINS PACK RADIO AS ANALYST

- » Former Pack great Chucky Brown will serve as color analyst for all men's basketball games on the Wolfpack Sports Network.
- » Brown was a four-year letterman at NC State who played in 128 career games from 1985-89. In his four years with the Wolfpack, NC State went to the NCAA Tournament all four seasons and won the 1987 ACC Tournament Championship as well as finishing first in the 1989 ACC regular season. Brown scored 1,357 career points, a total that still ranks 25th in school history, and shot 55.7 percent from the field in his NC State career, a mark that is fourth all-time in the program record book.

REPLACE THE LEADING SCORER? NOTHING NEW FOR THE PACK

- » NC State lost its leading scorer from the previous season as Marcus Hill and his team-high 11.5 points per game transferred to Texas & M. The loss of the previous season's leading scorer is nothing new for NC State though. As a program, NC State has not had a player repeat as scoring leader since C.J. Leslie led the team in scoring in the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons.

- » Wade spent the past two seasons at McNeese, where he led the Cowboys to back-to-back Southland Conference regular season and tournament championships and was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year both seasons. He compiled a 50-9 record at McNeese, including a 33-1 home record.




