CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has played all its games at home in 2026, defeated Charlotte 11-1 in seven innings on Tuesday.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.8 runs per game and hitting .361 with a .588 slugging percentage, .469 on-base percentage and three steals.

- The pitching staff has an 0.55 ERA, a .179 opponents' batting average and 5.86 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .969.

BRYANT OVERVIEW

- Bryant, which has played all its games on the road and is averaging 8.0 runs per game, is led by seventh-year Head Coach Ryan Klosterman.
- The Bulldogs won two of three games at Davidson last weekend. They are hitting .300 and have a 7.66 ERA and .978 fielding percentage.
- Casey Wensley is 7-for-11 with a homer and five RBIs, Charlie Saul has two homers and seven RBIs and Justin Dressler has one save.

QUICK HITS

- Bryant Head Coach Ryan Klosterman played 17 games off the bench in his one season (2001) at Clemson.
- Clemson has more walks (23) than strikeouts (15) at the plate.
- Clemson pitched 25 innings in a row without allowing a run until Charlotte hit a solo homer in the final inning on Tuesday.

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 15 in the nation by NCBWA this week.
- Clemson has an active 46-week streak of being ranked in the top 20 of at least one poll dating to the 2023 season.
- Clemson has played 145 consecutive games (dating to 2023) ranked in the top 20 of at least one poll.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,805 fans per home date (3), the 10th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of Feb. 18).
- Entering 2026, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 32 straight seasons.

CAPTAINS

- Joe Allen, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the third time, while Knaak and Purify were voted a team-captain for the second time.
- Talan Bell, Luke Gaffney, Ty Marshall, Tryston McCladdie and Noah Samol were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Jason Fultz Jr., Tyler Lichtenberger, Dane Moehler, Danny Nelson and Nate Savoie were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

SAVOIE OFF TO HOT START

- Sophomore catcher and outfielder Nate Savoie is in his first season at Clemson after transferring from Loyola Marymount.
- He is hitting .733 with two homers, two double, eight RBIs, six runs and a 1.267 slugging percentage in four games in 2026.
- He has a .765 on-base percentage, as he has reached base in 13 of his 17 plate appearances.
- He has two walks against no strikeouts.
- In his first three games as a Tiger against Army West Point on Feb. 13,14, he was 8-for-11 with a homer, double and seven RBIs.

SHARMAN FILLING ROLE

- Senior lefthander and transfer Michael Sharman filled in in the rotation during the opening weekend and has been in the rotation since.
- He is 1-0 with an 0.00 ERA, .050 opponents' batting average and eight strikeouts versus no walks in 6.0 innings pitched over one start.
- He retired the first 17 batters and allowed one hit and no walks with eight strikeouts to earn the win against Army West Point on Feb. 14.
