### WINNERS OF 6 OF THE LAST 8 ACC GAMES, SEMINOLES TRAVEL TO PLAY AT NO. 24 CLEMSON

Florida State, which has won six of its last eight ACC games (including ACC road wins at Miami, Notre Dame and Virginia Tech), travels to play No. 24 Clemson at Littlejohn Coliseum in Clemson, S.C. on Saturday, February 21, 2026 at 12 Noon. The game will be televised on The CW. The Seminoles' current hot streak began with a 65-63 victory at Miami (January 20) and includes wins over the Hurricanes, Cal (January 28, 63-61), Stanford (January 31, 88-80), at Notre Dame (February 7, 82-79), at Virginia Tech (February 14, 92-69) and most recently Boston College at home on Tuesday night (February 17, 80-72). Florida State's game against the Tigers on Saturday is their only scheduled game against Clemson during the regular season. Following Saturday's game at Clemson, the Seminoles play host to Miami on Tuesday, February 24, at 9:00 p.m. The Seminoles began their current streak of five wins in their last six games and six wins in their last eight games against Miami in Coral Gables on January 20.

### THE SEMINOLES' SECOND HALF STORIES AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH AND BOSTON COLLEGE

Florida State enters Saturday's game at Clemson looking to win its third consecutive ACC game and its third consecutive ACC road game. In both of their last two wins, the Seminoles rallied from halftime deficits, shot better than 60 percent the field in the second half, scored 48 or more points in the second half, held their opponents below 42 percent shooting in the second half, and held both Virginia Tech (27) and Boston College (30) to 30 second half points or less.

### MCCRAY V EYING 1,600 CAREER POINTS

Senior Robert McCray V enters Saturday's game against Clemson having scored in double figures in 13 consecutive games (219 total points) and averaging 16.8 points per game since ACC play began at North Carolina on December 30. He has scored in double figures in all 13 of Florida State's ACC games and enters play against the Tigers with 1,528 career points and needs just 72 points to eclipse the 1,600 career point mark. McCray V is ranked 16th in the ACC with his 15.2 points per game scoring average and third in the ACC for assists per game (6.0) and total assists (156).

### SOMERVILLE RUNS TURNOVER-LESS STREAK TO FOUR STRAIGHT GAMES

Sophomore Martin Somerville has played error-less basketball with zero turnovers in each of his last four games and 112 consecutive minutes played. His has finished turnover-less at Notre Dame (31 minutes, six assists), Virginia (24 minutes, three assists), at Virginia Tech (30 minutes, six assists), and Boston College (28 minutes, zero assists), he has committed only four turnovers since the start of the Seminoles' game against Syracuse on January 13 (280 minutes with only four turnovers) and has yet to commit a turnover in four games in the month of February.

### LOOK FOR FLORIDA STATE TO...

- ...Defeat Clemson and gain a win over a ranked team for the first time since defeating No. 22/23 Colorado, 77-71, in the championship game of the Sunshine Slam on November 21, 2023;
- ...Defeat Clemson and win its third consecutive ACC game for the first time since winning five consecutive ACC games since topping Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest, Notre Dame, and Miami in succession in January of 2024;
- ...Defeat Clemson and win its third consecutive ACC road game for the first time since winning at Notre Dame (January 13, 2024; 67-58), at Miami (January 17, 2024, 84-75), and at Syracuse (January 23, 2024, 85-69) during the 2023-24 season.

Luke Loucks One of three current ACC head coaches - Luke Loucks (Florida State, 2012), Jon Scheyer (Duke, 2009, 2010), and Hubert Davis (North Carolina, 1989, 1991) - who won ACC Basketball Championships at their alma mater. All three are currently coaching at their ACC alma mater.

### FLORIDA STATE PLAYING WELL IN ITS LAST EIGHT GAMES

Florida State has won six of its last eight ACC games (three at home and three on the road) as it has held its last eight opponents to more than 10 points fewer than it allowed its opponents in their first 18 games of the season. In their last eight games, the Seminoles held their opponents to fewer than 70 points four times (Miami, 63; Cal, 61; Virginia, 61; Virginia Tech, 62) while scoring 80 or more points in five games (80 vs. SMU; 88 vs. Stanford; 82 at Notre Dame; 92 at Virginia Tech; 80 against Boston College).

### IN THE LAST 12 MINUTES OF THE GAME AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH AND BOSTON COLLEGE

Florida State outscored both Virginia Tech (53-27) and Boston (48-30) in the second halves of their last two victories with much of their offensive and defensive damage done in the final 12 minutes of their games against the Hokies and the Eagles. The Seminoles overcame an eight point deficit (first half) against Virginia Tech and a 14 point deficit (first and second halves) against the Eagles. The Seminoles trailed Virginia Tech by eight points (19-11) at the 13:39 mark of the first half on January 14 and outscored the Hokies from that point on by an 81-50 score and trailed Boston College on January 17 by 14 points (59-45) at the 11:28 mark of the second half and outscored the Eagles by a 35-13 margin to close the game.

### FLORIDA STATE'S SECOND HALF NUMBERS AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH AND BOSTON COLLEGE

Florida State rallied in a big way in the second halves of their last two games to gain consecutive ACC victories for the third time this season. The Seminoles have defeated Cal and Stanford, Stanford and Notre Dame, and Virginia Tech and Boston College in consecutive games since January 28. The Seminoles' second half performances in their wins over Virginia Tech and Boston College have been particularly impressive.

### FLORIDA STATE ABOVE 70 PERCENT FROM THE FREE THROW LINE IN FIVE CONSECUTIVE GAMES

Florida State has made its season-high of 27 free throws on its season-high of 35 free throw attempts and outscored Boston College by a 27-3 margin from the free throw line in Tuesday's victory over the Eagles in Tallahassee. The Seminoles enter Saturdays game at Clemson ranked in the ACC's top-10 for team free throw shooting percentage and have shot better than 70 percent from the free throw line in each of their last five games.

### FLORIDA STATE FROM THE FREE THROW LINE AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE

Florida State's 27 free throws made in its 80-72 win over Boston College is tied for the 16th most in an ACC game in school history and the most since making 28 against Pitt in an 82-70 victory over the Panthers on January 15, 2025. The Seminoles 35 free throw attempts against the Eagles is tied for the 13 most in an ACC game in school history and were the most since also attempting 35 in a game against Louisville on February 2, 2024

### SEMINOLES BLOCK FOUR SHOTS AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE

Led by two blocked shots by Lajae Jones against Boston College, the Seminoles enter Saturday's game against Clemson ranked sixth in the ACC with 99 blocked shots and a 3.8 blocked shots per game average. The Seminoles need just one blocked shot to reach 100 blocks for the 20th consecutive season.

### FLORIDA STATE'S TURNOVER-LESS STREAK

Florida State has held onto the basketball in winning six of its last eight games. The Seminoles averaged 8.5 turnovers (68 total turnovers) in their last eight games as compared to 12.3 turnovers in their first 18 games of the season. The Seminoles are 6-2 in their last eight games and were 7-11 in their first 18 games of the season.

### FLORIDA STATE FROM THE FIELD

Florida State has attempted 842 3-point field goals and 812 2-point field goals through its first 26 games of the season.

### LAST GAME AGAINST CLEMSON

Clemson's Dillon Hunter scored a game-high 17 points and Ian Schieffelin totaled a double-double of 14 points and 12 rebounds to lead the No. 19/23 Tigers to a 72-46 win over Florida State at the Donald L. Tucker Center on February 15, 2025. The Tigers scored the first two points of the game and never trailed in earning the ACC road victory. Jamir Watkins led the Seminoles with 14 points and seven rebounds, with one assist and one steal. He has scored in double figures in four consecutive and 23 of 25 games this season. Sophomore Taylor Bol Bowen finished with a team-high seven rebounds and one steal. Freshman Daquan Davis scored nine points, all coming in the second half. Junior Malique Ewin finished with six points and six rebounds. Senior Justin Thomas hit a three-pointer at the first-half buzzer and finished with six points.

### LAJAE JONES IN DOUBLE-FIGURE SCORING

Senior Lajae Jones has scored in double figures in a season-high five consecutive games and is averaging 15.4 points since totaling 18 points in Florida State's 88-80 victory over Stanford on January 31. He enters Saturday's game against Clemson averaging a career-high 11.8 points per game -- the second consecutive season he has averaged in double figure scoring.

### JONES WITH A TEAM-LEADING 25 BLOCKED SHOTS

Senior Lajae Jones totaled three blocked shots in Florida State's victory at Virginia Tech and has blocked nine shots in the last eight games. His 25 blocked shots this season are just four shy of establishing a new single-season personal career high. Jones blocked 28 shots during the 2024-25 season while at St. Bonaventure.

### SWINTON FROM THE 3-POINT LINE

Sophomore AJ Swinton has made nearly twice as many 3-point shots this season (16) as compared to his freshman season (nine). He made 10 3-point shots in ACC play with two each coming in Florida State's victories over Cal (6 points, January 28), at Notre Dame (eight points, February 7), and at Virginia Tech (6 points, February 14). His two 3-point shots against Virginia Tech, as noted by Hokie's head coach Mike Young, counted as very important shots in the Seminoles' come-from-behind victory. His first 3-point shot against the Hokies pulled Florida State within three at 23-20 (9:48, first half) and his second tied the games at 34-34 (4:18, first half). Swinton's second 3-pointer against Virginia Tech allowed the Seminoles to pull even after trailing by eight points early in the first half in winning the game by a 92-69 final margin.

## **Robert McCray V – Playing on Basketball’s Biggest Stage at Florida State**

TALLAHASSEE – On January 4, 2022, Robert McCray V scored two points and totaled one rebound in Wake Forest’s victory over Florida State at the Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum in Winston Salem, N.C. He was a freshman playing in his first season of college basketball on that cold and cloudy night on Tobacco Road, never imagining that he would one day be a Florida State Seminole.

Only three short years later, McCray is a Seminole and preparing for his final collegiate season as one of the most important additions to the roster for the first year of the Luke Loucks era. After playing one season at Wake Forest, and two at Jacksonville, he is ready to continue to thrive on the basketball court at Florida State.

“I came to Florida State knowing that it will give me a taste of playing at the next level,” said McCray at the conclusion of the Seminoles’ eight-week summer training camp. “The NBA is where I want to be, and I know this is the right place for me to continue to elevate my game. Florida State is the right place for me because of Coach Loucks and Coach (Jim) Moran with their backgrounds in the NBA, along with our fast-paced style of play.”

McCray has always been a standout athlete in a family of great athletes. While playing for his dad, Robert IV at A.C. Floria High School in his hometown of Columbia, S.C, he was twice named as the player of the year in his region, led the Falcons to regional and state championships in 2019, 2020, and 2021, and to the Class 4A Lower State Championship game in 2018. McCray was the No. 11 ranked combo guard in the nation as a senior.

He displayed his incredible athleticism as he won the South Carolina state championship in the high jump as a senior in 2021. His state championship winning jump was measured at 6-10 – a full six inches above his 6-4 height.

The lefthanded guard quickly caught the attention of Loucks and his staff as soon as the former Seminole accepted the job as the eighth head coach in school history on March 10, 2025.

“Robert was a guy we zeroed in on very early when we began putting our team together,” said Loucks. “He has the ability to create for himself, and more importantly, he has the ability to create for his teammates. He’s dynamic, he’s a team player, and he’s one of six seniors on our roster which was by design. Robert’s skill level and competitiveness are going to help us win games.”

As the middle child of nine brothers and sisters, McCray was one of the top guards in the Atlantic Sun during the past two seasons. He averaged a career-high 18.4 points per game in his first season and averaged 16.2 points, 4.8 rebounds, and 4.5 assists in earning All-Atlantic Sun First-team honors last year. McCray has also proven to be an excellent shooter who has made more than 100 3-point shots during his career.

“I learned to play college basketball at Jacksonville,” said McCray. “The main things I learned about college basketball is my ability to play every position, learning to be a strong facilitator, and getting all of my teammates involved on every play.”

First-year Seminole assistant coach Michael Fly, who helped coach McCray during his two years at Jacksonville, had a front row seat to McCray’s maturation as a basketball player and as a man.

“Rob carried a heavy load at Jacksonville for the past two seasons,” said Fly. “He is used to being the No. 1 player on the opposing teams’ scouting report. Rob improved a great deal as a shooter, as a decision maker, and as a leader during his time at Jacksonville. I expect him to continue his growth on and off the floor and represent the Garnet and Gold with character and integrity.”

McCray enters his first season at Florida State with 1,133 career points -- 1,107 which were scored in his two seasons at Jacksonville. His single season scoring totals of 589 points (2023-24, tied for 11<sup>th</sup>) and 518 points (2024-25, tied for 24<sup>th</sup>) make him one of only six players in school history (including the legendary Artis Gilmore) with multiple single-season scoring totals in the top 25 in history of the Jacksonville program. McCray's 1,107 career points is the 25<sup>th</sup> highest scoring total for career points in the history of Jacksonville basketball.

McCray helped lead the Dolphins to the 2025 College Basketball Invitational and is one of four Seminoles (McCray, Lajae Jones at St. Bonaventure, Alex Steen at Florida Southern, and Chauncey Wiggins at Clemson) who have played in the postseason during their collegiate careers.

McCray also completed his career at Jacksonville with his bachelor's degree in social science.

"Earning my degree from Jacksonville meant a lot to me," said McCray. "I knew earning my degree would make my parents proud."

As McCray prepares to suit up for the Seminoles this season, he knows there is a lot of basketball to be played in his future.

"The thing I enjoy most about playing basketball is how it makes me feel," said McCray. "Knowing that how I play can bring joy to my family, my friends, and now the passionate Florida State fans is special," said McCray. "The opportunities that playing basketball have created for me are amazing. The school spirit -- how much the fans love Florida State -- has been the most eye-opening aspect of being a Seminole. It's why I'm so excited for November 4 when we get to play in front of our fans."

While he didn't realize it when he first faced Florida State, it's much better to be a Seminole than to play against the Seminoles.

**Game 1 -- Florida State 108, Alcorn State 76**

TALLAHASSEE – Senior Robert McCray V was credited with a school-record 17 assists, and Luke Loucks won his first game as the Seminoles' head coach in a 108-76 season-opening win for the Seminoles over Alcorn State at the Donald L. Tucker Center. McCray broke the school record for assists in a single game, formerly held by Otto Petty in 1972 and matched by Tony William in 1983. With 12 points to go along with his 17 assists, McCray became the first player to record a double-double in a season-opener since Malik Osborn totaled a double-double of 18 points and 13 rebounds against Penn on Nov. 10, 2021. Loucks earned his first victory as Florida State's head coach as he became the eighth Seminole coach to win his first game. Every coach in school history has now won his first game as Florida State's head coach. McCray V also was the first player to record at least 13 assists since Loucks recorded 13 against North Carolina in leading the Seminoles to the first ACC Championship in school history on March 11, 2012. The Seminoles' 2025 season opened with an alley-oop slam from McCray to Alex Steen.

**Game 2 -- Florida State 101, Alabama State 64**

TALLAHASSEE – Florida State senior LaJae Jones scored a game-high 20 points, and the Seminoles made a near-school record 18 3-point shots, as they won their second consecutive game to open the season with a 101-64 win over Alabama State at the Donald L. Tucker Center. The Seminoles made 18 3-point shots (two shy of tying the school record for 3-point shots made in a game) while attempting a school and ACC record 47 3-point field goals. The 18 3-point baskets made by the Seminoles rank as the third highest total for made 3-point shots in a single game at Florida State and the most made since Florida State made 17 against Clemson on Feb. 5, 2017. The Seminoles' 47 three-point attempts set a single-game Florida State record, beating the previous record of 39, which was set against Wichita State on March 17, 2004, as well as a single-game ACC record. The previous ACC record for 3-point field goals attempted was 21 by Virginia Tech against Delaware on November 20, 2019.

### Game 5 -- Florida State 98, Charleston Southern

TALLAHASSEE – Florida State's Lajae Jones scored a career-high 36 points – and tied the single-game school-record for 3-point shots made with 10 – to lead the Seminoles to a 98-72 victory over Georgia Southern at the Donald L. Tucker Center. Jones tied the all-time school record for 3-point shots made in a game first set by George McCloud at La Salle on Feb. 23, 1989. Jones' 36 points is the most by a Florida State player since Al Thornton scored 45 against Miami on March 3, 2007. Jones became the first Seminole to score at least 30 points since Jamir Watkins against Rice on November 9, 2024. As a team, Florida State made 17 3-point shots, which is tied for the fourth most made in a single game in school history. The Seminoles also attempted a school and ACC record 49 3-point field goals. The 49 3-point attempts broke the previous record of 47 set by the Seminoles against Alabama State earlier this season on November 7, 2025.

TALLAHASSEE – Chauncey Wiggins led all scorers with 17 points, and Martin Somerville and Robert McCray V added 14 points each in Florida State's 89-59 win against the CSU Bakersfield Roadrunners at the Donald L. Tucker Center. Wiggins, Somerville, and McCray V led four Seminoles in double figures as senior Alex Steen earned the first double-double of his Florida State career with 13 points and 10 rebounds. TALLAHASSEE - Florida State outscored Boston College 17-5 in the final 4:36 to erase a 14-point deficit and defeat Eagles by an 80-72 margin at the Donald L. Tucker Center. The Seminoles trailed the Eagles by a 68-63 score with 4:51 remaining to play and held the visitors to two field goals the rest of the way to gain their sixth ACC win in their last eight games. Florida State trailed by 14 points in the first half and took the lead for good on a 3-point shot by Chauncey Wiggins with 1:49 remaining in the game. Robert McCray V led the Seminoles with 27 points to lead four Seminoles in double-figure scoring. Alex Steen totaled 13 points (on seven of eight shooting from the free throw line), Wiggins totaled 11 (on three made 3-point shots), and Lajae Jones scored 10 (on six of seven made free throws). Jones (nine rebounds) and Steen (eight rebounds) came within one and two rebounds, respectively, of earning double-doubles in the victory. McCray V added six rebounds and a team-high five assists. He has led the Seminoles in assists in 22 games this season.
