PREVIOUSLY IN GS SOFTBALL

- GS's young talent continues to deliver early in the season, highlighted by standout performances from freshman **Jaycee Bilbrey** and sophomore **Braelyn Queen**. Bilbrey has been red hot at the plate, going 3-for-4 with a run against Mercer, 2-for-3 with two runs vs. Tennessee Tech, and a perfect 4-for-4 showing against ECU that included a double, RBI, stolen base, and run scored. Queen has also provided steady production, posting multi-hit efforts against Mercer (2-for-3, RBI) and Tennessee Tech (2-for-2, run, RBI), adding a two-RBI performance vs. ECU and scoring a run in a 1-for-2 outing against Rhode Island.

- After previously contributing as a pinch runner and pinch hitter, freshman **Demere Gray** made the most of her opportunity in the starting lineup, blasting her first career home run –a two-run homer –against Tennessee Tech. The milestone marked her first long ball at the collegiate level and highlighted her immediate impact in an expanded role.

- Several new faces made their debut in blue and white, as **Demere Gray, Shaylin Stringer, Hannah Worthington, Kaylee Croft, Carley Ramsden, Kennedy Shea and Jaycee Bilbrey** each saw their first action representing the Eagles, marking the start of their collegiate journeys with the program.

- The 2025 Eagles rewrote nine single-season team records, earning multiple top-five marks in program history: doubles (72), walks (170), on-base percentage (.355), hit by pitches (54), fielding percentage (.979) and double plays (25).

- Georgia Southern set several notable single-game marks during the 2025 season: five doubles against Georgia State (3/29) - tying for seventh-most in a game in program history - stole five bases against Maryland (3/7), ranking fourth all-time, and drew nine walks versus Harvard (2/14), tying for eighth-most in a single game.

- **Emma Davis** continues to climb the program's all-time charts, entering the 2026 season with a .347 career batting average, ranking No. 3 in program history. She also sits eighth all-time in career stolen bases with 39.

- Veteran shortstop **Delanie Thames** leads the program with a single-season record 17 hit by pitches and is also tied for fourth all-time in career hit by pitches alongside A.J. Hamilton (2013-16). Campbell transfer **Madi Gillespie** also cracked the program's top-10 single-season list, tying for third all-time with 13 hit by pitches, alongside Morgan Robinson (2017) and Cathy Stinson (1990), in her first season as an Eagle.

- In her first season as an Eagle, Western Illinois transfer **Valerie Combs** etched her name into the program's record book, tying for fifth all-time in single-season doubles. Combs recorded 14 doubles, matching a mark originally set by Ashley Flemming in 1999 and most recently achieved by Hannah Farrell in 2019.

Barnard Breaks Through

Senior **Alana Barnard** was named to the 2026 Preseason All-Sun Belt Team, marking the first preseason honor of her collegiate career. Posting a 2.18 ERA in 64.1 innings worked, she held opposing teams to a .234 batting average in back-to-back seasons (2024, 2025).

Barnard also etched her name into the program's record book during the 2025 season, recording five consecutive victories from March 18-29, 2025. The streak ties her with 11 other Eagles to accomplish the feat, including teammate Maddie Johnson earlier in the 2025 campaign, with the most recent occurrence outside of the current roster dating back to Rylee Waldrep in 2018.

One Game, Big Statements

The 2025 Eagles also established several single-game records, including doubles, stolen bases, and walks. Against Georgia State on March 29, the Eagles recorded five doubles, tying for seventh-most in a single game in program history, a mark achieved by 11 other teams, with the most recent occurrence in 2021. Georgia Southern also stole five bases against Maryland on March 7, ranking No. 4 all-time for stolen bases in a single game, with the previous most recent instance dating back to 2016. Earlier in the season, the Eagles drew nine walks against Harvard on February 14, tying for eighth-most in a single game in program history, last accomplished in 2020.

Davis on the Rise

In her junior season, outfielder **Emma Davis** further solidified her legacy as an Eagle, posting a .347 career batting average to rank No. 3 all-time in program history. The mark surpassed Marie Fogle's .345, set from 2009-12. With the 2026 season ahead, Davis has the opportunity to climb even higher on the career batting average list, trailing only Nina Iduate (.371, 2007-10) and Shanita Black (.352, 2003-06). Davis has also moved into eighth place on the program's career stolen bases list with 39 steals on 47 attempts, surpassing Lindsey Hopkins' previous mark of 37 steals from 2006-08.

Rewriting the Script

During the 2025 campaign, the Eagles rewrote nine single-season team record categories, earning multiple top-five marks in the program's all-time record book. The team finished No. 5 all-time in doubles (72), surpassing the 1997 total of 69, and ranked No. 4 in walks (170), eclipsing the 2013 mark of 164. The Eagles also posted the fourth-highest on-base percentage in program history at .355, narrowly trailing 2024's .358, and recorded the second-most hit by pitches with 54, just one shy of the 2024 record.

Defensively, the 2025 squad set a new program record with a .979 fielding percentage, besting the 2012 mark of .974, while tying the all-time record for double plays with 25, a mark previously set in 2009. The Eagles also established a new program best with just 33 errors, a record that had stood since 2014, tied for No. 5 all-time in hits allowed with 326 alongside the 2006 team, and matched the third-most saves in a season with five, equaling totals from 2019, 2013, and 2005.

Shaping Pitchers, Setting Standards

Cortney Radke, the newest addition to the Georgia Southern softball staff, joined the program in July 2025 ahead of the 2026 season, bringing extensive collegiate coaching and international playing experience.

A Florida native, Radke arrives in Statesboro after two seasons at FGCU, where she helped develop one of the ASUN's top pitching staffs and guided multiple All-ASUN performers. Prior to FGCU, she worked with the pitching staffs at USF and her alma mater North Florida, playing a key role in UNF's historic 2022 season that included a 42-win campaign, a top-five national ERA (1.75), and a trip to the ASUN Championship game.

Radke also has Division II coaching experience at West Virginia Wesleyan and UB, consistently improving pitching metrics at each stop. As a student-athlete at UNF, Radke was an ASUN Freshman of the Year and remains a top-10 leader in multiple career pitching categories. Following her collegiate career, she gained international experience playing and coaching in Auckland, New Zealand.

Leading Beyond the Lines

After earning her bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice and Criminology with a minor in Philosophy in May 2025, **Emma Davis** continued her academic career as a graduate student pursuing a master's degree in Sport Management while serving as a graduate assistant in the Georgia Southern Athletics Compliance Office. In her role, she supports incoming student-athletes by assisting with onboarding, developing rules education materials for the department, creating informational resources for students, and reviewing scholarship-related documentation.

Born and Raised in the Boro

Infielder **Delanie Thames** and right-handed pitcher **Alana Barnard** both hail from Statesboro, Georgia, and are alumni of Southeast Bulloch High School. Barnard has a deep family connection to Georgia Southern, as her mother attended the university, while Thames continues a family legacy as her uncle, William Rushing, starred on the Eagles baseball team from 1994-95 and earned All-American honors in 1995.

An Eagle Legacy

Bailey Holland has deep ties to Georgia Southern, as her parents, Shane and Tish, are alumni of the university. **Shaylin Stringer** also carries a family connection to GS, with her aunts, Blair Stringer and Nancy Landrum, both attending Georgia Southern. Braelyn Queen's grandfather, Sam Maddox, is also an Eagle.

Athletic Roots Run Deep

The Georgia Southern softball program features a roster rich in athletic lineage, with several Eagles continuing family traditions at the collegiate level. These deep-rooted connections to college athletics reflect a shared understanding of competition, discipline, and commitment that extends beyond the field.

Senior pitcher **Alana Barnard** follows in the footsteps of her sister, Emily, who played collegiate softball at Reinhardt University. Outfielder **Emma Davis** also comes from a strong athletic background, as her father, John, played collegiate baseball at Lehigh University, while her mother, Shannon, competed in volleyball at Bloomsburg University.

Catcher **Valerie Combs** carries on her family's baseball tradition, with her brother Patrick playing collegiately at Illinois College. **Braelyn Queen** continues her family's athletic accolades, as her mother, Kim, played at UNC Asheville. **Kyla Maxwell** also has ties to collegiate athletics through her cousin, Jeremiah Alphabet, who played football at Indiana State.

Jaycee Bilbrey's family connection runs through softball, with her aunt, Jami Warren, competing at Trevecca Nazarene University. Infielder **Delanie Thames** continues a Georgia Southern legacy, as her uncle, William Rushing, played baseball for the Eagles from 1994-95.

Payton Cushman shares her collegiate-athlete experience with her brother, Preston, who currently plays football at UCF. **Demere Gray** represents a multi-generational athletic legacy, with her father, Matt, playing baseball at Georgia College, her brother Tyler competing at both Truett McConnell University and Bryan College, and her grandfather earning induction into Stetson University's Athletic Hall of Fame after competing in baseball, basketball, and track & field.

Rounding out the group, **Kaylee Croft** follows in the footsteps of her father, Brandon, who played wide receiver for West Georgia's football program. Together, these Eagles exemplify a tradition of excellence rooted in family, competition, and a lifelong connection to collegiate athletics.
