CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 9-0 home record, defeated Michigan State 12-1 in seven innings at Fluor Field in Greenville, S.C. on Wednesday.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.8 runs per game and hitting .306 with a .503 slugging percentage, .395 on-base percentage and 12 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 1.76 ERA, .158 opponents' batting average and 4.58 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .963.

LA SALLE OVERVIEW

- La Salle, which has a 3-2 road record and is averaging 10.5 runs per game, is led by fifth-year Head Coach David Miller.
 - The Explorers swept Coppin State in three road games last weekend. They are hitting .272 and have a 5.08 ERA and .966 fielding percentage.
 - Chase Swain is hitting .349, Alec Welshans has five homers and 13 RBIs and Titus Shay has a team-high two saves.
- ### QUICK HITS
- Clemson's last four-game series against one opponent was against Florida Gulf Coast at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from May 1-4, 2010.
 - Clemson has scored 51 of its 81 runs in the first four innings of its games in 2026.
 - La Salle Head Coach David Miller (1993-95) was an All-American at Clemson in 1995 and was a first-round draft pick after that season.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 10 in the nation by NCBWA this week.
- Clemson has an active 48-week streak of being ranked in the top 20 of at least one poll dating to the 2023 season.
- Clemson has played 153 consecutive games (dating to 2023) ranked in the top 20 of at least one poll.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,464 fans per home date (8), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of March 4).
- Entering 2026, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 32 straight seasons.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

CAPTAINS

- Joe Allen, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the third time, while Knaak and Purify were voted a team-captain for the second time.
- Talan Bell, Luke Gaffney, Ty Marshall, Tryston McCladdie and Noah Samol were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Jason Fultz Jr., Tyler Lichtenberger, Dane Moehler, Danny Nelson and Nate Savoie were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

PITCHING IN CONTROL

- Clemson's pitching staff has gotten off to a strong start in the 2026 season under Pitching Coach Jimmy Belanger.
- The staff has a 1.76 ERA, .158 opponents' batting average and 119 strikeouts against 26 walks in 102.0 innings pitched.
- The staff has a 4.58 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 10.50 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark.
- The staff has surrendered only 19 extra-base hits, including only four home runs.
- The staff is holding lefthanded batters to an .092 batting average.
- Since allowing 10 hits in the season opener against Army West Point, it has not given up more than six hits in a game in the last 11 games.
- In the series win against South Carolina from Feb. 27 to March 1, the staff allowed only four hits in each of the three games.

GAFFNEY RESURGING

- Junior infielder and catcher Luke Gaffney has rebounded in 2026 to become one of the team's top offensive threats.
- He is hitting .381 with two homers, three doubles, nine RBIs, six runs and a .595 slugging percentage in 12 games in 2026.
- He has a .460 on-base percentage thanks to seven walks against only three strikeouts.
- In his two years as a Tiger, he is hitting .291 with 10 doubles, seven homers, 48 RBIs, 32 runs and two steals in 66 games (63 starts).

KNAAK KEEPING WINNING WAYS

- Junior righthander Aidan Knaak has been a mainstay in the Tiger rotation for three years and has been a big part of wins for the program.
- He has a 2.77 ERA, .156 opponents' batting average and 22 strikeouts versus seven walks in 13.0 innings pitched over three starts in 2026.
- He has not allowed an extra-base hit.
- In his career, he is 14-3 with a 3.71 ERA, .213 opponents' batting average and 240 strikeouts in 186.2 innings pitched over 34 starts.
- Clemson has a 28-6 record in his 34 career starts.
- His 11.57 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in his career is second in Clemson history.

- His 3.69 strikeout-to-walk ratio in his career is ninth in Clemson history.
- He is one of five Tigers with multiple 100-strikeout seasons and the only Tiger with a 100-strikeout season in each of his first two years.
- Harold Stowe (1958,59), Rusty Gerhardt (1970,71), Brian Barnes (1987-89) and Billy Koch (1995,96) are the others with multiple seasons.
- He is one of only two Tigers in history to be a four-time ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week (first awarded in 1989) in a career (Kris Benson (6)).

McCLADDIE EMERGING

- Junior infielder and outfielder Tryston McCladdie has emerged as a consistent offensive presence near the top of the lineup in 2026.
- He is hitting .381 with four homers, two doubles, 14 RBIs, 11 runs, a .714 slugging percentage and five steals in 12 games in 2026.
- He has a .490 on-base percentage thanks to nine walks against only four strikeouts.
- He is 4-for-4 with the bases loaded.
- He has a team-high six multiple-RBI games.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak, which included his last two games of 2025 and the first nine games of 2026.
- In his career, he is hitting .307 with six doubles, a triple, nine homers, 36 RBIs, 38 runs and 15 steals in 61 games (41 starts).
- In his career, he has a .536 slugging percentage and .422 on-base percentage.

SAVOIE OFF TO HOT START

- Sophomore catcher and outfielder Nate Savoie is in his first season at Clemson after transferring from Loyola Marymount.
- He is hitting .391 with four homers, three doubles, 15 RBIs, 11 runs, a .440 on-base percentage and steal in 12 games in 2026.
- He has a .717 slugging percentage and is hitting .500 with runners in scoring position.
- He has a team-tying-high five multiple-hit games.
- In his first three games as a Tiger against Army West Point on Feb. 13,14, he was 8-for-11 (.727) with a homer, double and seven RBIs.

SHARMAN FILLING ROLE

- Senior lefthander and transfer Michael Sharman filled in in the rotation during the opening weekend and has been in the rotation since.
- He is 3-0 with an 0.90 ERA, .104 opponents' batting average and 18 strikeouts against one walk in 20.0 innings pitched over three starts.
- He has allowed only one extra-base hit (double).
- He retired the first 17 batters and allowed one hit and no walks with eight strikeouts to earn the win against Army West Point on Feb. 14.
- He pitched a complete game, the first by a Tiger since 2024, in the 4-1 win over South Carolina at Columbia, S.C. (Segra Park) on Feb. 28.
