### THE GIST

#### 9-SEED CLEMSON SET TO FACE 8-SEED VIRGINIA

- 9-Seed Clemson is set to face 8-Seed Virginia in the Second Round of the 2026 Ally ACC Tournament on Thursday, Mar. 5. Tipoff is slated for 11 a.m. and the game will air live on ACCN.

#### A WIN WOULD MEAN

- If Clemson reaches 21 wins, it will be the first time in 25 years (2000-01 season) that the Tigers have secured 21 wins.
- If Clemson wins, the Tigers will move on to the Quarterfinals and face 1-Seed Duke on Friday, Mar. 6 (11 a.m., ESPN2).

#### CLEMSON ACC TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- Clemson holds an all-time record of 37-46 in ACC Tournament games.
- The Tigers record as a 9-Seed: 1-3
- Clemson's record in the Second Round: 2-6
- CU vs. UVA in the ACCT: Clemson leads, 5-4
- HC Shawn Poppie in the ACCT: 1-1

#### THE CLEMSON-VIRGINIA SERIES

- Clemson trails to Virginia, 45-36 in the all-time series.
- The pairings between the Tigers and the Cavaliers span back to the 1977-78 season.
- In the last clash, Clemson fell to Virginia, 73-63 (Jan. 1, 2026).

#### CLEMSON NOTES

- In the latest Nitty Gritties Report, Clemson is ranked 44th in the NET, 48th in the NET SOS, and 40th in the WAB.
- Clemson is ranked 49th nationally (2nd in the ACC) in scoring defense, allowing 58.9 points per game, and 37th nationally (2nd in the ACC) in 3-pointers per game (8.1 3FG Per Game).
- In 17 games this season, Clemson has held its opponent to under 60 points.
- The Tigers are led by the scoring duo of senior

guard **Mia Moore** (All-ACC 2nd Team, 13.2 ppg.) and junior guard/forward **Rusne Augustinaite** (11.3 ppg.).

- Augustinaite** is also averaging 2.6 3PM Per Game (3rd in the ACC) and her 75 3PM Ranks 48th Nationally.
- Moore** holds a team-best 4.9 assists average (44th nationally & 5th in the ACC) and a 1.3 steals average.
- Graduate Forward **Demeara Hinds** (6.4 rpg.) leads the Tigers on the glass.
- Senior guard/forward **Hadley Periman** is the squad's leading shot blocker (1.1 bpg.) (17th in the ACC).

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Clemson fell to Stanford, 85-50 at Maples Pavilion on Sunday afternoon.
- Junior guard/forward Rusne Augustinaite (10 points) scored in double-digits for the 18th time this season.

#### TIGERS INK MONSTER SIGNING CLASS; HIGHEST EVER IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- The incoming 2026 class is the highest-ranked signing class in program history and ranks third nationally (per 247 Sports) and sixth nationally (per ESPN).
- The Class includes: Trinity Jones, Kimora Fields, Julia Scott, Meeyah Green, and Dyarri Braddick.
- Coach Poppie, who is in his second year at the helm, has signed six Top-100 recruits in two years. Prior to the Poppie Era at Clemson, the program has only had six Top-100 recruits in the previous 12 years.
- Jones was named to the 2026 USA Women's Nike Hoop Summit Team.
- 2026 McDonalds All-American East Nominee's: Jones (Final West Roster), Fields, Scott, & Green.

### SEASON NOTES

- The Tigers have won seven of their last 10 contests.
- Clemson has amassed an 11-7 ACC record over conference play, including home wins over No. 9/13 Duke (Feb. 22) and NC State (Jan. 8) and road wins at Notre Dame (Jan. 25) and at Miami (Jan. 4).
- Five of the Tigers' nine losses have come to teams currently ranked in the Polls (at No. 2/2 South Carolina, No. 22/21 Louisville, No. 20/21 Michigan St. (Baha Mar), at Alabama, & at No. 25/21 North Carolina).
- The Tigers boast a 75.6% Defensive Rebounding Percentage (Ninth Nationally) and allow opponents to grab just 8.2 offensive rebounds per game, which ranks fourth in the country.
- Clemson has held 17 of its opponents to under 60 points.
- Clemson ranks second in the ACC (49th nationally) in scoring defense, allowing 58.9 points per game, and 37th nationally (second in the ACC) in 3-pointers per game (8.1 3FG Per Game).
- Clemson's losses have come to teams with a combined 193-68 record (.739).

### SIGNATURE WIN | No. 9/13 Duke | 53-51 | Littlejohn Coliseum | Feb. 22, 2026

- Clemson trailed early, 20-8 after the first quarter, but the Tigers outscored Duke, 45-31, over the last three frames.
- In the final quarter, the Tigers started on a 17-4 run and ended the frame outscoring the Blue Devils 23-12.
- The Clemson defense held Duke's Naismith Award Late-Season Team Honoree Toby Fournier scoreless over the last 15:40 minutes of game time and without a shot attempt the entire fourth quarter.

### SIGNIFICANT WIN | RV/RV Notre Dame | 65-58 | Purcell Pavillion | Jan. 25, 2026

- With 8:39 remaining in the third quarter, Notre Dame held a five-point lead. Over the final eight minutes of the third frame, the Tigers went on a 23-7 run and would not trail for the rest of the game.

### SIGNIFICANT WIN | NC State | 75-65 | Littlejohn Coliseum | Jan. 8, 2026

- The Tigers trailed by five points heading into the fourth quarter. A pair of Clemson 3-pointers jumpstarted a 20-3 scoring run that spanned almost 7 minutes, which secured a Tigers win.

### CLOSER THAN THEY APPEAR

#### No. 22/21 Louisville | L, 65-54 | Littlejohn Coliseum | Nov. 16, 2025

- With under four minutes to play in the fourth quarter, back-to-back layups from graduate forward Demeara Hinds and senior forward Raven Thompson pulled the Tigers within four points of the Cardinals, but Louisville pulled away on a 12-5 run (six points on free throws) in the last 2:54.

#### vs. No. 20/21 Michigan St. | L, 72-64 | Baha Mar | Nov. 30, 2025

- Clemson held Michigan State to its lowest non-conference margin of victory this season (eight points), and the Tigers were within five points in the final minute of the game.

#### at No. 25/21 North Carolina | L, 53-44 | Carmichael Arena | Feb. 5, 2026

- Clemson's largest lead of the night was six points in the third quarter. In the fourth frame, the Tigers were within four points of the Tar Heels, 47-43, with 3:55 remaining, and kept the game within two possessions until 00:56.
- Clemson was outrebounded by nine without leading rebounder senior forward Demeara Hinds (8.7 PPG, 6.2 RPG), who was out due to injury.
- Clemson limited the Tar Heels to just 4-16 from 3-point range (UNC entered the game averaging 8.0 3PM Per Game).

#### at Syracuse | L, 68-64 | JMA Wireless Dome | Feb. 16, 2026

- The Tigers took a 54-53 lead with 6:57 remaining in the fourth quarter and neither team led by more than two possessions the last 12 minutes of the game. Clemson had a chance to tie with 13 seconds left, but the shot fell short and two Syracuse FTs sealed the game.
- Clemson showcased its depth as the Tiger bench outscored Syracuse's bench 39-9 in the contest.

### BEST OF THE TIGERS

- The Tigers are led by the scoring duo of senior guard **Mia Moore** (13.2 ppg.) and junior guard/forward **Rusne Augustinaite** (11.3 ppg.).
- **Augustinaite** leads the ACC with a 43.5% three-point percentage.
- **Moore** holds a team-best 4.9 assists average (44th nationally & 5th in the ACC) and a 1.3 steals average.
- Graduate Forward **Demeara Hinds** (6.4 rpg.) leads the Tigers on the glass.
- Senior guard/forward **Hadley Periman** is the squad's leading shot blocker (1.03 bpg.) (17th in the ACC).
- Senior guard **Rachael Rose** and senior forward **Raven Thompson** are two of seven P4 players who average 15+ minutes and have an offensive rating of 124-plus and a defensive rating of 91-plus (Per HerHoopStats).



# NOTES TO NOSH ON

## HISTORIC UPSET OF NO.9/13 DUKE

Clemson pulled off the upset over No. 9/13 Duke, 53-51 at Littlejohn Coliseum on Sunday afternoon. (Feb. 22) A Hannah Kohn three-pointer gave the Tigers a 53-51 lead with 3.1 seconds remaining. On the ensuing inbound play, Taylor Johnson-Matthews tipped the pass to run out the clock and give Duke its first ACC loss of the season.

- For the first time in 25 years (2000-01 season), Clemson has reached 10 wins in conference play, the last time that happened Jim Davis was the head coach.
- For the first time since the 2022-23 season, the Tigers earned an AP Top-10 victory, the last Top-10 Ranked win was a 64-59 win vs. AP No. 7 Virginia Tech (Dec. 29, 2022).
- Clemson's upset win against No. 9/13 Duke is the first-ranked win of the 2025-26 season and the third-ranked win of the Coach Poppie Era.
- This is Clemson's second win over an AP-top 10 opponent over the last 25 seasons.
- Clemson snapped Duke's 17-game win streak and is the only ACC squad to defeat the Blue Devils this season.
- Clemson earned National recognition as USBWA's Team of the Week after the historic upset.

## CLEMSON WOMEN'S BASKETBALL HEAD COACH SHAWN POPPIE SIGNS CONTRACT EXTENSION

Clemson women's basketball Head Coach Shawn Poppie has signed a contract extension through the 2030-31 season, announced by Athletic Director Graham Neff. The Board of Trustees compensation committee approved the action on Friday morning (Feb. 6).

"I'm incredibly grateful to Clemson University and Graham Neff for their Commitment to me, my staff and our entire Clemson women's basketball program," said coach Poppie. "We're proud to represent the Paw and to make Clemson University proud in everything we do, both on the court and in the community. We're thrilled to continue building something special here at Clemson!"

## CLEMSON DEFEATS RV/RV NOTRE DAME FOR 4TH TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Senior guard Taylor Johnson-Matthews (18 points, 3-3 3FG, 10th double-digit scoring game this season, and the 5th game of the season with 3+ 3-pointers) led Clemson as the Tigers handed RV/RV Notre Dame its second home loss of the season, 65-58 at Purcell Pavilion on Sunday.

For the first time since the 2019-20 season, the Tigers beat the Fighting Irish in South Bend (W, 71-55, Dec. 19, 2019). The win also marked the first win in the series since the 2020-21 season.

## TIGERS BEAT NC STATE FOR 1ST TIME IN 15 YEARS

Five Tigers scored double-digit points to lead Clemson to victory, 75-65 against NC State on Thursday night for its first win over the Wolfpack in 15 years (Jan. 6, 2011).

Clemson captured its second-straight Quad One Victory (at the time the game was played, since moved to Q2), with both wins coming by a double-digit margin.

Head Coach Shawn Poppie earned his first career

victory over NC State and his 26th victory as Clemson head coach, allowing him to pass Ito Umoh-Coleman (25 wins, 2011-13) for the sixth most wins in program history.

## 21 3PM RECORD BROKEN (PROGRAM & ACC)

Clemson collected 21 3-pointers (Program & ACC Record) in its 10th win of the season at Chicago St., 97-44, at the Jacoby Dickens Center on Sunday afternoon.

- The Tigers' total of 21 3-pointers marked a new program and ACC record. Clemson's previous team 3-point record was 15 3PM (N.C. State, Dec. 29, 2024). The previous ACC record of 20 3PM was held by Syracuse at North Carolina, Feb. 22, 2018).
- The 21 made 3-pointers by Clemson is the most in a single game across DI this season. It is the most since Tennessee made 30 3-pointers against N.C. Central (December 2024).
- The 35 3-point attempts are tied for the second-most in program history (vs. Longwood, Nov. 19, 2023).
- Clemson made 15 of its 21 3-pointers in the first half.
- The Tigers won by 53 points, the fourth-largest margin of victory on the road in program history.
- Senior guard Johnson-Matthews led at scorers with a season-best 23 points and knocked down a career-high six triples.

## NO. 20/21 MICHIGAN ST. NOTABLES

Clemson held No. 20/21 Michigan St. to its lowest scoring game and lowest margin of victory this season (eight points) in a 72-64 loss in the 2025 Baha Mar Nassau Championship (Junkanoo Division) at the Baha Mar.

- At halftime (38-30), Clemson trailed Michigan St. by eight points, the closest an opponent has trailed the Spartans at the break this season.
- The Tigers held Michigan St. (99.9 PPG) to 72 points, their lowest scoring game of the 2025-26 season.
- Michigan St. won by eight points; the Spartans' average margin of victory is 51.4 ppg.

## TIGERS INK MONSTER SIGNING CLASS; HIGHEST EVER IN PROGRAM HISTORY

The incoming 2026 class is the highest-ranked signing class in program history and ranks third nationally (per 247 Sports) and sixth nationally (per ESPN).

Coach Poppie, who is in his second year at the helm, has signed six Top-100 recruits in two years. Prior to the Poppie Era at Clemson, the program has only had six Top-100 recruits in the previous 12 years.

Senior guard Rachael Rose is 1-of-20 players (1-of-6 in the ACC) named to the 2026 Nancy Lieberman Point Guard of the Year Preseason watch list, announced by Hoophall & the WBCA. Rose did not earn a spot on the Preseason All-ACC Team.

The Nancy Lieberman Award recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. To be considered for this prestigious award, candidates must exhibit the floor leadership, playmaking, and ball-handling skills of Class of 1996 Hall-of-Famer Nancy Lieberman.

## Record Attendance Increase

In the first year of the Shawn Poppie Era, Clemson women's basketball experienced a 91% Year-over-year home attendance growth, 9th nationally and 1st in the ACC.

The Tigers finished the 2024-25 season with the highest home attendance (36,408 fans) in program history since the 2001-02 season.

## Tigers Turning Heads

Last season the Tigers upset No. 19 Georgia Tech (W, 68-61, Feb. 13) and No. 20 Cal (W, 69-58, Jan. 2) in head coach Shawn Poppie's first season (2024-25) at Clemson, which marked the first time since 2022-23 and the third time since 2004 that Clemson defeated two or more ranked opponents in a season.

## Offseason Staff Additions

Corey Fox (Special Assistant to the Head Coach) & Cayla King (Graduate Assistant) joined Shawn Poppie & Co. in the offseason.

Fox was most recently at Limestone, where he had served as the Head Women's Basketball Coach since 2004, and previously from 2001 to 2003 in the Men's Basketball staff. During his time with the Saints, he accumulated a 386-244 record, rebuilding the women's program and setting a school record of 34 wins in a season during 2014-15. He led the team to the program's first Sweet 16 in 2013, to the Elite Eight in 2014, and the Final Four in 2015. He coached nine consecutive winning seasons from 2009 to 2018 and led the Saints to seven consecutive conference championships from 2012 to 2018.

King comes to Clemson with two seasons of professional basketball experience in Slovenia and Australia. King played five seasons at Virginia Tech, connecting her with Poppie. King was a four-year starter for the Hokies, where she saw four NCAA Tournament Runs and was a starter in the 2023 Final Four. She owns the program record for 3FG in a game with nine, and ranks second in career games played (154).






